

THE TOP TRAVEL TECH FOR 2017



ENTERTAINMENT

AMAZON KINDLE PAPERWHITE

If you love reading books, this is THE gadget. Soft lit front to avoid eye strain in the dark. Charge once a month. \$120

LIGHTWEIGHT NOTEBOOKS FOR TRAVEL

When you travel, you need the lightest notebook you can get. And yes, there are great options that are not named Air. Lenovo LaVie Z550 is lighter than a hip Air at 0.78kg. 13-inch, dual-core Broadwell processor. \$1,300. Asus ZenBook 3 is 12.5 inches, gorilla glass, full-size keyboard and a fingerprint reader. i7 processor, 16GB DDR3, 128MB Intel HD Graphics 620. 512GB SSD. Weighs 0.91kg and lightens your wallet by \$1,600.

LIFESTRAW

You're travelling to some place with dubious drinking water supply. This straw is a microbiological purification unit capable of filtering 1,000 litres of water sucked up through the straw. Removes 99.9999 percent of waterborne bacteria and parasites. No chemicals, no batteries and no moving parts. Cons: It will NOT remove salt. Won't work on ocean water or in extreme cases, your own bodily water supply. In case of zombie attack in the desert, you can drink your pee through Lifestraw; it will be clean but salty. Ultra-light, weighs only 56 grams. \$20



OVERBOARD PRO-VIS WATERPROOF **GADGET BAG**

Waterproof, compact at 30 litres, high visibility colors. Cons: Only available in those two high visibility colors. Won't match your brown leather hiking boots. Starts from roughly \$40.



ROYCE FREEDOM WALLET

It won't transform into a suit. But it will protect your data via an RFID shield that prevents hackers from accessing the info on your passport's RFID chip. It has a Bluetooth tag that syncs with your phone. Lose it and the phone notifies you. \$99

STAY CONNECTED

HOOTOO TRIPMATE ELITE TRAVEL ROUTER

Stuck in a hotel room with single device wi-fi connection? Use Ethernet, connect multiple gadgets. Two-port USB chargers for phones and tabs. 6,000mAh battery for outdoor charging. Hook up flash drive to share files with other devices. Retails for about \$47.



BATTERYPACK CASES

Everybody drops their phones. The universe has set a law that the newer/pricier the phone, the easier it breaks. You need a protector while tackling mountains or shopping mall stairs.

BuQu Tech PowerArmour Case protects your smartphone accidental falls. Provides one full recharge. Nifty LEDs show how much charge remains. Retails

for about \$80. Anker Ultra Slim Extended Battery Case, also for iPhone 6 retails for \$46.99. Adds less than 1/4th inch thickness. Adds additional 120% charge.

The other popular device Samsung Galaxy S7, has PowerBear come to the rescue. 4,500 mAh. 24 Month Warranty and included screen protector. Retails for about \$30.

TAKE NOTES



SMARTPEN

Helps take notes on a tablet like the iPad and write on paper like a ballpen. It will sync with your device and saves your ink scribbles.

Pricey pen at \$170

BAMBOO SOLO FROM WACOM

Carbon fibre tip, weighs only 10grams to write, tap, draw on any device. Available in four colors. The Inkspace service easily lets you store, shape and share your ideas. Also much cheaper

at under \$20.

Roller suitcase with the only zipperless, garagedoor style opening. Built-in charger for your phone, GPS for tracking and it can weigh itself. \$345 for the 22 inch carry on luggage. Is it worth buying? That depends on how deep your pocket is!

SMART LUGGAGE

Built-in charger, GPS, measuring scale to avoid excess weight. Comes with app providing relevant info such as best routes, TSA wait times and weather updates. Scratch-proof and available in seven colors. The 22-inch carry-on case is \$295; the 28-inch check-in case is \$395. The two cases are sold together for \$595. Trust me, traveling couldn't have gone more techier!

COMING UP:

Delsey Pluggage is a prototype that includes interior lighting, a fingerprint ID lock and a speaker for playing tunes from your phone while you wait. On the other hand, Samsonite, one of the oldest name in luggage is working on "self-propelled" luggage. Like a little puppy it will trail the owner six inches behind. And unlike a puppy, it will not hump.

ACM-ICPC Asia regional contest held in Dhaka

ACM International Collegiate Programming Contest (ACM-ICPC) is an annual multi-tiered competitive programming competition among the universities of the world. Department of Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), University of Asia Pacific (UAP) hosted this year's Regional Final of the International Collegiate Programming Contest (ICPC) at UAP city campus. The inauguration ceremony took place on Friday, November 18 and the prize giving and closing Ceremony took place on Saturday, November 19, 2016.
