

# Drive to ensure toxin-free mango

A mobile court conducted by Gangni upazila administration in Meherpur seized and destroyed 2600 kg of chemically treated immature mangos on Monday evening, launching such a drive for the first time in the district famous for mango cultivation.

Some dishonest mango growers in the upazila are harvesting immature mangos before the plucking season and mixing toxic chemicals to ripen those early, said SM Jamal Ahmed, assistant commissioner (Land) of Gangni upazila, also executive magistrate of the court.

"The mobile court raided Chitla village and seized a mango-laden truck which was being

taken to Dhaka, after mixing calcium carbide to quickly ripen the immature mangoes.

"None of the perpetrators were found on the spot as they fled the scene sensing the presence of the mobile court, the magistrate said.

The truck-load of mangos were taken to Gangni Upazila Parishad ground and destroyed there.

The upazila administration in a meeting with mango growers and traders on May 4 fixed dates for plucking mangos based on varieties, which will start from May 15, said officials.

"We will show zero tolerance to mixing harmful chemicals with mangoes," the magistrate said.

## 40 kg lead seized at Benapole

Later, the officials recovered the lead worth Tk 15 lakh from his baggage.

## Lightning kills 3

Two brothers and a schoolboy died in lightning strikes at Rauti village in Dhobaura upazila and in the town yesterday.

The siblings were Asad Mia, 45, and Engraj Mia, 40, sons of Abdul Malek of the village.

Officer-in-Charge of Dhobaura Police Station Shawkat Ali said they were hit by lightning while they were harvesting Boro paddy.

The brothers were rushed to Dhobaura Upazila Health Complex where the doctors declared them dead.

Meanwhile, a schoolboy was killed by lightning in the town the same day.

The victim was identified as Tamim, 14, a Class IX student at Mymensingh Zila School.

Tamim sustained serious injuries when he was hit by lightning while playing football with his friends at the school ground, school sources said.

Critically injured Tamim was rushed to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital where the doctors declared him dead.

# Brick kilns on paddy field

Toxic gas from brick kilns has damaged Irri-Boro paddy on 200 acres of land along with fruit orchards in Badalgachhi and Manda upazilas of Naogaon.

Protesting the incident, farmers of the areas continue demonstration, demanding proper compensation.

In Manda, Irri-Boro paddy on 90 acres of land got damaged by toxic gas from several brick kilns set up at Shahpur village in the upazila. Besides, the toxic gas damaged several commercial mango and guava orchards, said the growers.

Harun Ur Rashid of the village said paddy plant looked burnt with heat after it came in contact with the toxic gas.

He has a mango and guava orchard on 3.3 acres of land. The growing mangoes and guavas

dropped from most of the trees after turning black due to the toxic gas.

Besides, leaves of mango and guava plants also curled up due to the toxic gas.

There are two brick fields -- MCB Bricks and SAT Bricks -- in the village, said Harun Ur Rashid.

One acre of paddy land was also damaged by the toxic gas.

Farmers in the village suffered the same problem last year, said another grower Moksed Ali.

Sadequul Islam, who runs a nursery in the village, alleged that most of the plants in his nursery are dying due to the toxic gas.

Abdus Salam, manager of SAT Bricks, claimed that the crops were damaged due to other reasons, not the brick kiln.

Zahidul Islam, agriculture officer of Department of Agriculture Extension (DAE) in

Manda upazila, said he learnt about crop damage by the toxic gas from the brick kilns. He will submit a report after a field visit, he said.

In Badalgachhi, around 110 acres of Irri-Boro lands were damaged by the toxic gas from several brick kilns in Kismat-Pachgharia village.

Farmer Mehedul Islam of the village said half acre of his paddy land got damaged.

There are two brick kilns at the village, ARB Bricks and ABF bricks, he said.

Enamul Haq, owner of MBF Bricks, said he will pay compensation if the crop was damaged by the toxic gas from his brick field.

There are four more brick fields in the area, he said.

Salga Akter, agriculture officer of DAE in Badalgachhi upazila, said she visited the spot and found that the allegation was true.

## Abducted boy returns to parents

A minor boy, who was abducted from Manikganj on Saturday, was rescued from Sirajganj's Tarash upazila on Monday.

Detective Branch (DB) of Police also arrested Md Moazzem Hossain, 40, of Sakoaidighi village in the upazila for his alleged involvement in the abduction.

Victim Badhan Hossain, 8, son of Aslam Hossain hails from Ijdia village in Harirampur upazila of Manikganj.

Acting on a tip-off, the law enforcers raided Sakoaidighi village and rescued the boy in the evening.

They also arrested Moazzem from the spot, said Officer-in-Charge of Tarash Police Station Md Monjur Rahman.

Our Manikganj correspondent added, a gang allegedly led by Moazzem picked up the boy when he was returning home from his school on Saturday.

An anonymous caller then demanded Tk 3 lakh ransom from the victim's family, said his father Aslam.

After tracking the phone number, detectives raided the area on Monday and rescued the boy, said Manikganj Superintendent of Police Mahfuzur Rahman at a press conference at his office yesterday.

## Three JMB suspects held in Sirajganj

The brothers are accused of reorganising the banned outfit

The Rapid Action Battalion arrested three brothers on charge of organising the activists of banned militant outfit Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) from Dhubli Bottola of Solonga upazila in Sirajganj yesterday.

The arrestees -- Md Najibul alias Najib, 29, Mamunur Rashid Mamun, 35, Abdulla Bin Masud, 32, -- are sons of Maksudur Rahman of Aulipur village in Ullapara upazila of Sirajganj.

Acting on a tip-off, an operation team of Rab-12's Sirajganj camp led by Major Safayet Ahmed Sumon raided Dhubli Bottola area of Solonga yesterday morning where the arrestees had taken shelter.

The arrestees are accused in a case filed by the Detective Branch (DB) of police in September last year, on charge of organising JMB activists, said Major Sumon.

Earlier on September 20 last year, the DB raided the house of district JMB chief Joyal Abedin at Erandah the village in Solonga upazila and arrested Joyal among four suspected JMB operatives and recovered 50 jihadi books, 10 cocktails, huge amount of splinters for making bombs, and a packet of gunpowder.

During the drive, Najib, Mamun and Masud fled away from the scene.

"After the incident, DB police filed a case accusing Joyal Abedin and the three absconding brothers. The three arrestees will be sent to jail through the legal procedure," Major Safayet said.
