Proctor Prof Tapan Kumar Saha assured action after the reporter filed a complaint. He added, "We already handed the youth (Rabbi) over to Ashulia police."

Central Shaheed Minar with participants of the Dhaka march programme, which will start from seven points across the country.
The National Committee has long been pressing for scrapping the project near the Sundarbans. Anu Muhammad, however, hoped that the government would not obstruct their protest programmes.
He said they informed the chairman of the National Human Rights Commission, Bangladesh, of their programmes and urged him to take necessary measures for them.
"Following rules, we already sought permission from the authorities concerned, including the police, to hold the rallies and hope that we will get it," he told reporters.
Despite vehement public protests, the government is going ahead with the project, ignoring serious environmental concerns.
Asked about a recent decision of the Workers Party of Bangladesh (WPB) on refraining from joining the Dhaka march, Anu Muhammad said they tried their best to remain united, but they had nothing to do in this regard, as it was the party's decision.
He, however, said many of the WPB activists told them that they would individually join the protest programmes.
WPB on Monday said they would not participate in the march, reasoning that some of the National Committee's allies are spreading "misleading" information and slandering India and China.
However, Prof Anu said their movement was against the power plant, not against any country.
Ruhin Hossain Prince of the Communist Party of Bangladesh, Moshrefa Mishu of Ganotantik Biplobi Party, Bazur Rashid Firoz of Bangladesher Samajtantrik Dal and Junaid Saki of Gonosonghoti Andolon were present at the press conference.

charges into cognisance on March 29.
Yesterday, Prosecutor Hrishikesh Saha prayed to the tribunal to frame charges, saying that they have sufficient evidence to prove the charges while defence counsels Gazi MH Tamim and Muzahedul Islam Shahin filed petitions seeking their clients' discharge.
The five charges are abduction, torture and killing of three people of Kalairpar, Chaklauripara and Phulbaria municipality between August 22 and 25; killing of three people of Bidyananda and Betbari on August 27; an incident of genocide in which eight Hindus were killed and three Hindu women raped in Risipara on November 5; another incident of genocide in which at least 43 people of six villages were killed on November 3; and killing of three brothers of Bhalukjan on November 21.

jail terms for five men but acquitting Farhat and Hummam, Assistant Attorney General Shahidul Islam Khan told The Daily Star. Mahbubul's appeal will be heard when the documents arrive, he said.
Soon after the International Crimes Tribunal-1 passed the war crimes case verdict on October 1, 2013, Salauddin's wife and family members showed "a copy of the verdict" to newsmen, claiming it was leaked.
Later, the tribunal authorities said a portion of the draft verdict had been leaked.
Detectives filed a case with Shabbagh police on October 4 that year against Fakhru, Mehedi, Faruk, Nayon and several unnamed people under the Information and Communication Technology Act, 2006. Hummam's whereabouts remain unknown after he was allegedly picked up by unidentified men on August 4.
The verdict, passed on September 15 this year, saw Salauddin's counsel Fakhru Islam jailed for 10 years and slapped a Tk 10 lakh fine while Salauddin's manager Mahbubul, Fakhru's assistant Mehedi Hasan and the then tribunal office assistant Faruk Hossain and peon Nayon Ali were jailed for seven years.
The Cyber Tribunal acquitted Farhat and Hummam, as the prosecution failed to prove their involvement in "hatching conspiracy and instigating" the leak, which raised question over the security of the special tribunal.

at the workplace, while almost all of them stressed the need for recruitment of more women in the police force.
Speakers at the roundtable said the situation of women police in Bangladesh personnel was better than other South Asian countries such as India, Pakistan and the Maldives, as the Bangladeshi policewomen were more co-operative.
Of the participants, 100 percent of the inspectors and sub-inspectors said their families supported their job while this was respectively 96.7 percent and 97.39 percent for ASIs and constables, says the report.
It added that 2.7 percent of SIs, 3.3 percent of ASIs and 10.46 percent of constables alleged that they faced sexual harassment at the workplace.
Of the participants, 33.34 percent of inspectors, 62.16 percent of SIs, 40 percent of ASIs and 43.8 percent of constables said they worked over 12 hours a day.
Addressing the roundtable, Manusher Jonno Foundation Executive Director Shaheen Anam stressed the need for more women in the higher ranks.
"The role of women police personnel is important for women empowerment," she said, adding that the association of women police personnel could play a vital role in this regard.
Maja Daruwala, senior advisor and board member of CHRI, highlighted the role of police in addressing citizens' concerns.
Christine Hunter, country representative of UN Women in Bangladesh, said the world agreed to eliminate all forms of violence against women by 2030.
"And we are so far from there," she said, adding that more than 70 percent of Bangladeshi married women still faced violence.
Reading out a written statement, DIG (logistics and procurement) Mily Biswas said over the past few decades the concept of policing had changed.
The job now requires persons with ethical and excellent interpersonal and problem-solving skills, said Mily, also president of Bangladesh Police Women's Network.
The police official added that there might be incidents of sexual harassment, which needed to be addressed.

Meanwhile, a team of Rapid Action Battalion-11 arrested two ABT men -- Abbas Ali, 27, and Sabbir Hossain alias Razu -- in Siddhirganj area of Narayanganj.
Rab, in a statement, yesterday claimed that ABT man Abbas was drawn into militancy after listening to sermons of ABT chief Jasimuddin Rahmani in 2012.
Sabbir, who has expertise in information technology, was an admin of different Facebook pages that provoke militancy.
In primary interrogation, the arrestee told Rab that they had a plan to release Rahmani through either breaking in Kashimpur prison or carrying out an ambush on their way from and to court.
