The New President Of Film Artistes' Association

Misha Sawdagar has been voted the new President of Bangladesh Film Artistes' Association while Zayed Khan the General Secretary. Montazur Rahman, the election commissioner, further announced Riaz as the Vice President with 328 votes. The election was held at Bangladesh Film Development Corporation. This election ended the presidency of Shakib Khan from the last election which took place in 2015.
