



A legendary Bangladeshi theatre and television actor, script writer, director, civil engineer and also a writer, Abul Hayat was born in 7th September. He started his stage performance at the age of 10 and he is the founder member of the pioneer theatre group of Bangladesh which is "Nagorik Natya Sampradaya". He has acted in over 1000 television dramas, 1000 nights at stage, 100 movies, 100 radio dramas, done with modeling in 520 television commercials and written 26 books in total. He received several prestigious awards including the "National Film Award" for Best Actor in supporting role in 2007, and was also awarded the "Ekushey Padak" for his outstanding contribution in cultural fields in 2015 by the Government of Bangladesh.
