HULK PUNCHED YOU?

Hulk has been accused of punching the coach of a rival team on Saturday because he "despises the Chinese people", a claim his club Shanghai SIPG denied after their latest win in the Chinese Super League. Hulk allegedly punched Guizhou Zhicheng assistant coach Yu Ming at halftime during his side's 3-0 win. "Hulk cursed our assistant coach in English. We argued with him and he punched our assistant coach Yu Ming, who fell to the ground," said out-going Guizhou head coach Li Bing. SIPG denied the allegations on social media. "The claims Hulk punched the assistant coach of Guizhou are not true," SIPG said. "The statement of Li Bing and Yu Ming are inappropriate and they provoke hostility between the foreign players and Chinese people and it has affected the image of our club."

Arsenal shoot down Manchester United

Arsene Wenger bested Jose Mourinho in the Premier League as Arsenal beat Manchester United 2-0 yesterday to revive their challenge for Champions League qualification.

Quick-fire second-half goals by Granit Xhaka and United old boy Danny Welbeck at the Emirates Stadium condemned the visitors to their first defeat in 26 league games.

Arsenal remain sixth, six points behind Manchester City, who occupy the fourth and final Champions League berth, but they are now just two points below fifth-place United and retain games in hand on both Manchester teams.

Arsenal will approach their final four matches with hope intact that they may yet squeeze into the Champions League for the 20th season running.

For United, the Europa League now looks even more like their best hope of securing Champions League football for next season.

The visitors had two early sights of goal Wayne Rooney heading over and Anthony Martial drawing a near-post parry from Petr Cech, but it was Arsenal who made most of the running.

Persisting with their new 3-4-2-1 shape, the hosts were allowed to advance deep into United territory and chances soon arrived.

The second half was trundling along at the same, fairly pedestrian pace before two goals in the space of three minutes dropped victory into Arsenal's lap.

They took the lead in the 54th minute thanks to a huge stroke of fortune as Xhaka's speculative 25-yard strike smacked into Herrera's turned back and looped over the despairing dive of De Gea. Before United had had time to clear their heads, it was 2-0.

In the day's earlier game, Liverpool's James Milner missed a penalty in an uninspiring 0-0 draw with Southampton.

The Reds never got out of first gear at Anfield in a terrible contest best remembered for Fraser Forster's brilliant penalty save from Liverpool skipper Milner. Liverpool have now moved above Manchester City into third place.

Higuain breaks Benatia in live TV racism storm

Gonzalo Higuain fired a last-gasp leveller past England 'keeper Joe Hart to save Juventus's blushes in a 1-1 derby draw with Torino that kept the Serie A giants' title celebrations on ice Saturday.

Torino looked to be heading for their first derby win over Juve since April 2015 when Adem Ljajic put the visitors ahead minutes after the restart.

But Sinisa Mihajlovic's visitors lost midfielder Afriyie Acquah in the 57th minute after he was sent off for a second bookable offence.

And despite battling all the way, their hopes of causing an upset days after the club commemorated the 68th anniversary of the Superga air disaster ended when Higuain fired a low angled strike past Hart in the second minute of added-on time.

Italian football has been hit by a second racist storm inside a week after Juventus defender Mehdi Benatia was insulted live on air during a live, post-match television interview with Italian state broadcaster Rai.

Benatia, a Morocco international, was being interviewed following a 1-1 Serie A draw at home with city rivals Torino when it was cut embarrassingly short by what seemed like a studio technician's gaffe.

As he was speaking to studio presenters about Juventus, Benatia heard a voice over his radio earpiece say: "What are you saying, shitty Moroccan?"

Benatia, who had been answering a question about Juventus winning their



sixth consecutive Serie A title, stopped mid-sentence and said: "Who said that? What stupid person is speaking?"

Presenters also heard the remark, but tried to brush it off, telling Benatia: "It seems there are some technical problems. No one here has been heard making any insults."

A visibly angry Benatia wiped his brow as presenters thanked him for his time before bringing the interview to

an abrupt end.

It is thought the remark came from a careless studio technician who had left a microphone on, but it put racism firmly back in the spotlight a week after the controversy surrounding Ghana's Sulley Muntari.

Pescara midfielder Sulley Muntari said Saturday he felt "treated like a criminal" after being sanctioned for walking off the pitch during a 1-0 loss at Cagliari last week where he fell victim to racial abuse.

Muntari was booked by the referee for complaining about the abuse and then shown a red card for walking off the pitch in the final minutes.

After he personally appealed to league bosses, his ban was rescinded on Saturday when he said: "I was being treated like a criminal. How could I be punished when I was the victim of racism?"

Blackburn drop to third tier

Blackburn Rovers became the first Premier League champions to drop into the third tier of English football on Sunday whilst Newcastle claimed the Championship title on a nerve-racking final day.

Wins for another historic club, two-time European champions Nottingham Forest -- 3-0 over Ipswich -- and Chinese-owned Birmingham City, who beat Bristol City 1-0, condemned Rovers.

Blackburn were Premier League champions in 1995, but their fortunes have dived under the ownership of the Indian poultry firm Venky's.

Real reserves thrash Granada

Alvaro Morata and James Rodriguez scored twice as a much-changed Real Madrid moved to within three victories of winning La Liga with a 4-0 demolition of Tony Adams's already-relegated Granada.

Earlier, Neymar, Lionel Messi and Luis Suarez were all on target to take their combined tally for the season to 102 as Barcelona kept pace at the top with a 4-1 win over Villarreal.

Barca remain top thanks to their superior head-to-head record with the two locked on 84 points, but Real have three games remaining to the Catalans' two.

Real coach Zinedine Zidane continued his rotation policy of recent weeks with nine changes from the side that beat Atletico Madrid 3-0 in the first leg of their Champions League semi-final

on Tuesday as hat-trick hero Cristiano Ronaldo was left out of the squad entirely.

However, it mattered little as Real maintained their perfect La Liga record in nine games without Ronaldo this season.

"For a coach it is the best possible news," said Zidane.

"It means that everyone is involved,

in good physical condition, every time they get a chance to play they do well. I can only be satisfied with that."

Barely two minutes had gone when Lucas Vazquez got in behind the Granada defence and squared for Rodriguez to tap home the opener.

The Colombian then powered home a header from Fabio Coentrao's cross just nine minutes later.

Adams made a substitution after just 16 minutes as Uche Agbo replaced Aly Malle, but it couldn't prevent the one-way traffic.

"Real Madrid are at another level to us, they've got some fantastic players but we gave it to them too easily in the first-half," said Adams.

Morata blasted home Danilo's low cross then bullied Martin Hongla out of the way to fire home his 20th goal of the season.

Vazquez then hit the bar and Casemiro somehow shot over with the goal at his mercy as Madrid's dominance of the first 45 minutes left some Granada fans in tears.

Real had mercy on the hosts after the break, but now just need seven points from their last three games against Sevilla, Celta Vigo and Malaga to seal a first La Liga title in five years.
