

### Newborn found in dustbin

A newborn baby girl was recovered from a roadside dustbin near the labour ward of Monirampur Upazila Health Complex in Jessore on Sunday night.

Nurse Sunila at the hospital said the girl is okay now after she was given primary treatment.

Upazila Health and Family Planning Officer Dr Dilip Kumar Roy said some employees of the hospital recovered the baby girl after someone abandoned the infant at a dustbin near the labour ward and admitted her to the hospital.

OC of Monirampur Police Station Mokarram Hossain said the hospital authority have informed him of the matter.

## KILLING OF WOMAN, DAUGHTER Man confesses to crime

A man arrested on charge of killing a woman and her daughter in Fulgazi upazila of the district on May 24, yesterday confessed to the double murder.

"The arrestee, Faruq Bhuiyan, 40, in his statement under Section 164 in the court of Senior Judicial Magistrate Dhruvo Jyoti Paul in Feni, said he beat and strangled to death Bibi Fatema and her six-year-old daughter Ishfa at Purba Basikpur village under GM Hat union of Fulgazi on May 24 noon," said MA Murshed, officer-in-charge (OC) of Fulgazi Police Station.

"After confirming their death, Faruq covered the bodies with a mattress and fled the scene. Fulgazi police recovered the bodies in the evening that day.

"Faruq, also a resident of Purba Basikpur village, used to sexually harass Fatema, which she protested," the OC said.

Fatema's mother Hosne Ara Begum filed a case with Fulgazi Police Station against unknown accused on May 25 and police on Sunday arrested Faruq with the help of locals.

## An ill-fated mother 85-yr-old Morium undergoing treatment at MMCH with injuries from fox bites

A woman has had to experience a most traumatic experience in the twilight years of her life, thanks to the utter callousness of her sons.

The ill-fated mother, Bibi Morium, 85, is now undergoing treatment at Mymensingh Medical College Hospital (MMCH) with injuries from fox bites.

She is already suffering from various old age complications, said doctors at MMCH.

Morium, widow of Muslem Uddin of Tejpatuli village in Phulbaria upazila, is mother of three sons and two daughters.

Of the sons, Muklesur Rahman works as surveyor while Mobarak Hossain and Marfat Mia are day labourers.

The sons, all married, live in tinshed houses but they treat their mother as a huge burden. They always treat her with utter negligence, said local people.

The trio serve food to Morium by rotation and she was recently sent

to Marfat's house as the turn of eldest son Muklesur ended on Wednesday.

Marfat became angry at his mother's return and as he could not send Morium to other brothers' houses immediately, he left her to sleep in his polythene wrapped cowshed beside a bush the same night.

When Morium was asleep, some foxes bit her legs early Thursday.

Hearing the hue and cry, locals rushed to the spot and rescued her, but Marfat did not take any step for her treatment till Sunday.

On information, the local union parishad chairman rushed to the spot and arranged Morium's treatment. She was admitted to Phulbaria Upazila Health Complex and then shifted to MMCH yesterday morning, Dr Md Nazrul Islam of the health complex said, adding that she might have been bitten by more than one fox.

UNO Lira Tarafder said they have already provided financial support of Tk 13,000 for Morium's treatment.

# Fishing rampant in Sylhet haors, rivers

A section of fishermen are indiscriminately catching different species of fish including fry and mother fish in the haor areas of Sylhet region, as the ban on catching fish in large water bodies was lifted last month after fish, livestock and birds started dying there.

Different varieties of fry and mother fish are also being caught with banned nets like mosquito nets and current nets from different areas of Surma, Kushiara, Bashia, Monu, Khowai and other rivers in the area.

Experienced fishermen and experts have expressed apprehension as such callous act badly affects overall fish stock.

While visiting Hakaluki Haor area and Surma and Kushiara rivers, this correspondent found fishermen catching fry and mother fishes with banned nets.

"Newly spawned fish fry feed on

the juice of their mothers' bodies. If the fry and mother fishes are caught in large scale, local fish stock will face threat of extinction," said Sahodub Biswas, 65, a fisherman of Chandpur area near Hakaluki Haor in Sylhet's Fenchuganj upazila.

After the water level decreased during the last several days in Hakaluki Haor area in three upazilas of Moulvibazar and two upazilas of Sylhet, fishermen are now catching fry and mother fish daily and selling it in local markets for high prices, said some fishermen.

One Murad Ahmed said he bought one kg of fish fry for Tk 390 near Hakaluki Haor in Dakkhinbazar area of Kulaura upazila in Moulvibazar.

"Some birds and animals eat small fishes in the rivers and other water bodies. Massive destruction of fry will also cause food crisis for such birds and animals," said Mohammad Ashraf Kabir, coordinator of 'Bhumi Sontan Bangladesh, a Sylhet-based environment and animal rights

organisation.

Different varieties of fish release eggs at different times, especially during March to July, in the shallow parts of rivers and haors and taking the opportunity, a section of fishermen indiscriminately net the fry and mother fishes, said Md Sultan Mahmud, senior fisheries officer in Kulaura upazila.

"Rampant netting of fry and mother fish now poses threat to 54 varieties of fish in the area. The malpractice should be stopped right now to protect the native varieties of fish," said Prof Dr Md Shahab Uddin, dean of the Faculty of Fisheries at Sylhet Agricultural University.

Mosharref Hossain, deputy director of the fisheries department in Sylhet division, said they are conducting mobile court drives with the help of the district administration in the rivers against illegal catching of mother fish and fry.

### Help get back my missing son

Mother appeals to PM

Rezwan's father Mizanur Rahman and elder brother Ripon Hossain were also present at the press conference.

Officer in-Charge Apurba Hasan of Benapole Port Police Station, however, denied the alleged abduction by the law enforcers and said he did not know anything about such an incident.

# Shortage of teachers in Bogra Govt College

Bogra Government College in the district town has been running without sufficient teachers as well as classrooms, greatly hampering academic activities.

Besides, the college has only one official to run the administration.

Two buildings, out of the three on the campus, are about to be abandoned while a floor of the new three-storey building has a laboratory, library and ICT laboratory. Classes are held in six rooms on two other floors.

A section of an old building is used as a teachers' common room, principal's office and administrative office.

The college is situated on 89 decimals of land in Satmatha area beside Sherpur road in the town.

Principal-in-Charge Md Faruk Ahmed said the college started its journey in 1965 as an attached institution with government polytechnic institute for diploma in commerce.

The college opened commerce group in 1981 and it was named Bogra Government Commercial College, he added. It was turned into Bogra Government College as a general college under Rajshahi Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board on May 12 in 2016, he said.

The college had been conducting its activities with an acting principal, three assistant professors, four lecturers and an office staff until the middle of last year.

After it was made a general college in 2016, the education board approved 23 subjects and admission of 650 students in the 2016-2017 session of Higher Secondary level in science, humanities and commerce groups. A total of 577 students were admitted to the college last year, and it has got permission to admit 850 students for the 2017-2018 session, the principal said.

Faruk said although it has been made a general college, no post for teachers and staff has been created so

far and the college has been running with eight approved teachers, including the principal, 12 teachers on deputiation and three or four office staff, instead of 48 teachers -- 24 assistant professors and 24 lecturers -- for 23 subjects and 30 staff.

Science student Selina Ferdous said there is shortage of teachers and laboratory facilities for them. There is also lack of library and residential facilities, she added.

Commerce student Himadry Sarkar said they are to depend on private tutors as they do not have sufficient facilities in the class and necessary books in the library.

Faruk Ahmed, also an assistant professor of accounting department, said the college authorities wrote a letter to the Ministry of Education on October 10 in 2016 for creating posts of 24 assistant professors, 24 lecturers and 30 staff and for establishing infrastructure for smooth academic and administrative activities of the college, but there has been no result visible as yet.

### Youth shot dead in B'baria

Police recovered the bullet-hit body of an unidentified youth aged around 38 years from Digirjan area alongside Kasaba-Akhaura road on Saturday morning.

Officer-in-Charge of Akhaura Police Station Mosarraf Hossain Tarafder said there were four bullet injuries on the victim's chest.

The body was sent to Brahmanbaria Sadar Hospital morgue. An unnatural death case was filed in this connection, the OC added.

Moniando Mia Parishad Member Firoz Union said criminals might have brought him there and shot him.

### College teacher hacked

Unidentified criminals hacked a college teacher in Pirojpur town early yesterday.

Critically injured Sadanando Gayn, 52, Head of Department of English at Pirojpur Government Soharwardi College, was first taken to Pirojpur Sadar Hospital and then referred to Khulna Medical College Hospital as his condition deteriorated.

Victim's brother-in-law Swapan Kumar said like the other days Sadanando went out of his house for having morning walk.

When he reached near the under-construction district jail on Pirojpur-Nazirpur road around 5:30am an unidentified criminal hacked him with sharp weapon on his forehead.

Hearing screaming, locals rescued him and admitted him to Pirojpur Sadar Hospital.
