## Probe agency finds evidence suspect arrested against four Satkhira men

STAFF CORRESPONDENT

The investigation agency of the International Crimes Tribunal yesterday said to have found evidence against four Satkhira men, including the district ameer of Jamaate-Islami, over their alleged

involvement in crimes committed during the 1971 Liberation War.

They were "involved" in killing of six persons, torturing of 14 people and raping of two women in different areas of Satkhira Sadar and Ashashuni upazilas, the agency's coordinator Abdul Hannan Khan said at a press conference at its Dhanmondi office.

The accused are Abdul Khaleq Mandol, 72, Satkhira Jamaat's chief and former lawmaker; M Abdullah Al Baki alias Abdullah Hel Baki, 102; Khan Rokonuzzaman, 64, and Jahirul Islam alias Jahirul Haque alias Tikka Khan.

All of them are from the Sadar upazila, the coordinator said. Of them, only Khaleq Mandol is in jail, he added.

Later, Abdur Razzak Khan, the investigation officer of the case, handed over the probe report and other documents to the Chief Prosecutor Office.

Prosecutor Zead Al Malum said now they will scrutinise the documents.

N'GANJ SEVEN-MURDER HC accepts appeals of

17 death row

The High Court yesterday accepted the appeals filed by 17 death row convicts including Nur Hossain and three sacked Rapid Action Battalion officials against their convictions in two Narayanganj sevenmurder cases.

The HC also stayed the portion of a lower court verdict that ordered Tk 1 lakh fine for each.

The HC passed the order after a brief hearing on four appeals filed by Nur Hossain and former Rab official Arif Hossain challenging the verdict. On January 16, the lower

court sentenced 26 people including Nur Hossain and three former Rab officials --Tareque Sayeed Mohammad, Arif Hossain and Masud Rana -- to death. The court also fined the death row-convicts Tk 1 lakh each, Advocate SRM Lutfor Rahman Akand, a lawyer for Nur and Arif, told The Daily Star.

Narayanganj City Corporation ward Councillor Nazrul Islam, his driver and three associates along with senior lawyer Chandan Sarkar and his driver were abducted from Dhaka-Narayanganj Link Road in Siddhirganj on April 27, 2014. Later, their bodies were found in the Shitalakkhya river.

which has a wide variety of collections this year. The publisher has brought out 34 books so far. Of them, 25 are translated novels of authors like Isaac Asimov, Orhan Pamuk and Naguib Mahfouz. Among the books, "South of the Border, West of the Sun"

by Japanese author Haruki Murakami, a story about attempting to recapture the magic of the past, is highly sought. The novel is translated by Tapobrato Das.

Even children became a part of the literary journey as the publication brought translated versions of various children's books.

"Bisalakay Bondho Daitta" by Roald Dahl and "King Solomon's Mines" by H Rider Hagard both translated by Chunilal Mukhopadhyay were drawing much attention from the young bookworms.






