


"American Horror Story" renewed for two seasons

FX has renewed "American Horror Story" for two more seasons — in addition to the already-picked-up seventh season — taking the anthology series through a ninth season.


The announcement was made Thursday ahead of the cabler's sessions at the Television Critics Association winter press tour in Pasadena, California.

Created by Ryan Murphy and Brad Falchuk, "American Horror Story" began in 2011 with its first installment, "Murder House". Then came "Asylum", "Coven", "Freak Show", "Hotel" and the most recent season, "AHS: Roanoke", wrapped in late 2016.

Over the course of its run, "Ameri-

can Horror Story" has won 15 Emmy awards, plus Golden Globes and AFI Awards. The fifth installment "AHS: Hotel" won two Emmys in 2016. Aside from accolades, "AHS" is also a ratings winner, topping FX's all-time telecasts. For the past five installments of "AHS," each season has ranked among cable's top five scripted series of the year in which they aired.

Over the years, "American Horror Story" regular players have included Sarah Paulson, Jessica Lange, Angela Bassett, Kathy Bates, Lily Rabe, Evan Peters, Emma Roberts and Lady Gaga.


Zahid Hasan is kicking off 2017 by directing a new television series titled "Raju 420". Scripted by Zakir Hossain Ujjol, the play will include Zahid Hasan himself in the starring role.

Last year, the actor-director's play "Vagabond" was met with great success, and it is currently aired on Banglavision. However, the director is also anticipating the release of "Raju 420", saying, "Raju is a very ordinary man who takes it upon himself to support those in need and stand up to those that do wrong. However there are circumstances under which cheating is justifiable; Raju will never cheat those that are honest, but he seeks out those that earn money through ill means, and cheats them out of their illegal financial gains. I am doing best to portray Raju in the best way possible, going as far as to changing my appearance. I am quite excited for the series to reach its viewers."

Zahid Hasan informed the show will be aired on ATN Bangla every Saturday through Monday, and the first episode will premiere tonight at 10:45pm.

The actor recently took part in a commercial for a fan brand alongside seasoned TV actors Dilara Zaman, Chanchal Chowdhury and Farhana Mili, directed by Roni Bhowmik.

Zahid Hasan's momentous career began with the 1986 film "Boloban" directed by Abdul Latif Bachchu. After a hiatus spanning several years, the actor appeared in "Jibon Shongi" alongside Shyama in 1996. In 1999, Zahid Hasan was the recipient of National Film Award for his work in the Humayun Ahmed-directed "Srabon Megher Din". In the same year he began his directorial debut with "Onno Tepantor", also produced by him under the banner Pushpita Visuals.





People's Theatre Association yesterday organised a programme simultaneously with its 200 children's organisations and 80 youth organisations countrywide, to clean up their respective Shaheed Minar monuments. As part of the programme, about a thousand children and adolescents of 50 organisations took part in the programme at the Central Shaheed Minar, says a press release. Cultural personality and Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy DG Liaquat Ali Lucky inaugurated the programme. A cultural programme was also held on the occasion, featuring music, dance and recitation.

"Deadpool 2" is bringing back three supporting characters

"Deadpool" was not only one of the most successful superhero movies of 2016, but also one of the most surprising blockbusters in general. Made off a \$58 million budget, the Merc with the Mouth's first solo adventure went on to earn over \$780 million worldwide, and earned rave reviews from comic book fans and casual viewers alike. A performance like that guarantees a sequel, and sure enough, "Deadpool 2" is currently in the works. While no plot details have been revealed yet, writers Rhett Reese and Paul Wernick have revealed three of the supporting characters from the first movie who will be back for the follow-up.

First up are Colossus and Negasonic Teenage Warhead. While Reese and Wernick weren't willing to reveal to Collider how they'll fit into the plot, they did assure fans that they will appear in "Deadpool 2". "Yeah, they'll make at least an appearance," Wernick said.

For the most part, Deadpool was a selfcontained superhero movie, but Colossus and Negasonic Teenage Warhead served as the primary connective threads to the wider X-Men world. They first showed up to try to recruit Deadpool into the mutant superhero team, and later agreed to help him rescue Vanessa from Ajax and Angel Dust. Their personalities also played off of Deadpool's excellently; Colossus as the straight man trying to urge Wade to become a better person and Negasonic as the apathetic teenager unimpressed with the main protagonist's antics. Even if they aren't integral



to the sequel's story, it will be great to see them have more amusing conversations with the fourth wall-breaking anti-hero.

Then, during an interview with Nerdist, a conversation occurred about Dopinder the cab driver's role in "Deadpool", and Paul Wernick mentioned that he would return as well for the next movie.

While Dopinder's role in "Deadpool" wasn't nearly as important as Colossus and Negasonic Teenage Warhead's, he did have some amusing moments, namely with how he misconstrued Deadpool's advice and kidnapped his cousin Bandhu for stealing away the woman he loved, Gita. The last time Dopinder was on screen, he had just crashed his car, which had Deadpool's bag of guns on the front seat and Bandhu

Along with the above three characters, Wade Wilson will also share screen time with newcomers Cable and Domino in "Deadpool 2", although those characters haven't been cast yet. Behind the camera, David Leitch has taken over directing duties, and his action experience combined with Rhett Reese, Paul Wernick and Ryan Reynolds' humorous chops will hopefully blend well enough to make "Deadpool 2" just as appealing a movie as its predecessor, if not more so.

The movie doesn't have an official release date, but it's expected to arrive in theaters sometime in 2018.
