

### VERDICT LEAK CASE HC grants bail to SQ Chy's lawyer Fakhrul

The High Court yesterday granted bail to Barrister AKM Fakhrul Islam, a lawyer for executed war criminal Salauddin Quader Chowdhury, for one year in a case filed for leaking draft of Salauddin's verdict a day before a tribunal delivered the judgment.

It passed the order after hearing Fakhrul's appeal seeking bail in the case in which he was sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment and fined Tk 10 lakh on last September 15.

Now, there is no legal bar to Fakhrul's release from jail, his lawyer Advocate Zainul Abedin said. Soon after the pronouncement of the verdict in the war crimes case on October 1, 2013, Salauddin's wife and family members showed "a copy of the verdict" to newsmen, claiming that it was leaked before. Later, the tribunal authorities said a portion of the draft verdict was leaked.

## OCCUPYING GOVT LAND WITH FAKE DOCUMENTS ACC arrests real estate owner

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) yesterday arrested owner of Shah Ali Nagar Housing Estate of Mirpur Shamsur Ali and a retired data entry operator of National Housing Authority (NHA) Nuruzzaman in the capital's Mirpur-1 for occupying 4.26 acres of land through fake documents.

According to the case statement, then sub-registrar of Mirpur Mokhesur Rahman Thakur leased out the land, worth approximately Tk 2.78 crore, of NHA in Mirpur's Bishil to Shamsur at Tk 6,400 only ignoring the fact that the value of the land was much higher and the government would lose a huge amount of revenue.

Nuruzzaman helped validate the false document.

The case statement read, "The NHA had indeed never leased out the land to Shamsur."

Mokhesur was also accused in the case filed with Darus Salam Police Station on February 2, 2016.

Meanwhile, the ACC is going to file a case against an assistant authorised officer of Rajdhani Unnayan Kartipakkha (Rajuk) for allegedly amassing wealth worth Tk 1.47 crore.

According to the ACC, Ali Azam Mia, who joined Rajuk as a surveyor in 1991, has a six-storey building in sector 13 of Uttara and the amount of his total wealth is Tk 2.22 crore.

Azam opened tax return file with National Board of Revenue (NBR) in 2008-09 fiscal year, said ACC sources.

In the ACC's interrogation, Azam mentioned that he bought 1.5 acre land in Muktagaccha of Mymensingh from his grandmother Zebunnesa in 1985 with Tk 4,400. In 2010, he sold one acre of the land to one Jahangir Alam of Bhaluka for Tk 90 lakh which he spent for constructing the building.

The ACC's investigation officer scrutinised both deeds of 1985 and 2010 and found that no such land was sold to Azam in 1985.

In this way, Azam amassed a total of Tk 1,47,85,202, said the source.

He also concealed information of Tk 56,87,110 in his wealth statement submitted before the ACC.

The Daily Star tried several times to reach Azam over the phone but he did not respond.

## RAMPAGE AT DU BIJOY EKATTOR HALL BCL unit president, GS instigators

Finds probe

A probe body, formed after an incident of vandalism at Bijooy Ekattor Hall in Dhaka University on March 13, has found that Bangladesh Chhatra League president and general secretary of the hall unit "instigated" the incident.

The committee scrutinised CCTV footage and interviewed 22 students including the hall unit President Fakir Rasel and General Secretary Nayan Hawlader, and concluded that 15 BCL men were involved in the incident, according to the report.

BCL men chased resident teachers, went on a rampage and besieged the hall provost's room, and beat up a journalist on the night to take control of several rooms of the hall, as per the report.

The three-member probe committee formed on that night led by resident teacher Dr Asif Hossain Khan submitted the report to the university vice chancellor on Sunday, said a member of the committee on condition of anonymity. The Daily Star has obtained a copy of the report.

The report said Rasel and Nayan conducted several meetings with their followers at Rasel's room, the dormitory's TV room and guest room, and instructed the supporters to commit the act.

## Two Chhatra Sangstha activists held

Two activists of Islami Chhatra Sangstha, a female student wing of Jamaat-e-Islami, were arrested in East Bakalia of Chittagong city while they were circulating leaflets with "instigating remarks" against observing Pahela Baishakh.

The arrestees are Umme Habiba, a second-year student of physics at Chittagong College, and Rahnuma Rauno, a third-year student of economics at the same college, said Pranali Chowdhury, officer-in-charge of Bakalia Police Station.

The two, along with four to five other persons, were circulating leaflets among students at Ahmmediya Karimia Sunnia Fajil Madrasa. On information, police arrested the duo while others managed to flee, said police.

below 30. The figure is nearly 33 percent for single and lower houses, the study finds.

Citing the grim picture of youth participation in politics, Osoru said the study is an eye-opener for the entire world and the picture is worrisome for democracy.

The youths do not trust the politicians as they make pledges that they do not fulfill. They tell lies that discourage the youths, she said, adding that the youths prefer to engage in day-to-day business as politics bring no benefit to their daily life.

The survey finds that about one-fifth of the world population -- around 1.2 billion -- are aged between 15 and 24.

"Youths are innovative. They have new ideas and creativity... [they] have impact on democracy." So it is essential to restore their trust and engage them in politics, said Osoru.

The study shows that most of the 57 percent of potential voters, aged between 20 and 44, are reluctant to exercise their franchise due to mistrust in politics.
