Jordi Alba and Sergio Busquets paid a visit to former Barcelona team-mate Marc Bartra as he continues his recovery from a broken wrist suffered during last week's attack on Borussia Dortmund's team bus. Spain centre-back Bartra underwent surgery after the Dortmund squad was targeted by three explosions on their way to last Tuesday's Champions League quarterfinal against Monaco at Signal Iduna Park. A window on the bus shattered and Bartra also had debris removed from his hand, while the match was pushed back a day and Monaco claimed a 3-2 first-leg advantage. Alba posted a picture of the trio on Instagram and said: "What a joy to see you and to share laughs together, my friend." In an Instagram post of his own last Friday, Bartra described the ordeal of the attack as "the longest 15 minutes of my life".

Real Madrid will be without Gareth Bale as they look to book their place in a record seventh straight Champions League semi-final against Bayern

Bale is sidelined by the recurrence of an ankle problem picked up in Madrid's 2-1 first-leg win last week and is also a doubt for Real's crunch La Liga clash with Barcelona on Sunday.

The Welshman was sidelined for three months earlier in the season after suffering ligament damage in his right ankle. "Gareth worked very hard to get back

into the team after his injury," said Madrid coach Zinedine Zidane on Monday.



defender John Terry will leave Stamford Bridge at the end of the season, the English Premier League club said yesterday.

The 36-year-old former England

international played more than 700 games for Chelsea and has been their most successful captain. Terry made the third-highest number of appearances for Chelsea, captained them a record 578 times and scored 66

"After 22 years there is so much to say and so many people to thank at this great football club, "Terry said. "From coaches, team-mates and staff to the fans who have given me so much support down the years, I can't thank you enough.

"I will decide on my future in due course, but for now I am committed to helping the team achieve success this season."

"I will, of course, always be a Blue and am desperate to end my final season as a Chelsea player with more silverware," he added. "I've always been conscious that I depart at the right time,

in the right way, and I feel that the end of this season is the right time for the club and I." Terry, who made his Chelsea debut in 1998, won the 2012 Champions League, four Premier League titles, five FA

Cups, three League Cups and the Europa League.
