Road crashes kill eight

Eight people were killed and two others injured in road accidents in the country yesterday.

Our Bogra correspondent reports, two persons were killed and two others injured as a sand-laden truck carrying them veered out of control and hit a roadside tree at Arulia Bazar on Bogra-Noagaon road in Bogra Sadar upazila.

The dead are Pavel, 22, and Jahangir, 35, of Shakharia village. The injured were rushed to a hospital.

Our Mymensingh correspondent reports, Phulbaria correspondent of local daily Ajker Mymensingh Shamsul Haque Sarker, 52, was killed in a road accident in Laxmipur area on Mymensingh-Phulbaria road in Phulbaria upazila.

He sustained serious injuries when a CNGrun auto-rickshaw ran him over while he was standing beside the road, said police. He was rushed to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital where he died around 8:30pm.

Our Savar correspondent adds, a farmer, Lal Mia, 65, was killed as a human-haulier ran him over while he was cutting roadside grass in Themukhi village of Dhamrai upazila yesterday. Police sent the body to DMCH for an autopsy.

Our Faridpur correspondent reports, Emon Gazi, 15, son of Lavlu Gazi of Madaripur Sadar upazila, died as his motorbike veered out of control at Kazirtake in the upazila.

Our Patuakhali correspondent adds, two labourers, Bikash Das, 35, and Mohadev Dhali, 45, both from Mirzaganj upazila, were killed as a brick-laden truck carrying them fell into a ditch beside Barguna-Barisal road at Amragachia.

Our Thakurgaon correspondent adds, a tractor driver, Sajib, 33, of Panchagarh municipality, died after he fell under the wheels of the tractor while boarding the running vehicle at Darikamari village in Panchagarh. At that time, his helper was driving the vehicle.


