WORKERS IN UAE, QATAR Safe workplaces not being ensured: Study

Construction companies operating in the Gulf region especially in the UAE and Qatar are failing to protect migrant workers from hazardous working environment, hinting at an alarming signal on the workers' safeguards in workplaces, said a survey report of Business & Human Rights Resource Centre.

The UK-based NGO that tracks the human rights impacts of over 6,900 companies, making information available on its website, enquired with 100 construction companies operating in the UAE and Qatar on the measures they are taking to stop exploitation of migrant workers.

Only 22 companies responded, indicating a shocking level of inaction for the migrant workers' protection measures.

The centre yesterday released the report titled "Wall of Silence: The Construction Sector's Response to Migrant Rights in Qatar and the UAE" analysing the companies' responses on some specific key indicators for the migrant workers' safety.

Migrant rights activists in Bangladesh have been expressing their worries over serious

violation of the workers' rights in the workplaces abroad especially in the Gulf countries those hire around 80 percent of workers from Dhaka.

"As our workers' recruitment for the Gulf countries are mainly dealt with the outsourcing companies, the employers or the authorities usually avoid responsibility of ensuring protection measures for the workers. The Bangladeshis remain deprived of enjoying their legal rights of getting safe workplaces, fair wages, health and accommodation," said Prof CR Abrar, executive director of Refugee and Migratory Movements Research Unit (RMMRU) yesterday.

More than 10 lakh Bangladeshis are now working for the construction firms in Qatar and the UAE, according to statistics of Bureau of Manpower Employment and Training (BMET).

RECRUITMENT, CONTRACTS AND RIGHTS

Only 10 companies mentioned of some degree of direct involvement in the recruitment process – through, among others, in-country interviews, recruitment, visits, and spot checks. Eleven companies stated that

of Sust unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), on October 4.

Sylhet Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Saifuzzaman Hiru recorded the testimonies of 17 witnesses among 37 including Murari Chand College Principal Nitai Chandra Chanda, Vice-Principal Hayatul Islam Akanjee and Khadiza's uncle, said Mahfuzur Rahman, additional public prosecutor.

The same court, earlier on November 29, indicted Badrul, also a suspended final-year student of Economics of the university.

Of the 37 witnesses, including Khadiza as the second witness, 20 were called to give their statement to the court, said the APP.

The court also set December 11 as the next date for recording testimony of the remaining witnesses, the APP added.

Khadiza, a second-year Degree student of Sylhet Government Women's College, was hacked by Badrul on her way home after appearing at the examination at Murari Chand College following the refusal of his proposal for having an affair with him. Hearing the victim's screams, other students rescued Khadiza and caught Badrul from the spot and handed him over to police after giving him a good thrashing.

Khadiza was first taken to Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital from where she was moved to Square Hospital in Dhaka for better treatment.

She is now undergoing treatment at Centre for the Rehabilitation of the Paralysed (CRP) in Savar.

Mentionable, Badrul confessed to hacking Khadiza in his statement he made under section-164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC) on October 5.

On November 8, Harun Ur-Rashid, sub-inspector and investigation officer of Jalalabad Police Station submitted a charge sheet against the lone accused Badrul.

available on the spot of the 14-storey building that housed Rezaul Apparels upto the 10th floor.

The police asked the workers to go to the BGMEA Complex in Karwan Bazar, saying that the association would help them.

Leaders of the Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA) brought together the labour leaders and the owners to a meeting.

Mahmud Hasan Khan, a vice president of the BGMEA, said the factory owners want to shift the factory and was ready to provide compensation as per laws.

The laws stipulate that if owners shift factories to places which are within 40km of the existing factory their workers will have to move, said Khan.

If the workers refuse to move they will be considered that they have resigned and will get compensation for the days they have worked. But the workers are demanding termination benefits which entitle them to four-month's basic salary as compensation, said Khan.

The talks were ongoing till last evening.

OUTBREAKS OF PESTS Early measures to save tomato harvest Speakers tell Bari, SIAB seminar

Agricultural scientists yesterday stressed conducting a survey on damages to tomato production from an outbreak of a pest, Tuta absoluta, a leaf miner, identified in a Chaklarhat village field in Panchagarh in May and containing the spread before caused colossal damage in potato production.

They were addressing a seminar, "Integrated Management of Tuta absoluta, South American Tomato leafminer", Bangladesh Agricultural Research Institute (Bari) and Seed Industries Association of Bangladesh (SIAB) organised with support from USAID's Agricultural Value Chains Project in Bangladesh in the capital's at BARC auditorium.

M Shahadath Hossain, a Bari senior scientific officer, said tomato farmers were fighting at least 10 pests and Indian farmers had faced it in 2014.

Other immediate measures suggested include sowing healthy seedlings and using pest exclusion nets and pesticides made of neem (margosa).

"The pest cannot be destroyed, but employing integrated pest management practices...can lead to an effective control," mentioned R Muniappan, director of Integrated Pest Management (IPM) of the office of International Research, Education and Development at Virginia Tech.

"With the proactive actions taken by IPM Innovation Lab, we hope to significantly reduce the economic loss caused by this pest in Nepal and Bangladesh as well as in the rest of Asia and the United States," he said, when addressing the seminar.
