

Child house help tortured by employer in Ctg

A 14-year-old domestic help was allegedly beaten by her employers in Panchlaish Hamzarbag of Chittagong city on Saturday evening.

But the employers managed to cover up the incident by paying Tk 4,000 through a negotiation with the help of a local.

The house help is the daughter of Md Mofiz, a rickshaw-puller from Baizid Shahidnagar.

On Saturday evening, the employer, Dr Romana Begum, a medical officer of Chittagong General Hospital, phoned Mofiz to inform that his daughter had stolen Tk 2,500.

She also asked him to take her back by paying Tk 6,000, the father alleged.

When the parents reached the house they found their daughter was tied to a window grille. Romana along with her sisters were beating her with pieces of wood.

"They said they would kill my daughter and dump the body in a septic tank if she does not return the money. But my daughter was repeatedly saying that she did not steal anything," said Roshna Begum, her mother.

"Around 7:00pm, they drove us out of the house keeping my daughter inside. Local youths informed police after seeing me crying outside," said the mother.

"Later, police rescued her from the house and asked us to get a medical certificate from Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH)."

But the family went home instead and later took her to a local quack Musleh Uddin whose chamber is beside Romana's private chamber in the area.

also hoisted the flag of independent Bangladesh, with the map of the country, atop the perambulator of his one-year-old daughter and pushed it around Chittagong Cantonment. With the help of local youths and students, Bashar obstructed the members of Pakistan army to release arms and weapon from Pakistani ship 'Swat' at Chittagong port. From then on Captain Bashar became the arch rival of the occupation Pakistan army.

During non-cooperation movement in March 1971, Bashar was an inspiration for the Bengali army officers in Chittagong Cantonment.

After the crackdown of Pakistan army, he, along with his pregnant wife and daughter came out of his cantonment house to join the Liberation War. He shot down a helicopter of Pakistan army at Halishahar, Chittagong. When Pakistani military junta was disarming the senior Bengali army officers, he along with the young Bengali officers led the revolt at Chittagong. Bashar was 28 when he was killed by the Pakistani military junta.

on the grounds that the case was filed following newspaper reports and that police are yet to submit the charge sheet to the lower court concerned, he added.

The case was filed with Gulshan Police Station on May 26 last year against Aslam allegedly for hatching a conspiracy with Israel's Likud Party and its intelligence agency Mossad to oust the government.

He was arrested from the capital's Khilkhet on May 15 last year.

Aslam was also shown arrested in two other cases filed with Motijheel and Lalbagh police stations in 2015 in connection with arson attacks during the BNP-led anti-government movement. In the cases, he also got bail from the HC earlier.

99pc water used by slum

reservoir tanks, glasses, buckets, unwashed hands, insects and rodent vectors," Dr Abdur Rob said.

WaterAid Bangladesh's Country Director Dr Khairul Islam said Bangladesh made a progress by 2015 that 97 percent people use water from improved water sources, meaning either supply or tubewell water.

"Now, during the SDG era we are talking not about improved source, but of safe drinking water. From that perspective, it may be 68 percent people who drink safe water if we consider arsenic and faecal contamination," he said.

Citing recent studies, Dr Ishita Mustafa of icddr,b said one third of the country's under-five children suffers from chronic malnutrition. It is widely believed that poor hygiene and sanitation combined with unsafe complementary food predisposes infants and young children to malnutrition, she said.

Dr Dibalok Singha, executive director of Dushtha Shasthya Kendra, said the slum people mostly do not have gas supplies; therefore, they are less capable to boil water for drinking as the other urban people can. He suggested that Wasa should use sodium hydrochloride for water purification.

Dr M Feroze Ahmed, vice chancellor of Stamford University; Prof Ferdous Jahan of public administration at Dhaka University; Dhaka Wasa Honorary Chairman Dr M Habibur Rahman; Joseph Halder, head of advocacy at the NGO Forum for Public Health; Alok Majumder, country coordinator of Bangladesh WASH Alliance; Dr Suresh Kumar Rohilla, programme director of Centre for Science and Environment, India; Brig Gen (ret'd) Shahedul Anam Khan, associate editor at The Daily Star, also spoke at the discussion moderated by Liakath Ali, director (programme and policy advocacy) at WaterAid Bangladesh.

ACC sues ex-IFIC bank director

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) yesterday filed a case against a former director of IFIC Bank Limited for allegedly acquiring illegal wealth.

ACC deputy director Sheikh Abdus Salam filed the case against Mohammad Lutfar Rahman Badal with Ramna Model Police Station in the capital, ACC spokesman Pranab Kumar Bhattacharya told the news agency.

According to the first information report (FIR), Abdur Jabbar, a resident of the capital's Monipuri Para, earlier in May 2016 submitted a complaint to the ACC chairman that former IFIC Bank director Badal was involved in stockmarket scam and amassed a huge amount of wealth illegally.

Responding to an ACC notice, Badal's wife Soma Alam Rahman submitted a wealth statement to the ACC on August 8, 2016, on behalf of him.

After scrutinising the wealth statement, ACC found that Badal accumulated illegal wealth worth about Tk 60 crore and also concealed Tk 2.33 lakh in his statement, the FIR said.

Responding to another question, the analyst said the most obvious benefit for Bangladesh is the connectivity with various countries in Asia.

He said the BCIM (Bangladesh, China, India and Myanmar) economic corridor is a case in point and understandably, it is an important part of the OBOR project.

But the third Joint Study Group (JSG) meeting held in April showed that the tug of war between China and India is holding back its progress, Prof Riaz observed.

He said Chinese investments are on the rise and expected to grow further.

"However, I would like to ring a bell of caution here. Chinese investments in various countries, particularly in African continent in the past decades, have faced enormous criticisms ranging from controversial business practices to failure to promote good governance and human rights," Prof Riaz added.
