### Woman burnt with hot water over dowry in Rangpur

A husband has allegedly poured hot water onto his wife in Rangpur city as she refused to provide him with more dowries. Mariam Nessa, 24, wife of Masud Rana of Keranipara, sustained burn injuries from waist down to her knees, said doctors at Rangpur Medical College Hospital. Victim's brother Manik Mia said Rana had already taken Tk 3 lakh as dowry after the marriage and recently had started torturing Mariam for Tk 2 lakh more. On Friday, Masum first beat up Mariam, he said, adding, when she collapsed, he poured hot water onto her body. A case was filed yesterday. Rana is on the run, said Rangpur Sadar police.

### No official FB pages of PM, Rehana

The Awami League has clarified that there are no official Facebook pages of Prime Minister and AL President Sheikh Hasina, her sister Sheikh Rehana and daughter Saima Wazed Hossain Putul. The party cleared it after various Facebook pages, using their names, have been posting misleading and sometimes false news and announcements. The official Facebook of AL, at a post yesterday, made the announcement and warned people not to be confused by the fake ones. The post also mentioned Sajeeb Wazed, son of PM, and Radwan Mujib Siddiq Bobby, son of Sheikh Rehana, have verified Facebook pages, which they maintain themselves.

### UNFPA donates ambulance for Rohingya refugees in Cox's Bazar

The United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) on Sunday provided an ambulance for Rohingya refugees living in Kutupalong refugee camp of Cox's Bazar, said a press release. The ambulance was handed over to Research, Training and Management (RTM) International -- a non-government organisation. In the camp, UNHCR Country Representative Shinji Kubo, UNFPA Chief of Health Dr Sathyananarayan Doraiswamy and President of RTMI Dr Ahmed-Al Kabir, among others, celebrated the joint effort of UNHCR and UNFPA.

### Govt wants good ties with Hefajat: Moudud

The government is trying to be on good terms with Hefajat-e-Islam, BNP standing committee member Moudud Ahmed said yesterday, and called the ruling party an opportunist. The attempt, however, would not bring any result, he added, while speaking at a discussion at the Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh, marking party founder Ziaur Rahman's 36th death anniversary. Moudud said the government was staging a drama over removal of the statue of Lady Justice. "This drama is for votes," he said. Addressing the same programme, BNP secretary general Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir called upon the government to withdraw all cases and not to file fresh cases against its leaders and activists to create a level playing field for all in the next general election. "You will participate in the election and we will observe that from the court premises -- this type of election is not going to happen in the country," he said. "Of course, we want election, but that has to be meaningful and participatory."

## Steps taken to ensure hassle-free Eid trips

Says Quader; rules drafted for Uber service

Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader yesterday said his ministry had taken steps to ensure safe and hassle-free journey of people on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr. Three vigilance teams, comprising officials from different departments of the ministry, will work at Sayedabad, Gabtoli and Mohakhali bus terminals to prevent overcharging, overloading, and public sufferings, he said. "This year we started Eid preparations before Ramadan. We finalised our work plans taking experience of the previous years into account," Quader told a views exchange meeting with Bangladesh Road Transport Authority's officials at BRTA's head office. He said foreign tours of his ministry officials were cancelled till Eid, and monitoring teams had already been activated. Ansar men will be deployed to help police for traffic management in important entry and exit points of Dhaka city, the minister said. Trucks, lorries, and covered vans will not be allowed to ply the roads three days before Eid, he said. However, trucks and covered

vans transporting foods, essentials, drugs, garment products, and fuels will remain outside the ban, he added.

The minister said orders were already given to remove roadside kitchen markets and complete repairing all highways seven days before Eid. Besides, mobile courts will run operation to control unfit and outdated vehicles on highways and unauthorised parking in the city, he added.

BRTA will open a control room for traffic management in coordination with all stakeholders, and it would remain open for seven days starting four days before Eid.



Quader said they had requested the energy ministry to keep all CNG stations open 24 hours for 14 days starting seven days before Eid, and requested the garment factory owners to close and open their factories on different dates.

**DRAFT RULES FOR 'UBER'**  
The minister said a guideline for Uber, a taxi-hailing mobile application, was drafted, and it would be finalised after proper scrutiny. He did not give details of the draft.

Uber launched its service in Dhaka in November last year, promising to bring a change in the commuting experience in the busy city, and has already gained popularity.

## Prosecution allowed to grill two Sherpur war crimes suspects

International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday allowed the prosecution's petition to interrogate two Sherpur men in connection with a case filed against them for allegedly committing crimes during the 1971 Liberation War.

The three-member tribunal led by Justice Anwarul Haque passed the order following a petition moved by Prosecutor Rezia Sultana Chaman.

As per the order, investigators would be allowed to interrogate Emdadul Haque alias Kwaza Doctor and AKM Akram of Sherpur for one day each at the conference room of Dhaka Central Jail on May 11 and 12, Rezia said. Police arrested Emdadul and Akram following an arrest warrant against them on April 24.

Of the two other accused in the case, Aminuzzaman Faruk is now in jail while Mukhlesur Rahman alias Tara is

yet to be arrested. Investigation of the case started on November 19, 2015. Aminuzzaman Faruk was arrested after investigation officer found his involvement with wartime crimes, Rezia said.

During further investigation, the investigation officer found involvement of the three other accused, she said.

The prosecution is scheduled to submit the investigation report of the case on July 31.
