Yahoo Inc has warned that it had uncovered yet another massive cyber attack, saying data from more than 1 billion user accounts was compromised in August 2013, making it the largest breach in history.

The number of affected accounts was double the number implicated in a 2014 breach that the internet company disclosed in September and blamed on hackers working on behalf of a government. News of that attack, which affected at least 500 million accounts, prompted Verizon Communication Inc to say in October that it might withdraw from an agreement to buy Yahoo's core internet business for \$4.83 billion.

Assad congratulates Syrians on 'liberation'
as hundreds leave the flashpoint city

Hundreds of civilians and rebels left Aleppo yesterday under an evacuation deal that will allow Syria's regime to take full control of the city after years of fighting.

The rebel withdrawal began a month to the day after President Bashar al-Assad's forces launched a new offensive to recapture Aleppo and will hand the regime its biggest victory in more than five years of

on Saturday 17 December




