

# Under trial and imprisoned for nine years

HC asks jail authorities to produce 10 such prisoners

Dablu was 19 when he was imprisoned as a murder suspect. The next nine years, apparently the best period in his life, he spent in jail. At 28 now, Dablu is still to know about his fate although he was produced before the court an astonishing 110 times.  
He is among 10 under-trial prisoners who have been languishing in jail for more than nine years with little progress of the trial proceedings.  
On primary information, the High Court yesterday ordered the jail authorities to produce them before it and directed the trial courts concerned to submit records of the cases.  
Two HC benches also issued separate rules asking the government to explain why the under-trial prisoners should not be granted bail. Five of the prisoners have to be produced on May 29 and five others on June 1 before the benches.  
The HC came up with the orders and rules suo moto (voluntarily) after two panel lawyers of the Supreme Court Legal Aid Committee placed the issues of the under-trial prisoners before the judges for necessary orders.  
The under-trial prisoners are Dablu, now 28, Sharif Uddin, 26, and Bablu alias Bagha,

37, of Rajshahi; Mojibur Rahman, 43, Sanju, 27, and Sohel, 28, of Mymensingh; Zinnat Ali, 32, of Faridpur; Sarwar Hossain, 40, of Patuakhali; Zakir Hossain, 28, of Sunamganj, and Billal of Narsingdi.  
Mojibur, Sanju, Sohel, Zinnat and Sarwar will be produced before the bench of Justice AKM Abdul Hakim and Justice SM Mozibur Rahman on May 29, and Dablu, Sharif, Bablu, Zakir and Billal before the bench of Justice Obaaidul Hassan and Justice Krishna Debnath on June 1.  
The panel lawyers of the Legal Aid Committee, Chanchal Kumar Biswas and Rana Kawsar, told The Daily Star that the 10 had been in jail for more than nine years in criminal cases, but their trial proceedings were yet to be finished. After examination of the case records, the reason of the delay in their trial will be known, they said.  
Quoting jail authorities, the Legal Aid Committee sources said 462 people were in jail now, with their trial making little progress, and that the committee would give legal assistance to 58 of them who had been in custody for five to 10 years.  
The HC has so far granted bail to 18 people who had been in jail for more than 10 years.

## HC upholds ban on fishing in Bay

The High Court yesterday upheld a government order restricting fishing in the Bay of Bengal from May 20 to July 23 every year.  
The fisheries and livestock ministries issued a gazette notification on May, 20, 2015 prohibiting fishing in the bay between May 20 and July 23 every year to ensure smooth breeding of fish.  
Later on, Bangladesh Marine Fisheries Association President Ahsan Iqbal Chowdhury filed a writ petition with the High Court challenging the legality of the ban.

## Dhaka condemns N Korea missile tests

Dhaka has deplored North Korea's latest ballistic missile test and urged the country to refrain from such activity.  
"Bangladesh is deeply concerned at the launch of ballistic missile by Democratic People's Republic of Korea. By launching the missile, DPRK has violated its obligation under the relevant resolutions of the United Nations Security Council," said a foreign ministry statement yesterday. While reaffirming its commitment to the maintenance of peace and stability, Bangladesh urged North Korea to refrain from any activity which can potentially escalate tension in the region and beyond.

# 10 injured in Rajshahi Jubo Dal factional clash

At least 10 Jubo Dal activists were injured in a clash between two factional groups of the youth wing of BNP, in Rajshahi city yesterday.  
The clash took place in the presence of BNP standing committee member Goyeswar Chandra Roy at a meeting of BNP in the city's Uttara Community Centre. Rajshahi Mayor and city BNP president Mosaddek Hossain Bulbul was presiding over the function.  
Of the injured, Uzzal Sheikh was admitted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital. He received injuries on his forehead as he was beaten with a chair. Other injured Jubo Dal activists were admitted to different private clinics to avoid arrest, said BNP insiders.  
It all started at 5:00 pm when new General Secretary of Rajshahi city Jubo Dal Mahfuzur Rahman Riton asked former secretary Tofael Ahmed Raju to leave stage of the meeting, said police and witnesses.  
Soon afterwards, followers of city BNP president Mosaddek Hossain Bulbul and former president Mizanur Rahman Minu locked in a clash followed by chase and counter-chase.  
The meeting began at 6:00pm again after police brought the situation under control dispersing the feuding groups.  
One Jubo Dal activist named Shahan was arrested from the spot, said Shahadat Hossain Khan, officer-in-charge of Boalia Police Station.  
There is a conflict going on between city Jubo Dal president Abul Kalam Azad and former president Waliul Haque Rana over formation of the organisation's new city committee. City Mayor Bulbul is patronising Azad's group while Minu is backing the opposite group, said BNP insiders.
