Trump doubles down on wiretap claims

WH requests Congress to probe if Obama admin abused power

President Donald Trump is asking Congress to look into whether the Obama administration abused its investigative powers during the 2016 election, White House press secretary Sean Spicer said in a statement yesterday.

The request came a day after Trump took to Twitter to accuse former President Barack Obama, without providing any evidence, of wiretapping his phones in Trump Tower in the weeks before the November election.

"Reports concerning potentially politically motivated investigations immediately ahead of the 2016 election are very troubling," Spicer said in the statement, which he also posted on Twitter. "President Donald J Trump is requesting that as part of their investigation into Russian activity, the congressional intelligence committees exercise their oversight authority to determine whether executive branch investigative powers were abused in 2016."

"Neither the White House nor the President will comment further until such oversight is conducted," Spicer added. He did not provide any further details on the President's request to Congress.

While Spicer said "reports" to that effect prompted the call for a congressional investigation, the White House still has not provided any evidence to back up the President's accusations. There are no publicly known credible reports SEE PAGE 2 COL 5

Polls to 14 UPs under new EC today

Fourteen upazila parishads in 12 districts go to polls today with much attention focused on whether the new Election Commission will be able to hold those in a free and fair manner. Fresh elections will be held in Sylhet's

Osmaninagar, Khagrachhari's Guimara and Sunamganj's Jagannathpur for all three posts of chairman and vicechairpersons.

The remaining 11 upazila parishads will see by-polls to fill some vacant posts, said EC officials. Four municipalities in four districts will also see by-polls for either mayor or councillor posts.

The EC has taken all out preparation to hold the polls in a free and fair manner, EC Director (public relations) SM Azaduzzaman told The Daily Star.

President Abdul Hamid on February 6 appointed KM Nurul Huda as the chief election commissioner (CEC) along with four election commissioners for five years.

Right after taking oath on February 15, the new EC got the task of holding some pending local government polls.

Fate of illegal BGMEA building sealed

SC rejects review petition against demolition

The Supreme Court yesterday dismissed a petition seeking review of its judgement upholding an April 2011 High Court order for demolishing the 15-storey BGMEA building illegally built in the capital's Begunbari canal and Hatirjheel lake.

It also asked the Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA) to submit an application by March 9 stating the time it would take to bring it down.

A three-member SC Appellate Division bench headed by Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha fixed to pass an order on the application that day. Attorney General Mahbubey Alam, representing Rajdhani Unnayan
