"The firearm of Halimul Haque Miru was used during the clash. Ballistics experts found that shots had been fired from the shotgun. They also opined that the pellet recovered from the victim's body was similar to the ones of the firearm," Monir Hossain, investigation officer (IO) of the case, told The Daily Star, quoting the ballistics report.

According to the ballistics report of the firearm, it is clear that Shimul might have been killed by the pellet of the mayor's gun, said Monir, also officer-in-charge (investigation) of Shahzadpur Police Station.

Miru, who was suspended from Sirajganj district unit AL's organising secretary post after the incident, and his brothers Habibul Haque Mintu and Hasibul Haque Pintu are among 14 people detained in connection with the murder.

The victim's wife filed a murder case against 18 people, including the mayor and his two brothers.

Police were trying to detain the

other accused, IO Monir said. They have already got vital informa-

tion about the incident (clash), he said. Findings of the ballistics report would help the investigation into the murder case, said the police official and hoped to file a charge sheet in the case

Miru managed to get his firearm licence from the Sirajganj district administration, showing his "fake freedom fighter certificate" in 2014. After the incident, the Muktijoddha Sangsad unit of Shahzadpur has recommended removing his name from the freedom fighter list for his "fake documents", said Binoy Kumar, commander of the Muktijoddha Sangsad unit.

#### Resume trial

ACC lawyer advocate Khurshid Alam Khan told The Daily Star that now the trial court would resume the trial at the current stage and finish the proceedings based on the statements already recorded from the witnesses.

The lower court had earlier recorded statements of 12 witnesses and would now hold arguments on their statements and deliver a verdict in the case following the SC order, he added.

On January 8 this year, the apex court directed the lower court to resume trial of the corruption case and also cancelled the High Court directive that had asked the lower court to finish the trial by March 31.

The SC passed the order after hearing an appeal filed by former air chief Sultan Mahmud, also an accused in the case, challenging the HC order.

The ACC then filed the review petition with the SC seeking its directive on the lower court to record statements of the rest 21 witnesses.

Following an ACC petition, the HC on November 24 last year directed the trial court to finish the trial by March 31. On December 19 last year, Sultan Mahmud filed the appeal with the SC challenging the HC order.

The now-defunct Bureau of Anti-Corruption filed the case against former president Ershad and three others in 1992. Ershad in collusion with others allegedly caused a loss of Tk 64.04 crore to the state exchequer by purchasing radars from the USA while he was in

power, said the case statement. On August 12, 1995, the trial court framed charges against Ershad, former air chiefs Sultan Mahmud and Mamtazuddin Ahmed and United Traders Ltd director AKM Musa. Musa has been absconding since then.

Nelson Mandela's eldest grandchild has publicly ditched the ruling African National Congress party over its damaging and seemingly endless scandals.

Nelson Mandela led the ANC from 1991 to 1997, carrying the party to an historic election victory at the end of apartheid when he

became South Africa's first black president in 1994. "I will not be voting for something

that does not resonate with me anymore, and does not resonate for what granddad and his comrades fought for," Ndileka Mandela, 52, told the News24 website at the weekend. Ndileka said her decision followed

"He is my only son. Please find him," she cried.

Sohel, a furniture trader in Gulshan, studied only up to class 10. Sohel and and disciples of Charmonai Pir.

They went missing on February 27 while returning to Narayanganj after attending a religious programme of the Pir in Barisal.

They were coming back in a launch and its operator was Momtaz's cousin, who dropped the two friends near Kanchpur in Siddhirganj. Getting down from the vessel, the duo was about to get into a car parked near the Kanchpur bridge. However, some men appeared at the

scene in a microbus and took them inside and disappeared. The launch operator saw it from the vessel, Momtaz claimed. They also took away the car, which

belonged to Hanif, holding the driver hostage at gunpoint, she said. The launch operator tried to call

Hanif on his mobile phone immediately but it was switched off. He then called Momtaz and told her what just happened. The next day, she came to Dhaka from Barguna in search of her son, who is in his early 40s.

The men, who "picked up" the two friends, left the driver near Purbachal area that day. The car is still missing, she

Talking to reporters on Sunday, Hanif's wife Kulsum Begum gave a similar description of the incident. She said, "Our driver Jewel took our car to Kanchpur bridge to pick up Hanif.

"After Jewel reached there, he saw a group of seven to eight people whisk Hanif and Sohel away by a HiAce microbus," Kulsum said quoting the driver.

Several other members of the group posing as detectives then forcibly boarded the car. They pointed firearms at Jewel and asked him to keep driving. As the car reached Purbachal area, they forced Jewel to get down and drove off, she said.

Talking to The Daily Star yesterday, Momtaz said her anxieties only increased after she heard the news of Hanif's death in Rab custody.

#### RAB'S ACCOUNT

Contacted, Mufti Mahmud Khan, director of Rab's Legal and Media Wing, rejected the claim of Sohel's mother.

Sometimes, he said, criminals Hanif, both from Barguna, were friends impersonating as police and Rab members abduct people, harming the reputation of law enforcers.

> He reiterated the claim that Hanif died in Rab custody following complaints of chest pain.

> Hours after a suicide bomber blew himself at a Rab barrack in Ashkona on Friday, Hanif was detained around 4:30pm after he tried to run away from a local restaurant sensing Rab presence. Later, he was taken to a Rab camp where he complained of chest pain, he He was then taken to Kurmitola

General Hospital where doctors declared him dead around 5:45pm, the official added.

However, Hanif's brother Halim Mridha said he filed a general diary with Siddhirganj Police Station on March 4, stating that Hanif and Sohel disappeared after disembarking from a launch on February 27.

Halim on Sunday said they learnt from media reports that a person named Hanif died in Rab custody. Later, they went to the Bimanbandar Police Station and confirmed that the deceased was indeed his brother Hanif.

Asked for comments on the incident, National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) Chairman Kazi Reazul Haque told reporters at a discussion at The Daily Star Centre, "Government should prove that their men were not involved. If they are involved, they should be punished."

Meanwhile, law enforcers were yet to identify Friday's suicide attacker at Ashkona and the biker shot dead by Rab men on Saturday after he "defied a signal to stop at a checkpoint" in the capital's Khilgaon.
