Hong Kong to tighten cyber security rules after broker hacks

Hong Kong plans to toughen information security rules after a series of embarrassing hacks at the city's brokers, the securities regulator said on Thursday.

The draft rules would likely include requirements for two-step authentication for account log-in and for brokers to notify clients when a transaction had been made, a Hong Kong Securities and Futures Commission (SFC)

In the scheme, criminals invest in thinly traded penny stocks and then manipulate their share prices by ordering trades from hacked brokerage accounts.

They earn profits by selling before the fraudulent trades are reported.

Hong Kong has been a favoured place for such attacks because of the number of thinly-traded penny stocks in the territory and because its securities industry has fallen behind other financial centres in defending against cyber fraud, Reuters reported in February. (here)

Venezuela illegally seizes auto plant: GM

General Motors said on Wednesday that Venezuelan authorities had illegally seized its plant in the industrial hub of Valencia and vowed to "take all legal actions" to defend its rights.

The seizure comes amid a deepening economic crisis in leftist-led Venezuela that has already roiled many U.S. companies.

"Yesterday, GMV's (General Motors Venezolana) plant was unexpectedly taken by the public authorities, preventing normal operations. In addition, other assets of the company, such as vehicles, have been illegally taken from its facilities," the company said in a statement. It said the seizure would cause irreparable damage to the company, its 2,678 workers, its 79 dealers and to its suppliers.

Venezuela's Information Ministry did not immediately respond to a request for information.

Venezuela's car industry has been in freefall, hit by a lack of raw materials stemming from complex currency controls and stagnant local production, and many plants are barely producing at all.

In early 2015, Ford Motor Co wrote off its investment in Venezuela when it took an \$800 million pretax writedown.

The HC asked them to hold voting in the secret ballot if it is necessary for recruiting its directors through election at the annual general meeting and to record the whole proceedings of the meeting in video.

The vacation bench of Justice AFM Abdur Rahman came up with the order following a petition filed by Adnan, Tamal, Rafigul and Tushar seeking necessary orders for smoothly holding the meeting and so that the petitioners can attend the function.

Petitioners' lawyer Barrister Mehedi Hasan Chowdhury told The Daily Star that his clients filed the petition under Banking Companies Act, apprehending that the meeting of NRBC Bank will not be held smoothly, as there are allegations of irregularities against its Chairman Farasath Ali and Managing Director Dewan Mujibur Rahman. The NRBC Bank authorities on April 6 issued a notice for holding its AGM on April 23 excluding the names of the writ petitioners, he said.

The lawyer said the HC passed the directives on the consents of the lawyers of the petitioners and the NRBC Bank, Attorney General Mahbubey Alam and Deputy Attorney General SM Moniruzzaman appeared for the bank, while Barrister Sheikh Fazle Noor Taposh and Barrister Mehedi represented the petitioners.

Value-added leather goods account for 76 percent of the exports in the sector with finished leather accounting for 24 percent. "I hope the ratio of leather goods exports will cross 80 percent at the end of this year as the value addition is increasing," said Islam.

Bangladesh's overall export has grown at more than 12 percent year-on-year in the last few years. But it has been 3.97 percent so far in the current fiscal year.

Exporters said Brexit has had a negative impact on Bangladesh's export earnings because of the depreciation of the pound against the dollar.

The UK is the third largest export destination for Bangladesh and imports products worth more than \$3 billion a year from the country.

Sales beat boosts Unilever's argument to go it alone

Unilever reported a surprise pick up in quarterly sales growth on Thursday, boosting its argument that it can improve performance on its own after spurning a \$143 billion takeover offer from Kraft Heinz in February.

The maker of Knorr soups and Dove soap, which earlier this month announced a business revamp in response to the takeover interest, said improving economies and rising commodity costs helped it to lift prices in the first quarter.

That offset a small dip in the volume of goods sold.

Chief Financial Officer Graeme Pitkethly said there was always a delay between economic improvements and a pick up in household spending and so Unilever expected a better performance in the second half of the year, helped also by its own easier year-on-year comparisons.

"We are seeing positive signs in the economy overall," he told Reuters, talking about a "bottoming out" of currency devaluations in places such as India, Indonesia and Brazil.

Unilever's underlying sales growth of 2.9 percent topped analysts' expectations of 2.0 quarter of 2016.

Growth was led by emerging markets, while pricing added 3 percent and the dip in margins, buy back shares, increase the divivolumes took off 0.1 percent.

The results, which outshone those of rival Nestle, sent Unilever's shares up 1.5 percent to 39.94 pounds, leaving them more than 19

percent higher than before Kraft's unsolicited, and swiftly rejected, offer.

Nestle, the world's largest packaged food company, posted sales growth of only 2.3 percent. Compared with Unilever, Nestle has much more exposure to the shrinking North American packaged food market, where a late Easter and one less trading day in the quarter compounded weakness due to changing consumer tastes and intense competition.

Even at Unilever, food was the weakest division, coming in flat, whereas the ice cream and tea business rose 5.4 percent and home and personal care products rose 3.4 percent.

Excluding the margarine and spreads business, which is to be sold, Unilever's group underlying sales would have risen 3.4 percent. Pitkethly said it was "a bit of a relief" to be able to finally "engage wholeheartedly" with private equity suitors which have been circling the unit for some time.

In a statement, Chief Executive Paul Polman said the results reconfirmed the strength of Unilever's business model.

To appease investors, some of which were disappointed by the company's refusal to engage in takeover talks, Unilever percent and 2.2 percent growth in the fourth announced plans this month aimed at lifting shareholder returns.


