Missing man's decomposed body found

The decomposed body of a man was found in the capital's Badda lake yesterday, two days after he had gone missing on Wednesday.

The deceased, Mehedi Hasan Jahid, 32, worked as a supplier at his uncle's shop in Jatrabari, said Sumi Akhter, his wife.

On Wednesday morning, Jahid went out of his house. As he did not return, she filed a general diary with Jatrabari Police Station on Thursday.

Yesterday, locals found the body floating in the lake around 10:30am and informed police. OC Anisur Rahman of the police station confirmed the matter to The Daily Star.

Three die as picnic bus plunges into water body

Three people were killed and 15 others injured as a picnic bus plunged into a roadside beel (water body) at Mohadanga in Chapainawabganj municipality yesterday afternoon.

The deceased were identified as Ejant Ali, 65, son of late Hor Uddin; Abdul Karim, 35, son of Nazrul Islam; and Hashim Ali, 62, son of Rashid Ali,-- residents of Noyadiari village in Gomostapur upazila.

Mahabub Alam Khan, additional superintendent of police of the district, said some 150 people of Moyadiari village were returning from a picnic in Sadar upazila in two buses.

When the picnickers reached Mohadanga, one of the buses skidded off the road and fell into the beel around 4:30pm, leaving 18 people injured.

On information, police and firefighters rushed in and pulled out the bodies of Ejant, Karim and Hashim around 6:30pm. Eleven of the injured were taken to a hospital, the additional SP said. They feared that the death toll may rise, he added.
