meeting with top officials of law enforcement agencies.
Contestants backed by Awami League and BNP are participating in the election scheduled for March 30.
Commenting on the outcome of the meeting, Nurul Huda said the EC does not have any plan to deploy the army in the election, but they would remain on standby. "They [the army] would be deployed immediately" if the situation calls for it.
With main political parties participating, this CCC election carries special significance, he said. "About 40 executive magistrates and necessary number of law enforcers would be deployed. Detectives will remain alert. We will take action according to information from detectives. Law enforcers in plain clothes will also be deployed."
Asked whether there is any likelihood of any militant attack, he said, "We will remain extra alert at Sundarganj. The polling centres are scattered in different places. So the law enforcers would be prepared against militants, fundamentalists and those who try to destabilise the country."
However, only the ones involved in militancy would be brought to justice and no innocent person would be harassed by law enforcers, assured the CEC.
Summing up the meeting, he said, they would ensure gaining people's trust on this EC through the CCC election.
Meanwhile, a proposed plan regarding deployment of law enforcers in Comilla stated that people who are not voters or residents of CCC must leave the area by midnight on March 27.
Any influential outsiders found to be present or exerting influence in the CCC area after March 27 would face legal actions, the plan further stated.

thieves in the village arbitration.
What's wrong in this?" he asked this correspondent.
UP Chairman Mozahar Ali Mollah said the arbitration was held following directives of the local police. He said he called up the OC and he asked him to settle the matter through arbitration.
The OC denied giving any direction.
The UP chairman said the goat of villager Rezaul Karim was stolen early Wednesday. Later locals held the two with the goat at Horian Bazar and handed them over to the villagers. "The villagers beat them out of anger."
He said the arbitration fined the boys' families Tk 20,000 but he cut the

penalty to Tk 16,000. Of the money, Tk 2,500 was given to the goat owner and the rest was donated to two local mosques, he said.
CHILD ABUSE IN RAJSHAHI
At least 29 incidents of repression of women and children were recorded in Rajshahi district in February, 23 of them involving children, according to the Ladies Organisation for Social Welfare, an NGO.
Shahnaj Parveen, executive director of the organisation, said they recorded 499 such incidents in the district in 2016 and 508 in 2015.
Dil Sitara Begum Chuni, president of Rajshahi divisional chapter of Bangladesh National Women Lawyers' Association, said child abuse was occurring due to a lack of public awareness and impunity to the abusers.
"People brutalise children of poor families," she said. "The law enforcers often show apathy in quickly responding to the incidents."
On February 14, locals tortured Ariful Islam, 12, in Puthia, accusing him of stealing a phone SIM card. Police later arrested two persons in this regard.
A week later, on February 21, the hair of transport worker Nazmul Haque, 12, was cut and his face was smeared with motor oil by his colleagues for damaging the CD player of a bus in the same upazila. Two abusers were later arrested.

WAR CRIMES IN GAIBANDHA Charges pressed against five

The prosecution yesterday pressed charges against five Gaibandha men for allegedly committing crimes against humanity during the Liberation War in 1971.
Prosecutors Mukhlesur Rahman Badal and Tapos Kanti Baul submitted the formal charges with the probe report, testimonies of the witnesses, and other documents to the International Crimes Tribunal-1 through its registrar office.
The accused are Abdul Jabbar Mondal, 86; Jachijar Rahman alias Khoka, 64; Abdul Wahed Mondal, 62; Montaz Alia Bepari alias Momtaz, 68, and Ranju Miah, 59.
All the accused are from Gaibandha Sadar upazila. Of them, Ranju is now in jail while the rest are on the run.
After completing the investigation on December 21 last year, the tribunal's investigation agency said to have found evidence over the alleged involvement of six Gaibandha men, including the five, in crimes committed in 1971.
They were "involved" in four incidents of killings, abduction, confinement, torture, arson and looting, the agency said.
But one accused Ajar Hossain Khan, 66, died on December 23 last year, Prosecutor Sabina Yesmin Khan Munni told The Daily Star yesterday. "So the prosecution did not press charge against him," she said.
According to the investigation agency, all the accused were involved with Jamaat-e-Islami during the Liberation War. Jabbar and Jachijar were arrested in 1972 on charges of war time offences but did not face trial, the agency said.
The charges involved killing of one Hindu man, torture of two Hindu women and forcing of around 400 Hindus of the Sadar upazila's Sahapara union to leave the country; killing of nine people at Nandina village and looting of around 50 houses; killing of five people at Doulatpur village; and killing of seven people in Sahapara union.
Meanwhile, the tribunal has shown six Khulna men arrested in a case filed in connection with the crimes committed in 1971.
The tribunal passed the order following a petition moved by Prosecutor Mukhlesur Rahman Badal.
The accused are Ashraf Sheikh, 79; Amzad Hossain Hawlader, 74; Mozahar Ali Sheikh, 64; Atiar Sheikh, 69; Motasim Billah, 79, and Kamal Uddin Goldar, 65 of Batiaghata upazila in Khulna.
All the accused were arrested on March 5 in connection with a criminal case and now in Khulna jail, Prosecutor Sabina Yesmin said.
Investigation of the case began on November 15, 2015, and the investigation officer has already found involvement of the total eight persons, who were involved with Razakar Bahini, the prosecutor said.
Of the eight, the tribunal issued arrest warrant against two on Wednesday but police could not arrest them yet, she said.

ERSHAD'S Tk 1.91 CR GRAFT CASE Verdict on plea against 3yr jail on March 23

The judgement on Former president HM Ershad's 25-year-old appeal against a lower court verdict of three years' jail term for corruption will be delivered by the High Court on March 23.
The bench of Justice Md Ruhul Quddus set the date after concluding hearing on the appeal.
Advocate Khurshid Alam Khan, lawyer of the Anti Corruption Commission told The Daily Star that the then Bureau of Anti-Corruption had filed the case against Ershad with Cantonment Police Station in 1992 on charge of misappropriating Tk 1.91 crore through abuse of power during his tenure as the president of the state from December 11, 1983 to December 6, 1990.
On February 3, 1992, a Dhaka court convicted Ershad, also chairman of the Jatiya Party, and sentenced him to three years' imprisonment for misappropriating the money and ordered the authorities concerned to confiscate the money as well as his Toyota Land Cruiser car.
Ershad the same year filed an appeal with the HC, challenging the lower court judgment.
Following the appeal, the HC stayed the lower court verdict, Khurshid said, adding that Ershad had obtained bail from the HC in the case as he served three years in jail in the case.

but the shortage of kidney donors makes it impossible as Human Organ Transplant Act-1999 restricts kidney donors only to close relatives -- son, daughter, father, mother, brother, sister, paternal and maternal uncle and aunt, husband and wife.
Dr Zafrullah said the law should be amended to allow all voluntarily donate kidneys, while there has to be a system to stop kidney trading.
The central registration authority will work in this regard and make sure the donors have incentives from the state and priority healthcare for the rest of life, he added.
Dr Kamrul Islam, managing director of Center for Kidney Diseases and Urology Hospital (CKD), said in the developed countries, 60 percent of the end-stage kidney patients have kidney transplants.
In Bangladesh, cost of a kidney transplant is only Tk 1 lakh to 2.5 lakh, while in corporate hospitals it is Tk 6 lakh to 10 lakh. In other countries, including India, Singapore and Sri Lanka, the cost is much higher.
Dr MA Wahab suggested introducing donation of kidneys of the brain dead.
Brain death is the complete and irreversible loss of brain function, which may be

caused by accidents. In such condition, organs like kidney of that person can be transplanted upon those needing it.
In medical university and divisional level medical college hospitals, there should be medical teams to determine brain death, he said.
Lawyers Manzill Murshid and Elena Khan suggested advocating for amendment to the Human Kidney Transplant Act and creating awareness on kidney donation.
Aliul Asif, 27, who donated a kidney to his mother when he was 20, said he required some medication in the first three months and then he faced no physical problems.
Marufa Islam, a kidney recipient, said she is physically fine, but needs medicines worth Tk 16,000 per month. She urged authorities to lower medicine price for kidney patients.
The GSK awarded Prof Kamrul Islam of CKD and Prof Harun Ur Rashid of Kidney Foundation with crests for their contribution to the treatment of kidney patients.
Professor of Gono Bishwabiddalaya SA Hafiz, Nephrology Prof Toukir Karim, Society of Urologists President SA Khan also spoke at the discussion chaired by Gono Bishwabidyalay Acting Vice Chancellor Prof Laila Parvin Banu.
