

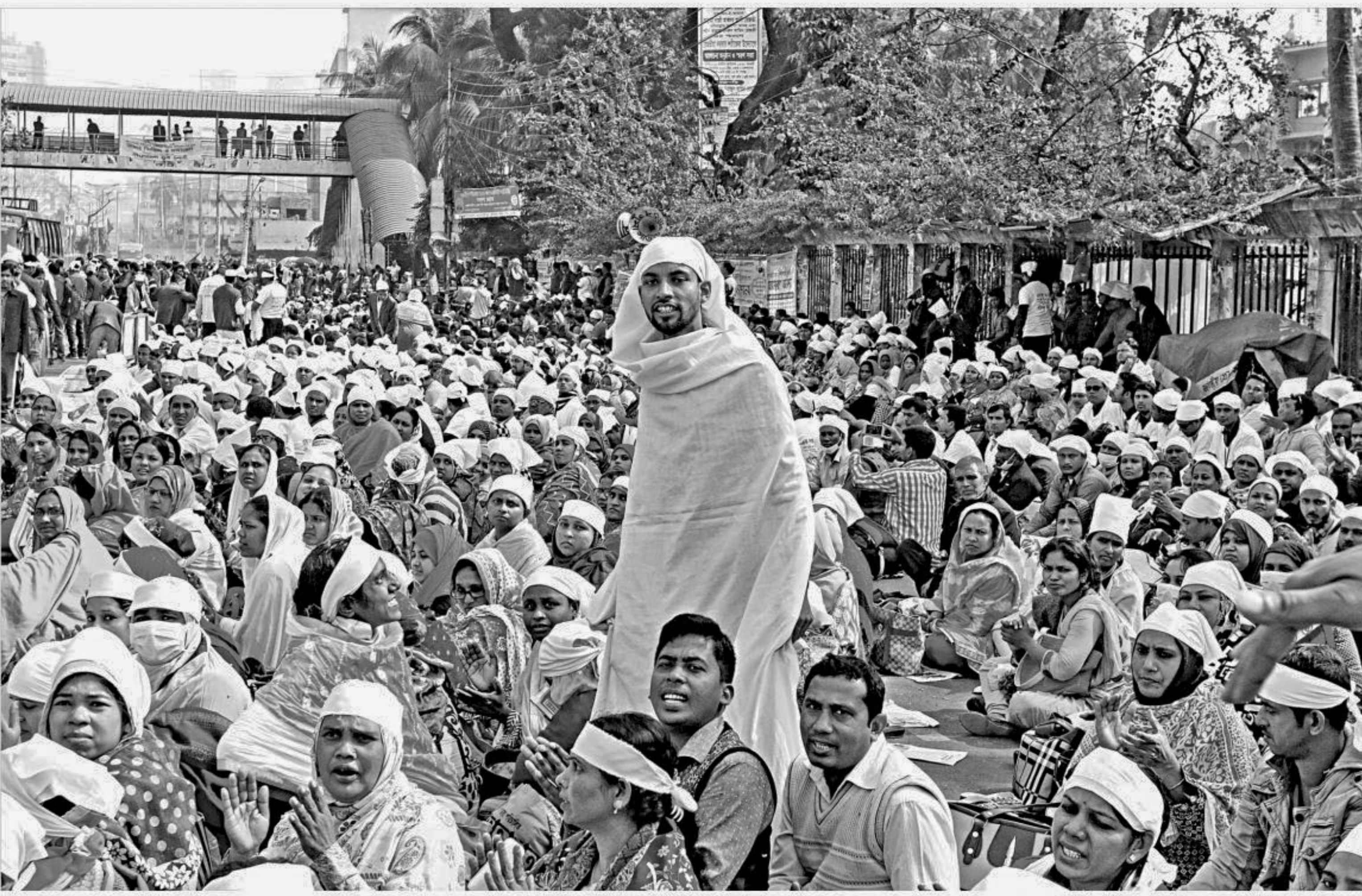
# Punishment alone can't stop crimes

Says Anisul

Crimes cannot be eradicated through punishment only, rather other preventive measures are needed to tackle crimes in the country, said Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Anisul Huq yesterday.

"Family and social bonding have become weak and even been torn in many places as people are running after name and fame. The trend of getting educated on social and humane values from the family and society has decreased. So, we have to strengthen our family and social ties, which can cause the social crimes to take a nosedive," he said.

Anisul came up with the observations while addressing the inaugural function of a conference titled "Many Colors of Violence: Bangladesh Context" organised by the Bangladesh Institute of Crime and

# Govt to form 'Probashi Kalyan Board'

The government would form a "Probashi Kalyan Board" soon as a draft law has already been made to set up a statutory organisation for providing welfare services to migrant workers and their family members.

The draft probashi kalyan board act-2017 has been uploaded on the expatriates' welfare and overseas employment ministry's website to take in people's opinion on it.

Talking to the news agency, Additional Secretary to the ministry Azharul Haq said the ministry would sit on January 12 to decide on the act.

According to the draft law, a 15-member body of the board will be formed with the secretary of the ministry as chairman. Its members will include three women. The board will have a director general with the rank and status of joint secretary.

The draft law was formulated in light with the International Convention on the Protection of Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families, 1990.

Officials said about 1.3 crore Bangladeshi migrants are employed in 162 countries and they annually remit over US\$ 15 billion to the country.

Alam claimed that Shanta's ex-husband Sajib Akan was behind the abduction and attack.

He filed a case against nine people, including Sajib and his father Sobur Akan, with Sharankhola Police Station.

Alam said Shanta got married to Sajib in January, 2015, but divorced him 10 months later as Sajib used to torture her.

Abdul Jalil, officer-in-charge of Sharankhola Police Station, said they were conducting drives to capture the culprits and that they suspect her former in-laws were behind the incident.

He said they picked up the trawler pilot for interrogation. The Daily Star could not reach Sajib and his family.

Locals held a rally in Raenda Bazar yesterday afternoon to protest the abduction and threatened to keep their business closed if the perpetrators were not caught in a day.
