BSS, Dhaka

Shipra Mondol, managing director of Tathyaseba Barta Sangstha (TSB) and wife of Ajit Kumar Sarker, a senior journalist of Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS), died at a hospital in Kolkata on Thursday. She was 55. She left behind her husband and a son. Family sources said she breathed her last at 1:30pm (local time) while undergoing treatment at Rabindranath Tagore Hospital. She was suffering from kidney related diseases. Shipra was taken to India last month for treatment. She underwent a surgery four days before her death. Her funeral was held at Kolkata's Kewratola crematorium yesterday.

27 'LGBT' youths held in Keraniganj

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) yesterday claimed to have arrested 27 youths of LGBT (lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender) community with some Yaba tablets and cannabis in Keraniganj outside the capital.

On information from locals, the youths were held around 3:00am from a community centre in Atibazar area, Jahangir Hossain Matobbar, commanding officer of Rab-10, told The Daily Star.

Locals have been keeping an eye on the "LGBT supporters" for a long time as they used to meet in the community centre every two months, he said.

They used to rent the community centre, the Rab official said, adding that they also detained the manager of the community centre.

"As they were not involved in any illegal sexual activities, we have handed them over to Keraniganj Police Station after filing a complaint under the narcotics act," said Jahangir.

The police station Officer-in-Charge Shaker Mohammad Zubayer said all of the youths are aged between 20 and 25 and students of different colleges and universities.

Most of them are from the capital and a few of them are from other parts of the country, he said.

Earlier, four LGBT supporters were detained in Shahbagh on April 14 last year, as they tried to bring out a procession celebrating Bangla New Year. Police, however, released them soon afterwards without pressing any charge against them.

Ten days into the incident, unidentified assailants hacked Xulhaz Mannan and his friend Mahub Tonoy to death in a Kalabagan flat on April 25. Xulhaz was an editor of "Roopbaan," the country's only known magazine for the LGBT while Tonoy was an LGBT supporter.

Police claimed banned militant outfit Ansarulha Bangla Team was behind the murder.

Death anniversary

Today is the sixth death anniversary of Al Musabbir Sadi, a sports journalist and former general secretary of Bangladesh Football Federation (BFF).

Sadi, also a senior member of the Bangladesh Sports Journalists Association, died of cancer on this day in 2011 at the age of 44.

After completing his master's degree in sociology from Dhaka University, Sadi started his career as a sports reporter at The Independent in 1995. He later worked at The Daily Star from 2004 to 2009 as a senior reporter before joining BFF in 2009.

NO END TO BLOODSPILL ON ROADS

Five lives lost

Five people were killed and 19 others injured in road accidents in three districts yesterday and on Thursday.

In Dinajpur, a man was killed and his wife and five-year-old son were injured as a bus hit their motorcycle on Dinajpur-Panchagarh highway near Goalpara village in Birganj upazila on Thursday night.

The deceased was Ziarul Islam, 33, of Majhboal village under the upazila.

Police said Ziarul along with his wife Shiuli Begum and son Zaid were returning home riding the motorcycle on that night. As they reached the place, the Dhaka-bound bus hit the vehicle leaving him dead on the spot.

The injured are being treated at Birganj Upazila Health Complex.

In Mymensingh, two people were killed as a bus hit a human-hauler on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway in Kathali Baghra area of Bhaluka upazila on Thursday night.

The deceased were human-hauler driver Ansarul Haque, 25, and his assistant Mahfuz Alam, 20.

In Nandail upazila of the district, a person was killed and 15 others were injured as a bus fell into a roadside ditch in Aamtol area yesterday.

The deceased was Sabuj Mia, 22, helper of the bus.

In Narayanganj, a pedestrian was killed as a motorcycle hit him while he was trying to save a child on Bhulta-Murapara road in Paragaon area of Rugganj upazila yesterday.

The deceased was Md Shahjalal, 45, of the area. The motorcyclist and his co-rider were injured in the accident.
