RADAR SCAM CASE AGAINST ERSHAD SC full bench to hear another accused's plea

The full bench of Supreme Court will now hear former air chief Sultan Mahmud's appeal against the High Court order on radar purchase scam case filed 24 years ago against Jatiya Party Chairman HM Ershad and three others.

Chamber judge, who is in charge of dealing with emergency judicial matters when the higher court goes into vacation, sent the matters to the full bench, passing no fresh order.

Justice Md Nizamul Huq, chamber judge of the Appellate Division, also sent the appeal to the full bench for its hearing on January 2 next year.

Anti Corruption Commission (ACC) lawyer Khurshid Alam Khan told The Daily Star that the HC order will remain in force until the SC passes any order on the appeal.

Mahmud, also an accused in the case, filed the appeal challenging the HC order that asked the lower court concerned to finish the trial proceedings by March 31 next year.

On December 19, Mahmud submitted the leave-to-appeal petition to the Appellate Division through his lawyer Syed Mahbubur Rahman, claiming that the HC passed the order without hearing his arguments.

Following an ACC petition, the HC on November 24 also said the trial court can record statements of the case's remaining 26 prosecution witnesses if they are produced within this period. Earlier, the lower court had recorded statements of 12 witnesses.

The now-defunct Bureau of Anti Corruption filed the case against Ershad and three others with cantonment police on May 4, 1992. Ershad in collusion with others allegedly caused a loss of Tk 64.04 crore to the state exchequer by purchasing radars from the US, instead of France, for the air force while he was in power.

On August 12, 1995, the trial court framed charges against Ershad, former air chiefs Sultan Mahmud and Mamtauddin Ahmed, and United Traders Ltd director AKM Musa, who has been absconding since then.

reflected in its role with regard to the issue of language movement since 1948. Pakistani armed forces unleashed crackdown in Dhaka University on March 25 in 1971 as its students were seen to be the most committed political elements, he said.

"Students from Dhaka University were part of the vanguard of the Mukti Bahini [freedom fighters]. Many of the university teachers provided valuable services to the provisional government established in Mujibnagar," he said.

Prof Khan Sarwar Murshid, who taught in the English department of DU since 1948, was a pioneer in promoting intellectual debates on public issues, democracy and human rights, Dr Kamal added.

Murshid was the vice-chancellor of Rajshahi University from 1972 to 1974; Bangladesh's ambassador to Poland from 1975-1977 and an assistant secretary general of the Commonwealth from 1977 to 1982. He joined back DU in 1982 and retired in 1984.

Murshid, one of the writers of the historic Six Points of Awami League, had expressed concern that "politicisation" of students and teachers went against the aspirations of those who wanted Dhaka University to emerge as a centre of academic excellence.

Dr Kamal Hossain said it is very important to get Dhaka University free of sycophancy and partisan politics. "Let us bring back the glory of Dhaka University," he added.

Prof Tazeen Mahnaz Murshid, daughter of Khan Sarwar Murshid, said objectives of the trust fund are to focus on areas of interests of her parents including aesthetics, higher education, politics, governance, civil society, human rights and gender, literature and history.

ASB President Prof Amirul Islam Chowdhury and Prof Dr Sabbir Ahmed also spoke.

Murders, low voter

Referring to violence centring the recently concluded Union Parishad (UP) elections, it said Dhaka division ranked top with 35 murders followed by Rajshahi (24), Chittagong (23), Barisal (16), Khulna (13), and Sylhet (5).

Of these, about 60 were caused by intra-ruling party violence, it added.

Internal feuds and intense competition for nomination were behind violence, it said referring to candidates participating with party symbols and ruling party supporters and operatives involving themselves in selecting candidates and spreading money to ensure victories.

Influence of money at the nomination stage pushed candidates to attempt to win at all costs, including through use of force, to get a return on their investments, causing widespread electoral violence, the BIGD observed.

Voter turnout was found to be low in local government elections including the city corporation, upazila parishad, union parishad and municipal elections, it said.

However, the voter turnout has been low in recent city corporation elections of Dhaka north and south and Chittagong in comparison to other city corporation elections held in the last several years, it added.

However, the participation of candidates in some elections including the 10th national and city corporation elections in Dhaka and Chittagong have been affected by boycotts by the main opposition party, which may have also resulted in a lower voter turnout, the report mentioned.

Recent local and national elections lacked a competitive process, it said, adding that there is no transparency about electoral fundraising and spending and reports filed with the Election Commission.

Commenting on electoral governance, Transparency International Bangladesh's Executive Director Dr Iftekharuzzaman said politicisation of the state machineries led to "controversial" elections in Bangladesh. "After the '90's, the state machineries were politicised and counter-politicised by different governments. This has contributed to absence of good governance in the election system," he said.

He added that the state organs must be independent and empowered to hold a participatory and credible election.

Renowned economist Prof Wahiuddin Mahmud and BIGD Executive Director Sultan Hafeez Rahman also spoke.

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Two militant suspects held

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) yesterday claimed to have arrested two militant suspects in the capital's Pallabi in the early hours.

Atikur Rahman alias Milon, 21, and Khademul Islam, 28, alias Khademul alias Gazoatul were members of a JMB faction, which Rab called the "Sarwar-Tamim group".

Five books promoting extremism, leaflets, four sharp weapons and Tk 37,593 were also seized from their possession, said Rab.

In primary interrogation, Atikur of Nilphamari admitted that he used to carry and distribute money on behalf of JMB leader Sarwar Jahan, who died after jumping off a building during a Rab raid in Ashulia on October 8, said Khandakar Lutful Kabir, commanding officer of Rab-4, at a press briefing at Rab Media Centre in Dhaka.

Khademul of Barisal confessed to giving shelter to militant recruits and receiving funds delivered by different people like Atikur for the purpose, he said.
