A nationwide initiative to create a digital video repository "Ekattorer Biroter Kotha" (stories of heroism in the Liberation War) narrated by the freedom fighters will start from December 10.

Grameenphone with assistance of the Ministry of Liberation War Affairs announced the initiative yesterday at a press conference in the capital, said a press release. The video repository with thousands of interviews will be handed over to the ministry on March 26 (Independence Day). The repository will be available online and accessible to all.

AKM Mozammel Huq, minister for Liberation War Affairs, MA Hannan, secretary of the ministry, Petter B Furburg, CEO of Grameenphone, and Yasir Azman, its CMO, also spoke. Lt Col (retd) Quazi Sajjad Ali Zahir Bir Protik, also a recipient of Swadhinata Padak, at the programme shared his experiences of the war.

Communalism will turn out destructive for the country if its roots are not eliminated, he said, calling upon lawyers to turn away those who instil communalism in people.

Swapan Mormu, a local of Gaibandha who filed a case over the clash, that day to explain the reason for filing the case.

The HC also fixed December 12 for passing further orders on the issue.

The mill authorities submitted a report to the HC informing that they harvested paddy from all 49 acres of land and handed it over to Santals as per the court order.

The clash broke out between the Santals, mill staff and police over eviction of the indigenous people from the disputed land. The clash left three Santal men dead and 20

others, including nine policemen, injured.

Responding to a writ petition filed by three rights organisations including Ain o Salish Kendra, the HC on November 17 directed the government to ensure security and free movement of the Santals, to allow Santal families to harvest the paddy and to submit a report on legal steps taken over the attack.

ZI Khan Panna, AM Aminuddin and Obu Obaidur Rahman appeared for the petitioners, while Deputy Attorney General Motaher Hossain Sazu represented the government.

He joined Muslim League in 1944 and was elected its Dhaka district vice president. He was also a vice-president of Awami Muslim League when it was formed as the largest opposition political party in Pakistan in 1949.

He took part in the 1952 Language Movement and worked for the United Front popularly known as Jukta Front in 1954.

He was a member of the provincial cabinet of Sher-e-Bangla AK Fazlul Huq. He was elected a member of the Pakistan Constituent Assembly in 1955.

Ataur Rahman Khan became the chief minister of East Pakistan in 1956 and continued to hold this position till the promulgation of martial law in the country in 1958. Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was a minister in his cabinet.

As one of the leaders of National Democratic Front (NDF) formed under the leadership of Huseyn Shaheed Suhrawardy in 1962 he played a vital role in the movement for the restoration of democracy in then Pakistan. He actively campaigned for Fatima Jinnah, the candidate of the combined opposition to defeat the military dictator Ayub Khan in 1965.

Ataur Rahman Khan was elected a member of parliament in the first general election of independent Bangladesh in 1973 and also served as the prime minister of the country from March 30, 1984 to January 1, 1985.

He was a lawyer, politician and writer of a good number of books, namely -- Ozarati Dui Bachhar (1963), Swairacharer Dash Bachhar (1969), Pradanmantritva Nai Mash (1987), Abaruddha Nai Mash (1990).

Ataur Rahman Khan died in Dhaka on December 7, 1991.

independence of the country, in contrast to the spirit of the Liberation War, many roads and structures had been named after individuals who took a stand against the liberty of the nation.

The HC in August the same year directed the authorities to rename Khan A Sabur Road in Khulna to Jessore Road -- the original name. The court also asked the Islamic University authorities to rename Shah Azizur Rahman Auditorium.

The court said the names of the road and the auditorium need to be changed as those were named after two collaborators.

AKM Rashedul Huq, the petitioners' lawyer, told reporters a supplementary petition was submitted to the HC annexing a list of 20 collaborators' names that are still being displayed on plaques of various structures.
