The Chittagong University authorities yesterday removed its Assistant Proctor Anwar Hossain from the proctorial body following protests against him over Bangladesh Chhatra League leader Diaz Irfan Chowdhury's death.

Acting Registrar Prof Kamrul Huda issued a notice in this regard which did not specify the reason behind the removal. The Daily Star got a copy of the letter.

The authorities declined to comment on the issue.

On November 24, Diaz's mother Jeheda Amin Chowdhury lodged a case with a Chittagong court against around 20 people, including Anwar Hossain and CU unit BCL president Mohammad Alamgir Tipu.

Meanwhile, Diaz's supporters postponed their indefinite strike, which they called on Saturday demanding a fair probe into the death, on the campus after the removal the assistant proctor.

CU unit BCL vice president Md Nazim Uddin said the removal led to the postponement of their strike.

5 charges pressed against three Netrakona suspects

Five specific charges have been pressed against three Netrakona men who allegedly committed crimes in the district during the Liberation War in 1971.

Hearing a brief submission on the charges from prosecutor Mukhlesur Rahman Badal, the three-member tribunal led by Justice Anwarul Haque fixed January 10 to decide whether to take those into cognisance.

The accused are Hedayet Ullah Anju, 80, and his brother Enayet Ullah Manju, 70, and Sohrab Fakir, 88, of Kulshreee village under Atpara Police Station. Of them Manju and Sohrab are now in jail while Anju is on the

Prosecutors Mukhlesur and Sabina Yesmin Khan Munni submitted the formal charges and other documents to the tribunal on Sunday through its registrar office.

The tribunal's investigation agency on September 8 completed investigations against the three and said to have found their involvement in crimes against humanity and genocide in 1971.

Hedayet was a Jamaat-e-Islami leader while the other activists in 1971 and all three first joined local Peace Committees and then Razakar Bahini, an auxiliary force of the Pakistani occupation army, says the investigators.

Hedayet contested in the Pakistan Nation Election in 1970 with Jamaat ticket but was defeated. He and his brother are still involved with Jamaat, they said.

The charges include looting and torching of 20 to 30 houses in Madhuakhali village on May 29 and abduction and killing of one Malek Talukder and Kala Chand Munshi of Mobarakpur village on August 23.

Court hears arguments of defence

Lawyers of six of the 35 persons accused over the sensational Narayanganj seven-murder repeatedly engaged in altercations with the public prosecutor (PP) while completing placing arguments on the fourth day of the hearings yesterday.

Twenty three of the accused were present in the court of Narayanganj District and Sessions Judge Syed Enayet Hossain. The remaining are on the run. PP Advocate SM Wazed Ali Khokan said the hearings would continue today.

Court sources said advocates Sultan Uz Zaman and Shahabuddin stood for sacked Rapid Action Battalion-11 commanding officer Tareque Sayeed Mohammad, the case's prime accused.

Advocate Mizanur Rahman defended sepoy Abu Tayeb, constable Sihabuddin and habildars Emdadul Haque and Nasiruddin while advocate Harendra Nath subinspector Purnendu Bala.

Seven people, including Narayanganj city corporation panel mayor Nazrul Islam and senior lawyer Chandan Sarkar, were abducted from the Dhaka-Narayanganj Link Road on April 27, 2014. Their bodies were found floating in the Shitalakkhya a few days later.

Two cases were filed, one by Chandan's son-inlaw Bijoy Kumar Paul another by Nazrul's wife Selina Islam Beauty.

Anyone falling victim to police excesses or harassment at any part of the country no longer needs to meet any police official in person to lodge a complaint. Victims can file a complaint sitting at home or from

any place having internet connection using-www.police.gov.bd -- the police headquarters' website. Clicking on "Opinion or Complaint" on the webpage's bottom left corner, anyone intending to lodge a complaint can view the process of filing one

online or give any type of opinion on police service. A team of police officers led by an additional deputy inspector general (DIG) will quickly look into the allegation and investigate it to get corrupt policemen punished.

The police headquarters has taken up the initiative in light of a national integrity strategy to make police accountable and bring transparency into the force, said head of the unit concerned, Additional DIG of Police Abdul Alim Mahmud.

Although the new website was launched in August, the police headquarters is hardly getting any



complaint as people are not aware of the new system of lodging complaints or praising police for good deeds.

"We are receiving one or two complaints or opinions a month," Additional Superintendent of Police Sadira Khatun told The Daily Star recently.
