of April 18, 2012, while BNP claimed that government agencies had picked them up to make them disappear.
Police recovered the abandoned car of Ilias, near his Banani home. Locals said they noticed the abandoned car with all its doors flung wide open.
Fakhru said BNP should go to different international organisations to discuss the disappearance of Ilias, and it could be most effective in finding the missing leader.
Referring to his recent visit to flood-affected areas of Netrakona, Fakhru said, "The way people responded against the government, I am sure the evil force won't be able to stay in power if we can unite ourselves."
Mentioning PM Sheikh Hasina's recent India visit, he said the present government lacked the ability to win a fair share of the Teesta river water as they did not have people's mandate.
"The prime minister could have said there would be no other deals unless the Teesta water sharing treaty was signed," Fakhru said. "The subservient government will not be able to realise the people's right to get a fair share of the Teesta river water."
Ilias Ali's wife Tahsina Rushdir was present at the programme, but did not speak.

somebody will lose. Rather, it is a positive game where everybody will win.
The government has done a lot and much more needs to be done on the CHT peace accord, he added.
Emphasising on adopt-

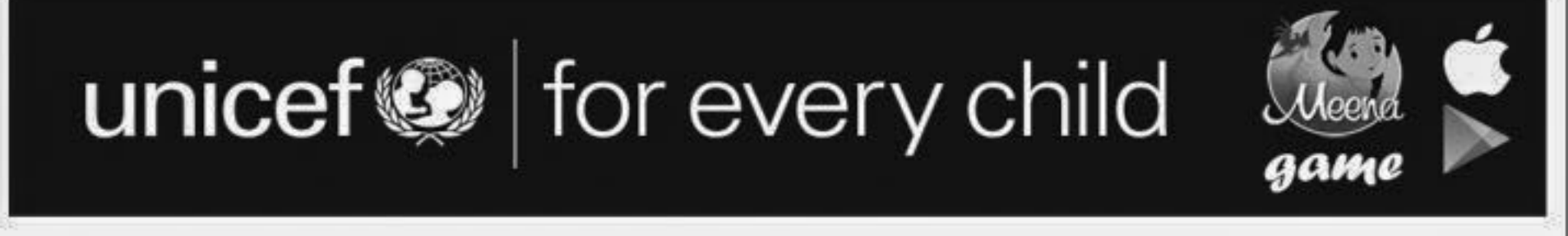
ing programmes to promote diversity, Gowher said diversity does not make a society weak. On the contrary, it makes a society stronger by enabling it better comprehend and address problems.
In order to build a strong and cohesive society, Gowher said, "National cohesiveness is very important, but we have to accommodate diversities to make a strong and cohesive nation. Recognition of diversity strengthens us because when we feel that our identity is being recognised -- we feel [that we are] a part of the whole."
He also said democratic institutions, processes and laws have to be tempered in pluralistic societies so the minorities are not excluded.
Dr Syed Anwar Husain, supernumerary professor of Dhaka University, in his keynote speech at the semi-

nar placed great emphasis on the necessity of promoting cultural diversity of small ethnic groups.
He outlined a number of proposals including publishing textbooks in ethnic languages and promoting ethnic cultures locally as well as internationally.
The government should have a framework of ethnic cultural policy to promote self development of ethnic cultures, said Prof Anwar.
Maj Gen (ret'd) Anup Kumar Chakma, former ambassador of Bangladesh to Myanmar, and Prof Meghna Guhathakurata spoke as panel discussants in the seminar.
Maj Gen AKM Abdur Rahman, director general of BISS, delivered welcome speech while Naba Bikram Kishore Tripura, secretary of Chittagong hill tracts affairs ministry, chaired the seminar.

model, was buried at Hetomkhan Graveyard in Rajshahi city on April 1.
Police recorded an unnatural case filed by the college authorities on the day of her death, while her father Mohamed Athif, a physician, lodged a murder case with a Rajshahi court accusing a classmate on April 10.
CID officials said they collected reports from previous investigators into both cases and began a new investigation.
Yesterday, a CID team led by Additional Special Superintendent Kazi Muhammad Shafi Iqbal visited Raudha's room at the women's dormitory of the college. The room had been sealed off since her death.
They took measurements of various items in the room including the door of her room at foreigners' block.
The CID looked into two aspects -- whether a woman of Raudha's height could hang herself from the ceiling fan using a scarf and a chair, and whether the door could be pushed open from outside, said Shafi Iqbal.
Measurements show that she would be able to hang herself, and the door could be pushed open from outside, he added. They also found that the door is the only exit from her room.
"We saw possibilities of

her committing suicide. It does not mean we found that she committed suicide. We are still investigating the case," he told this correspondent over the phone.
