Introduction
Southeast University (SEU) started its journey in the month of June 2002 as a private university. The main objective of this university is to impart quality education to the young learners at an affordable cost in order to make them adequately capable to meet the challenges of globalization. SEU encourages to attract students from the less privileged segment of remote places of the country.

The Honorable President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh is the Chancellor of SEU. From the very beginning SEU has been following the policy of not treating education as a commercial product and has been firmly committed to serving the society without having any commercial motive, whatsoever. With the phenomenal rise in enrollment coupled with quality education, SEU is now comparable with any other renowned private universities in Bangladesh.

Southeast University Authority
The Board of Trustees (BOT) of Southeast University Trust provides policy guidelines and approves the University Budget. The BOT is headed by the Hon'ble Chairman, Mr. Md. Rezaul Karim, an illustrious industrialist of the country. The Trustee Board is the highest body of the University. It consists of BOT members and the Vice Chancellor. The University is run by a number of statutory bodies as required under the provisions of the Private University Act, 2010. The Vice Chancellor as the Chief Executive and Academic Head runs the University with the help of different statutory bodies.
