

HSC EXAM Female teacher stabbed by outsiders

A college teacher was stabbed as she stopped some youths entering the centre during Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations in Gafargaon town on Monday.

Two youths -- Titu, 22, and Hridoy, 23, of the town -- were arrested in connection with the incident.

The injured is Assistant Professor Kazi Zakia Ferdousi of Department of English at Gafargaon Government College.

Md Amir Hossain, principal of the college, said the two arrestees wanted to enter the examination hall at the college around 12:00 noon on Monday.

After being denied, Titu and Hridoy waylaid Ferdousi when she was entering her dormitory on the college campus around 9:00pm. At one stage, they stabbed her and fled the scene, said the principal.

Hearing screams, the principal and other staff of the college rushed her to Gafargaon Upazila Health Complex.

Police arrested Titu and Hridoy yesterday, said AKM Mahub Alam, officer-in-charge of Gafargaon Police Station.

Principal's residence at lab!

The 'drawing lab' of Panchagarh Government Technical School and College is being unofficially used as the principal's residence for nearly three years, much to the disturbance of classes.

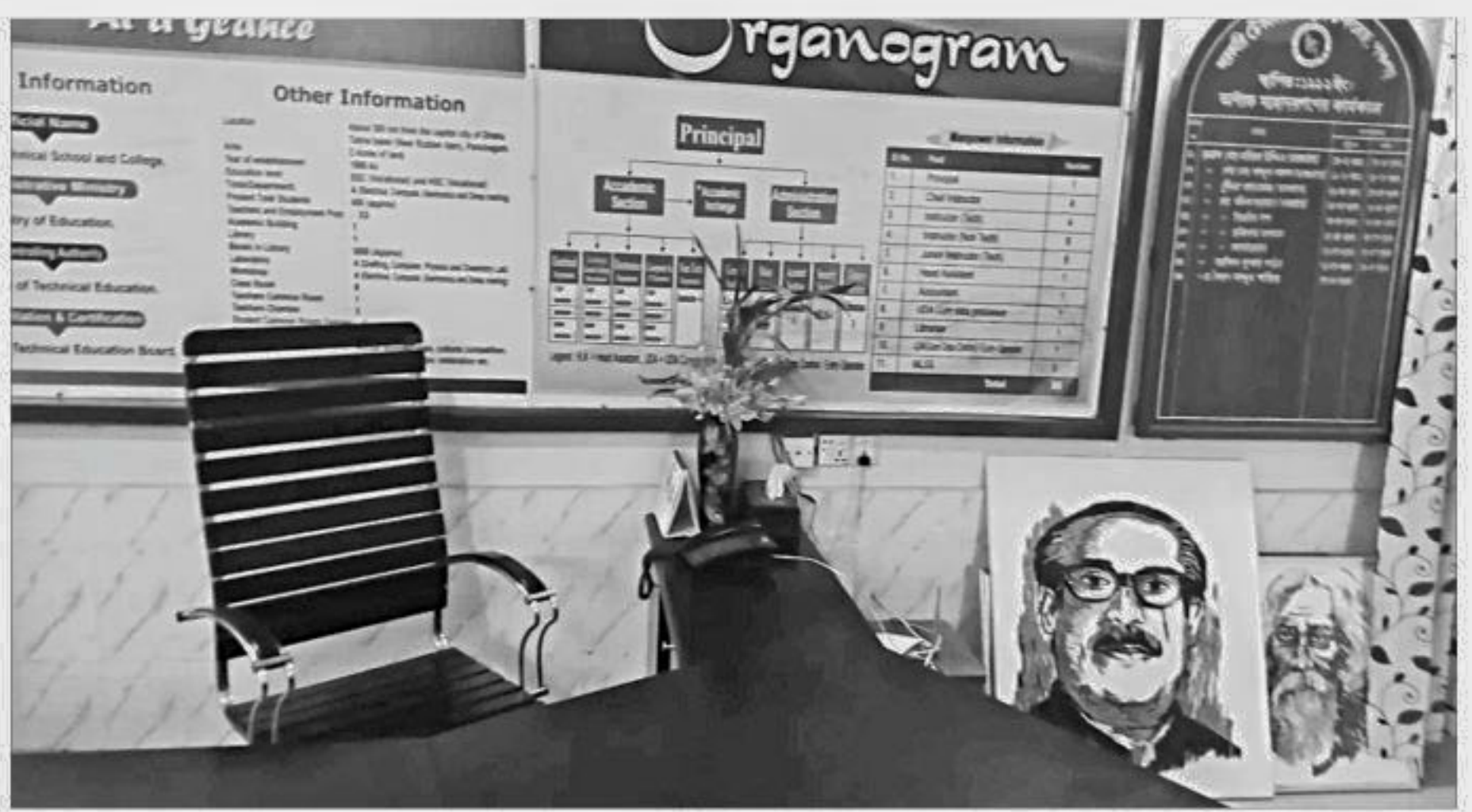
Principal Syed Abdul Aziz started residing there since July 2014, after building three rooms and two toilets with government allocation for building renovation, college sources said.

During a recent visit, this correspondent saw a portrait of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and another of Nobel laureate poet Rabindranath Tagore kept on

the floor of the principal's office. Asked why the portraits of the two great men were kept on the floor, he evaded the question.

After joining the college in 2010, the principal lived in a room of the second floor of the college administrative building and in July 2014 he started living at Surovi Bhaban, which was meant for drawing lab for science students, said several teachers and employees seeking anonymity.

Although he has been living in the college rooms for about seven years, every month he submits a declaration saying that he does not live in government quarters, thus evading payment of 30 percent of

Man to die for killing friend

A Netrakona court yesterday sentenced a youth to death for killing his friend in 2015.

The convict is Surjamal Mia, 30, son of late Lahut Mia of Kalmakanda upazila.

Netrakona District and Sessions Judge KM Rasheduzzaman Raza also fined the convict Tk 10,000, said Ziaul Haque, inspector of the court.

According to the case statement, Bhajan Chandra Das, 28, son of Sunil Chandra Das, along with his friend Surjamal went to visit puja mandaps on the occasion of Durga Puja on October 22 in 2015 and did not return home.

Villagers spotted Bhajan's body at Kalmakanda Bazar on October 26.

Police arrested Surjamal, after Bhajan's father filed a murder case with Kalmakanda Police Station the same day.

During police interrogation Surjamal confessed that he got Bhajan drunk first and then slit his throat with a sharp weapon to loot his money.

2 kids drown

Two children drowned in a pond in Panchbibi upazila of Joypurhat yesterday.

The deceased were Sima, 5, daughter of Sabuj Mia, and Rupa, 5, daughter of Roki Mia of Dakrapara village.

Police said the duo accidentally fell into a nearby pond at a primary school while playing on its bank at noon.

Later, the bodies were found floating on the pond around 5:00pm.

LOOTING, ARSON ATTACK IN PABNA

War crime convict Subhan charged

A Pabna court yesterday framed charge against death sentence recipient war criminal Moulana Abdus Subhan in the case for violence in Pabna's Chartarapur village in 2003.

Subhan, a top leader of Jamaat-e-Islami, was produced before the court of Pabna Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Rezaul Karim from Kashimpur Jail yesterday.

The court framed charge against Subhan and 26 others in the case for vandalism and arson attack at Chartarapur village on August 30 in 2003 when Subhan was lawmaker during the BNP-led government, said advocate Aktaruzzaman Mukta, public

prosecutor. Abdul Kuddus, a resident of the village, filed a case against Subhan and 30 others on April 2 in 2012 and police after investigation filed charge sheet against the Jamaat leader and 26 others.


Law enforcers arrested Subhan from Tangail on September 20 in 2012 in connection with the case and later the International Crimes Tribunal showed him arrested for 1971 war crimes.

The tribunal on February 18 in 2015 handed down death penalty to Subhan for his involvement in heinous crimes, including the killing of 400 people, mostly Hindus, in Pabna during the country's Liberation War in 1971.

'Robber' beaten dead in B'baria

An alleged robber was killed in a mass beating in Brahmanbaria's Kasba upazila on Monday night.

The deceased, Mamun Miah, 32, was son of Rahiz Miah of Kamalpur village under Kaiyampur union in the upazila.

People of Mondobag village caught Mamun around 9:00pm while he was roving in the area to commit robbery, said Officer-in-Charge Mohiuddin Ahmed of Kasba Police Station.

The villagers then gave him a good beating, killing him on the spot, the OC said.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to Brahmanbaria Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Mamun was wanted in at least five cases, including for robberies, added the OC.


AL FACTIONS' MEET Section 144 imposed
