

Cricketer Sunny denied bail

A Dhaka court yesterday rejected a bail petition of Bangladesh national cricketer Arafat Sunny and sent him to jail after completion of his remand in a case filed under ICT Act.

The court also ordered the jail authorities to provide Sunny with proper treatment according to Jail Code, if necessary.

Metropolitan Magistrate Zakir Hossain Tipu passed the order after Sub-inspector Md Yahya, also investigation officer of the case, produced him before his court.

During the yesterday's hearing, defence lawyer said they went to the marriage registrar's office at Meradia in Khilgaon to verify the marriage. But the Marriage Registrar Officer Anwar Hossain told that he did not register such marriage.

The defence also submitted another petition seeking an order to investigate the so-called marriage. The court, however, did not pass any order on the investigation.

According to the case filed on January 5 by a 23-year-old woman, Nasrin Sultana, who claimed to be Sunny's wife, the cricketer threatened to reveal her indecent photos on Facebook. Sunny denied the allegations. He, however, acknowledged having acquaintance with the woman.

In the case statement, Nasrin claimed to be in a relationship with Sunny for the last seven years and also said that the couple got married on December 4, 2014. On Monday, the woman filed another case against Sunny claiming that he sought Tk 20 lakh as dowry.

Stay away from wrong path

Prime minister asks BCL activists

Asking students to stay away from drugs, militancy and terrorism, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday said those who will walk along this wrong path must face tough actions.

She was addressing a discussion on the occasion of the reunion of Bangladesh Chhatra League at the capital's Suhrawardy Udyan, marking its 69th founding anniversary.

She expressed her expectation that BCL leaders would give first priority to education and always remain devoted to upholding the glorious history of the organisation, according to BSS.

"There'll be student politics, but pursuing education is the prime job of BCL leaders and activists," she said, "BCL leaders have to get prepared to run the country and the state."

Hasina also urged the students to create awareness against the three social menaces and put up a strong resistance.

The premier said the nuisance of terrorism and militancy is a global problem although there is no place of militancy and terrorism in Islam, the religion of peace. "Islam never



allows the killing. The only place of a suicide bomber is the hell. No one can go to the heaven after committing suicide."

She also said the government will take actions against those who are misguiding the country's softhearted youths.

Coming down heavily on BNP, Ziaur Rahman and Khaleda Zia for patronising and pampering the war criminals while in power, she said they will be tried for this.

The Prime Minister said Bangabandhu prioritised education and nationalised 36,000 primary schools soon after the independence as part of rebuilding the war-ravaged country.

Hasina said steps are underway to establish at least one university in every district.

AL lawmakers criticise BNP-Jamaat in parliament

Discussion on President Abdul Hamid's speech in parliament kicked off last night in the House with ruling Awami League MPs focusing their talks lambasting BNP and its ally Jamaat-e-Islam for their misrule, corruption and violent anti-government movement.

Abdul Hamid addressed the Jatiya Sangsad highlighting the government's development activities and success on January 22 -- the first day of the New Year's session of the 10th parliament.

Chief Whip ASM Feroz last night piloted a thanksgiving motion on the president's speech.

Inaugurating the discussion, AL senior lawmaker Ali Ashraf lambasted BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia, and for their involvement in killing innocent people in the name of anti-government movement since late 2013.

Other MPs also followed Ashraf and concentrated their speeches praising Sheikh Hasina's government and criticising BNP-Jamaat.

The business advisory committee of parliament earlier decided that the House would discuss on the president's address for 45 hours.

AL MP Dharendra Nath Samvhu and Abu Reza Mohammad Nezamuddin Nakvi, among others, took part.

Rampal project rejected in mock referendum at CU

Teachers and students of Chittagong University (CU) casting ballots in a mock referendum on Rampal power plant have voted against establishing the project near the Sundarbans.

A total of 5,198 participants cast their votes that started on January 5 and concluded on January 21 -- an initiative of left-leaning student organisation Samajtantrik Chhatra Front (SCF).

Of the total participants, 4,777 voted for saving the Sundarbans (91.90 percent), world's largest mangrove forest, and 392 for the Rampal project (7.54 percent). However, 29 votes were rejected.

Engineer Delwar Mazumdar, member secretary of Chittagong chapter of the National Committee to Protect Oil, Gas, Mineral Resources, Power and Ports, announced the result yesterday at a programme at the university's Mukta Mancha.

Delwar said Rampal project, if implemented, will bring great disaster to the environment. "We can find out alternative source for electricity but it is impossible to find out any alternative for the Sundarbans," he added.

Hasan Maruf Rumi, coordinator of Gono Sanghati Andolan of Chittagong district, SCF central committee Vice-President Satyajit Biswas, Socialist Party (Marxist) Chittagong District unit member secretary Apu Das Gupta, and SCF CU unit Convener Fazle Rabby also spoke.

7kg of gold bars recovered from Dhaka airport

Customs officials recovered 60 gold bars, weighing around seven kilograms, from the toilet of a Regent Airways flight at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in the capital yesterday.

The gold bars, worth about Tk 3.5 crore, were recovered from flight RX 724 that came from Muscat, HM Ahsanul Kabir, assistant commissioner of Customs told The Daily Star.

On information that gold was being smuggled on the flight, customs officials conducted the search, he said.

The official suspected that the smuggler abandoned the gold in the aircraft sensing the presence of customs officials.

Nurul Islam, however, did not elaborate on the exact mode of operation of G2G Plus, but emphasised that labour migration cost would not be more than Tk 40,000.

Business insiders alleged that a Malaysian private IT company, which would manage the overall recruitment process online, had selected a cartel of 10 recruiting agents of Bangladesh to manage the entire process in exchange for huge money.

But Shahriar Alam said there was no scope of forming such syndicates as the government would strongly monitor the whole process.

"We will urge the people to be more careful about dealing with any agency for getting jobs. They must know about the job, salaries and other facilities before going for any deal," he said.

He was speaking as the chief guest at the

launching ceremony of the book, "Untold Stories of Migrants: Dreams and Realities," organised by Refugee and Migratory Movements Research Unit (RMMRU) at the senate building.

The book featuring the lives of 150 Bangladeshi migrants in foreign lands was edited by RMMRU Founding Chair Prof Tasneem Siddiqui.

Undocumented Bangladeshis who might be more than one lakh in Malaysia will get two years' time to legalise their status and find jobs, Shahriar said.

With multiple stab injuries in several parts of her body, including the left side of her face and hands, she is now undergoing treatment at the neurosurgery unit at the hospital.

Dr Tanveen Kamal, register of the neurosurgery unit, said, "She is still in danger. We have already completed five surgeries. But she needs one more surgery on her head, which will cost around Tk 2.5 lakh."

"Nasrin can see but cannot speak," said Dr Tanveen, adding, she may lose her memory.

Doctors at the hospital said it is necessary that Nasrin's family members stay by her side for her fast recovery but none of her family members, including her parents, have yet come to see her in the hospital.

The hospital staff has been bringing food for Nasrin but she needs money for her treatment, said the doctor.

"I really want to see my daughter and stay by her side but could not go to the hospital for having no money," said Nasrin's mother Forida Begum over the phone.

"I do not know where to get money for my daughter's treatment. I live on a three-decimal government land," said Nasrin's father Hanif Sheikh, 70, of Jonay village in Khulna. He said Nasrin's children are living with him in the village.

Rasel who fled the scene immediately after the incident is yet to be arrested. On December 7, Nasrin's father filed a case with Ashulia Police Station accusing Rasel. According to the case statement, Rasel had been stalking her for a long time. Ruhul Amin, sub-inspector of the station, said, "We have not been able to arrest Rasel as details about his identity could not be known yet."
