

PRE-POLLS VIOLENCE Sylhet AL leader sued

OUR CORRESPONDENT, Moulvibazar A murder case has been filed following Sylhet pre-polls violence that killed two people. The victims were Saiful Islam, 17, and Sohel Mia, 34, of Osmaninagar upazila. Selina Begum, mother of Saiful Islam, on Wednesday filed the case with Osmaninagar Police Station against 218 people, including former upazila Awami League President Kabir Uddin, said Officer-in-Charge Awal Chowdhury. A clash broke out between the supporters of AL nominated chairman candidates of the upazila Ataur Rahman and his rival Akhtaruzzaman Chowdhury Joglu while both the groups were campaigning in Uttar Kalnichar area on February 26. Saiful was killed and 15 people were injured during the incident. The following day, Sohel succumbed to his injuries at Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital. Six people were arrested in this connection, said police. Election to the upazila will be held on March 6.

Missing girl found dead in septic tank

OUR CORRESPONDENT, Kusthia A three-year-old girl was found dead yesterday in a septic tank, 16 hours after she had gone missing from Iswarchandra village in Damurhuda upazila in Chuadanga. Damurhuda Police Station Officer-in-Charge (OC) Abu Zihad Khan said Mukta Khatun went missing around 4:00 pm on Wednesday. The incident took place when none including the victim's parents, was in the house. Local people found Mukta's body in a septic tank owned by Nasir Uddin, a neighbour of the victim, yesterday morning, the OC said, adding that the body bore marks of injuries in throat. Zihad said primarily they suspect the girl was strangled. Police sent the body to Chuadanga Sadar Hospital for autopsy. Police picked up owner of the septic tank Nasir Uddin and the victim's father Moniruddin alias Mister in this regard. The OC said they are being interrogated at Damurhuda police station.

Husband to die for killing wife 400-acre Kuakata forestland grabbed

OUR CORRESPONDENT, Natore A court here yesterday sentenced a man to death for killing his wife in Baraigram upazila in 2015. The convict is Kajol Kumar Sarker, 30, son of Sushen Chandra Sarker of Kalikapur village under Bonpara municipality of the upazila. Judge Rezaul Karim of District and Sessions Judge's Court also fined the convict Tk 1 lakh. According to the prosecution, Kajol used to torture his wife Mina Rani, daughter of Sadananda Paul of Sahebganj village in Atrai upazila of Naogaon, since their marriage in 2015. As continuation of the repression, Kajol strangled Mina to death on October 12, 2015. Deceased's father filed a case with Baraigram Police Station the following day.

SOHRAB HOSSAIN, Patuakhali Different real estate companies and some local influential people have grabbed over 400 acres of reserve forestland in Kuakata of the district. On the other hand, they continued giving threat to the staff of the local forest office, said Ajit Kumar Rudhro, divisional forest officer in Patuakhali. A section of realtors hung signboards there claiming ownership of the vast areas of land while the local forest office sent a list of 106 grabbers to the district administration to take stern action against the offenders. Divisional forest office sources said there are 3,503.80 acres of reserve forestland in two moujas under Gangamoti and Latachapl. Of them, 115.25 acres were grabbed in Gangamoti and 297 acres in Latachapl. Out of 30 lakh different species of trees in the forest areas, karai, tamarind, geoa and akashmoni are remarkable. During a recent visit, this correspondent found some real estate companies like Kuakata Assets Ltd, Sunrise Beach Resort, Basudha Builder Ltd and some influential people placed their signboards at different points in the areas. Of them, Kuakata Assets Ltd hung a signboard on 125 acres of land claiming its ownership in Kawer Char area under Gangamoti, about six kilometres in the east from Kuakata zero point. Another real estate company Sunrise Beach Resort also set up a signboard in the same area by felling at least 720 trees, alleged locals. Under social forestation project, 1.25 lakh different species of trees were planted on 125 acres of land in 2015-16 fiscal year, Md Jafor Ullah, officer-in-charge of Gangamoti forest camp, said, adding that a real estate company hung signboard there to grab the forestland. Basudha Builder Ltd, a real estate company, also grabbed a piece of forestland. Raja Nasir Uddin Khan, administrative officer of Basudha Builder Ltd, said, "After buying 58.65 acres of land from Kuakata Assets Ltd in 2011, we hung a signboard of the company. We learnt of the matter when a letter from the deputy commissioner's office reached us." Later, three cases were filed with the court against Kuakata Assets Ltd, he said. Abdur Rahman, director of Sunrise Beach Resort, said, "We hung signboard on our own land. We sold our land to Basudha Builder Ltd." Divisional Forest Officer Ajit Kumar said they sent a list of 106 land grabbers to the DC on February 16 this year to take action to save the forestland. Another letter was also sent to them on March 15 in 2016. The men of land grabbers are giving threats continuously to the staff of local forest office, he said. Contacted, Patuakhali DCAKM Shamimul Haq Siddiquee said they have started eviction drive in Kuakata area.

Man strangles wife, minor daughter

OUR CORRESPONDENT, Gaibandha A cable operator allegedly strangled his wife and six-month-old daughter over longstanding conjugal feud between the couple at Khamar Ballamjhar village in Gaibandha Sadar upazila early hours of yesterday. The dead are Nazma Begum, 30, and Sammy. Police arrested Nazma's husband Shamiul Islam in this connection. Quoting family members, Gaibandha Sadar Police Station Officer-in-Charge Mehdi Hasan said of Shamiul's three wives, Nazma was staying with him while two others were creating pressure on him for taking them home. The quarrel over the issue had become an everyday affair with his wife Nazma, the OC said. Besides, Shamiul sustained a huge loss in his business recently, Mehdi said. The couple got locked in a quarrel on Wednesday night and at one stage Shamiul strangled Nazma and then daughter Sammy, leaving them dead on the spot, the OC added. Local people rushed to the spot and caught Shamiul after his son Nazrul Islam, 12, raised a hue and cry for help as he tried to kill his son, the OC said, adding that on information police arrested Shamiul. All the incident took place before Nazrul, the OC said, adding that Shamiul confessed to the crime before the police. Police recovered the bodies yesterday morning and sent to Gaibandha Hospital for autopsy.

Woman hacked to death Husband arrested

OUR CORRESPONDENT, Moulvibazar A young woman was hacked to death allegedly by her husband following a family feud at Gangail village in Madhabpur upazila of Habiganj yesterday. Al Amin, 25, husband of the victim, was arrested in this connection, said Sajedul Islam Palash, officer-in-charge of Madhabpur Police Station. The deceased is Jharna Begum, 19, daughter of late Farid Mia of the village. Family sources said Al Amin married Jharna six months ago. After the marriage, Al Amin often tortured the victim over family feuds. Fed up with the incident, Jharna came to her father's house recently. Al Amin, of Rasulpur village, came to the house six days ago. Yesterday morning, Al Amin killed Jharna following an altercation. The body was sent to Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

'Not-for-sale' medicines on sale

Police seized a huge quantity of 'not-for-sale' medicines worth about Tk 2 lakh during a drive at Balapara village in Dimla upazila early Wednesday and arrested a man in this connection. Acting on a tip-off, a police team led by Sub-inspector Shahabuddin Ahmed of Dimla Police Station raided the house of one Mominur Rahman around 2:30am and recovered 20,330 pieces of tablets, capsules, injections and syrups meant for government hospitals from there. They arrested Mominur, 32, an employee of Dimla Health Complex working on contract basis, on charge of keeping the medicines in possession. After gleaming information, they produced Mominur before a Nilphamari court on Wednesday afternoon that sent him to jail. Officer-in-Charge Moazzem Hossain of Dimla Police Station said the seized medicines are meant for free distribution among the patients in government hospitals and health complexes. Police said an organised gang in collaboration with some employees of government hospitals steals medicines and sells them to different private clinics and medicine shops. Dr Rasheduzzaman, resident medical officer of Dimla Upazila Health Complex, said after investigation it will be clear whether the medicines are for Dimla Health Complex or not. SI Shahabuddin filed a case against Mominur, Jewel Islam and Safiar Rahman, son of an employee of the hospital. Nilphamari Civil Surgeon Dr Abdur Rashid said a three-member committee led by Dr Rasheduzzaman has been formed to investigate theft of medicines from the hospital.
