

Five women honoured in Rangpur

Five women were selected as Joyeeta, a Bangla word for victorious woman, for their feats under five categories in Rangpur Division. They are Merina Lovely (education and employment), Shilpi Begum of Rangpur (successful entrepreneur), Shanti Kuzur of Dinajpur (successful mother), Bizoli Begum of Lalmonirhat (prevention of repression on women), Nur Banu of Thakurgaon (social development). Advocate Hose Ara Lutfa Dalia, a lawmaker, handed over the crests, certificates and cheques under the five at the auditorium of Rangpur Dinajpur Rural Service (RDPS) on Wednesday. The programme was organised by Rangpur Divisional Administration and the Department of Women Affairs. Shahin Ahmed Chowdhury, director general of the department; and Abdul Awal, deputy commissioner of Thakurgaon; Divisional Commissioner of Rangpur Kazi Hasan Ahmed were present among others.

Sylhet woman found dead

A woman has been found dead in Balaganj upazila of Sylhet after she went out of home to buy food for her children. The lower part of the body of Shafia Begum, 27, remained in a roadside ditch and the other on its shore, said police, adding that she was bleeding from her head. Locals alleged that she was gang raped and later killed. Shafia Begum, a mother of four children aged from seven months to seven years, had been living in her father's Goshpur Lamapara village house for eight years, said the family. On Tuesday evening, she went to nearby Janakalyan Bazar to buy food for the children, said her father Khasim Ullah. "That night, she didn't return. And the next morning, we found her body," he said. A Balaganj police official, seeking anonymity, said the woman might have been killed. Officer-in-Charge SM Jalal Uddin said the body was sent to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College morgue for autopsy with a consideration that she might have been killed after rape. They are waiting for the autopsy report, he said. Her husband Ponki Miah of Koloma village in the upazila is on the run following the incident, the OC said, adding no case was filed till yesterday evening.

NCTB fixes six errors

Another goof-up that took place on the back cover of "Hindu Shikha" for class-III students of the English version would also be corrected. The back cover reads, "Do not 'heart' anybody". The remaining three corrections deal with spelling mistakes, said an NCTB official. He also said the pictures of a goat climbing a tree to eat mango and a girl wearing a scarf will be modified in the next editions. The government has been facing widespread criticism from various quarters over a sizeable number of errors and anomalies, including spelling mistakes, wrong arrangement of paragraphs and omission of articles since it distributed some 36.21 crore copies of textbooks to 4.26 crore students from

primary to secondary levels on January 1. The issue also triggered a firestorm of protests on social media. Eminent citizens and different organisations too strongly condemned the anomalies. Many alleged that the government brought the changes following the demand of Islamist group Hefajat-e-Islam to exclude some novels and poems written by "Hindus and atheists". Following the criticism, both NCTB and the education ministry formed committees to identify those responsible for the errors. So far, the ministry took measures against nine NCTB officials by either suspending or transferring them. However, it did not take any steps regarding the changes made to the contents of the textbook.

and asked the prosecution to submit an investigation report or a report on its progress on July 27. Simon said Momin's father Abdul Majid Talukder was a Muslim League leader in Adamdighi and formed a "Peace Committee" there and became its chairman. Both Muslim League and Peace Committee worked against the Liberation War. Simon said Momin was the commander of Razakar Bahini in Adamdighi and the IO has found his involvement in at least two incidents of crimes where 15 people were killed and houses were looted and torched. However, Momin's brother Abdul Mohit Talukder said his brother was neither involved with Razakar Bahini nor committed any crimes in 1971. Though his father was involved with Muslim League, he was not involved with

Peace Committee, he said. Mohit, also the chairman of Adamdighi upazila parishad, however said after the Liberation War, a case was filed against his father and brother in connection with crimes committed during the war, but it was dismissed in 1974. "The allegation brought against my brother is totally false and was brought for political reasons. People involved with the ruling party are behind the case," he claimed. Earlier in 2011, freedom fighter Subid Ali of Kayetpara village under the upazila filed a case with Senior Judicial Magistrate Court in Bogra against Momin in connection with crimes committed in 1971, reports our Bogra Correspondent. Later, the case documents were sent to the International Crimes Tribunal for further proceedings.

injustice and corruption will go away," he said. "I can say with the example of every country in the world that the head of the state -- no matter how much powerful he or she might be -- bows to the law. Nobody is above the law. Judges are also not above the law." The judiciary is independent in the country but the judges are under control, he said. "We, the judges, have some ethics and rules, and we cannot go beyond them. We cannot do anything beyond the law as our powers are limited by the law. We interpret laws to enforce them for protecting the rights of the people. It will be wrong if anybody in the administration feels this interpretation was not correct because the constitution has empowered the higher court to give interpretations of the law," he added.
