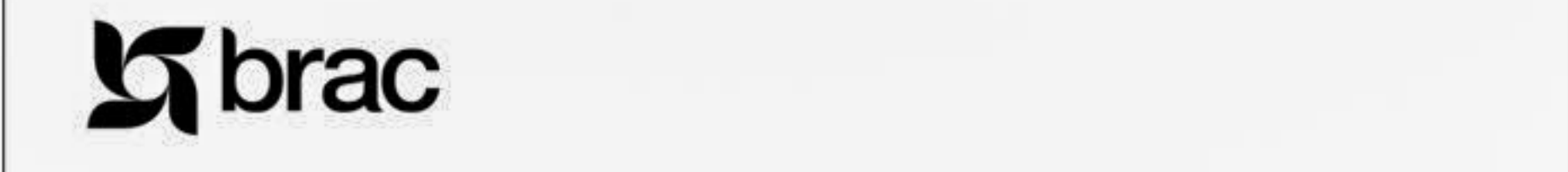

A sub-inspector (SI), an assistant SI and two constables of Darus Salam police in Mirpur caught a businessman, Chowdhury Moshir Rahman, and threatened to implicate him in a drug case if he did not give them Tk 1 lakh. The policemen called his wife to come with the money and get Chowdhury released. She was finally able to provide Tk 10,000 and a necklace for his release. In the complaint, Chowdhury said his wife fell unconscious on the road, unable to bear the trauma. Alim said they promptly conducted an investigation and the accused were suspended. A departmental investigation by Mirpur Division of Dhaka Metropolitan Police is ongoing, he added.

US calls for strong, independent EC

DIPLOMATIC CORRESPONDENT With the current Election Commission's (EC) tenure due to expire in February, the United States yesterday called for selecting a new one through an inclusive and transparent process to make the body independent, strong and non-partisan.

"We want to see an...electoral commission...that will ensure everyone who wants to vote can cast vote and every vote cast can be counted," said US Ambassador in Dhaka Marcia Bernicat. Replying to questions on issues including atrocities on Myanmar's Rohingya minority at Diplomatic Correspondents Association, Bangladesh (DCAB) Talk in the afternoon, she said the US was ready to participate with the international community to find solutions.

The event was organised in the capital's EMK Centre with DCAB President Angur Nahar Monty in the chair. General Secretary Pantho Rahaman also spoke. She expressed confidence that Bangladesh-US relations would remain as strong as it is today even after the new Donald Trump administration took over after January 20.

"We took real interest and notice that the prime minister herself during the Awami League council said that she does not want to have questionable elections next time. The new general secretary also said the same thing," said Bernicat. The formation will be the first tangible step as it would ensure excise of people's voting rights, she said.

Bernicat said the US and a number of like-minded countries were urging and advocating that there be an inclusive, transparent process to select a new EC and that was key to holding the best election possible. She said they had been putting pressure on the "Burmese" government both before and after the elections, calling them to respect rights of all people living in the country. Lauding Bangladesh, she said "We have been a great
