



# DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN

Repeal unjust laws

Cedaw urges govt

The UN Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women (Cedaw) yesterday urged Bangladesh to repeal all discriminatory provisions and enact new ones to guard against such inequality. It urged the parliament to take necessary steps regarding

implementation of the present concluding observations

between now and the next reporting period under the convention. The Cedaw reviewed women's rights in Bangladesh on November 8 and officially announced its findings, termed concluding observations, published yesterday. It regrets that despite its previous commitment, the state party has not taken any measures to withdraw its reservations

to articles 2 and 16, paragraph 1 (c), of the convention and reiterates that these reservations are incompatible with the object and purpose of the convention.

It, however, said the government brought changes in a number of areas like the labour act which increased maternity leave to six months, Persons with Disabilities Rights and Protection Act, Prevention and Suppression of Human Trafficking Act and Hindu Marriage Registration Act, which provides legal recognition of Hindu marriages.

The committee noted with concern that many discriminatory laws and provisions remain in the national legislation, such as different definitions of a girl child and boy child in various acts, restrictive scope of marital rape in the criminal code, and the lack of jurisdiction of special tribunals for violence against women to hear cases of discrimination against women.

It is also concerned that the personal status laws of the state party regulating marriage, divorce, inheritance, guardianship and custodial rights within various religious groups continue to discriminate against women and girls and that the country is yet to consider adopting a unified family code.
