Mayor of Tungipara Municipality Sheikh Ahmad Hossan Mirja unlocked it the next day.


Executive Engineer SM Mainuddin alleged that Tungipara Jubo League General Secretary Imdad Biswas locked the office because he did not get a tender of the work.

Mainuddin said Tk 5 crore was allocated for building a 4 kilometre-long earthen road from Katakhali to Tarail. Imdad locked the office as he applied for the work but Md Ilias Hossain, a contractor of Karim Group got it, Mainuddin said.

"We informed the deputy commissioner of Gopalganj, superintendent of police, and office-incharge of Tungipara Police Station about the matter. Mayor of Tungipara unlocked the office on Friday," Mainuddin said.

Imdad said, "Some office staff took money from me but they did not give me the work. There was some disturbance at the WDB office, but I did not lock the office."







None takes JMB

Amijul's body lying in hospital for 10 days

Ten days into his killing in a 'gunfight' at Sherpur under the district, no relative of Neo JMB leader Amijul Islam has come to take the body from Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital in Bogra as of yesterday.

Amijul, 24, Neo JMB's military commander of the northern region, was living with his mother and her second husband Ataur Rahman at Bujruk Rajarampur village of Rajshahi's Godagari upazila. Amijul's mother Laili Begum said, "Police told me to take

the body. But I am suffering from severe weakness and high pressure and my husband does not support me to take the body. I begged to the police to send my son's body."

Abdul Jalil, additional superintendent of police in Bogra, said, "Amijul's relatives should come to take the body. Police can extend help for sending it if they apply to the police station concerned. Otherwise, it will be finally handed over to Anjuman-e-Mofidul Islam for burial."

Naogaon polytech student murdered

A student of Naogaon Polytechnic Institute was stabbed to death on Friday.

The deceased was Shyamal Chandra, 19, son of Gopal Chandra of Sonapur village in Patnitola upazila of Naogaon, and a 6th semester student of Computer Science of the institute. Police said a gang of 5/6 stabbed Shyamal near the insti-

tute around 8:00pm. He was rushed to Naogaon General Hospital and later shifted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital (RMCH) as his condition worsened.

But, the RMCH authorities referred him to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. Yesterday morning, he died on

the way of Dhaka. As the news of his death spread, students of Naogaon

Polytechnic Institute agitated, demanding immediate arrest of the killers.

Superintendent of Police Mozammal Haque said three people were arrested in connection with the killing.

Spring rain puts curse on potato, bricks

The sudden downpour harms potato in Munshiganj and damages raw bricks in Thakurgaon

Incessant rain for the last three days has brought woes to the potato farmers in Munshiganj while about 60 brickfields in Thakurgaon have suffered a blow due to sudden shower on Friday night.

The rain in Thakurgaon damaged huge quantities of raw bricks which were piled up in the open fields. As there is very slight chance of rain

at this time of the year, most of the brickfield owners kept the raw bricks under the open sky for drying.

Thakurgaon Brickfield Owners Association President Murad Hossain said on an average around 5 lakh raw bricks in each of the brickfields have been damaged due to the rain.

The extent of losses could go up to Tk 4 crore, he said. Besides, the rain has doused the fires

of several brick kilns and it cost Tk 1.5 lakh to relight a brick kiln, Murad added. Mosharul Islam, owner of ZMB

Bricks at Barunagaon village in Sadar upazila said he incurred a loss of Tk 10 lakh as the rain damaged his 8 lakh raw bricks which were piled for drying.

A number of brick kiln owners claimed that they will have to face trouble this year as most of them took

loan from different banks and nongovernmental organisations.

Away in Munshiganj, incessant rainfall in the last three days has added to the woes of the potato growers in the district and ruined their hopes.

A number of growers in Sadar and Louhajang upazila claimed that the potatoes which were left on the fields in the ongoing harvest period would be completely damaged due to the rainfall.

According to Department of Agriculture Extension in Munshiganj about 39,300 hectares of land were brought under potato farming in the district this season.

Punish attackers, return land: Demand Santals

Indigenous Santals formed a human chain along Rangpur-Bogra highway at Gobindaganj in the district yesterday demanding return of their forefathers' land and punishment of those involved in torching and looting their houses in the name of eviction at Sahebganj sugarcane farm in November last year.

Around 500 Santal men, women and children moved from Madarpur and Joypurpara, beating drums while parading around seven kilometres, to attend the programme organised by Jatiya Adivasi Parishad and Bagda Farm Bhumi Uddhar Sangram Committee.

The then Pakistan government in 1950's acquired 1842 acres of lands mostly belonging to the Santal community people and set up a sugarcane farm at Sahebganj in Gobindaganj upazila for supplying sugarcane to operate Rangpur Sugar Mills, speakers at the programme said.

started growing different crops other than sugarcane on the farm in violation of the agreement with Bangladesh Sugar and Food Industries Corporation, and so, the Santals demanded return of their forefathers' land that had been acquired.

The Santals erected huts on nearly hundred acres of lands at Sahebganj farm on July 1 last year and police on November 6 attacked the Santal occupied lands and police and locals torched and looted Santal houses, the speakers said, adding that police firing centring the incident left two Santals killed and many others injured, they said.

Terming lawmaker Abul Kalam Azad, Sapmara Union Parishad Chairman Shakil Akand Bulbul and sugar mills Managing Director Abdul Awal as instigators for the attack on Santals, the speakers demanded arrest and punishment of them and all those involved in the attack.

Meanwhile, a police report identified two policemen responsible for torching Santal houses in the area.

Leaders of Basatbhita Rokkha Committee at a press conference yesterday reiterated their demand for a fair list of the land to be acquired for divisional development They said they want development of

Mymensingh division but the fresh list of acquisition of 4,366 acres of land in Sadar upazila will bring disaster for the residents of seven villages. The implementation of the list means a 'gross violation of human rights, they said.

The proposed acquisition area includes vast tracts of farmlands and homesteads in Char Anandipur, Char Gobindapur, Char Durgapur, Char Jelkhana and Char Laxmir Algi where most of the people are small and marginal farmers and sharecroppers, they said.

They said the administration made a new list of 4,366 acres of land, cancelling the old list of 1,220 acres. Urging the administration to use khas

lands and lowlands on the banks of the Brahmaputra river, the leaders said they should implement the first phase covering 1,220 acres of land. They said the new land acquisition
