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The fair showcases different species of mangoes, berries, jackfruits, litchis, oranges and lemons, common flowers like roses, cactuses, orchids and medicinal plants. A display of exquisite bonsais is also a key attraction.
More importantly, the rarity of some plants help highlight the wealth of the exhibition.
For flower lovers, there's even more reason to visit. Those who are keen to grow orchids in small and empty spaces of their apartments need to pay a visit to the stall of Dipto Orchids. Similarly, the nursery from Phulbaria of Mymensingh is solely dedicated for orchids.
Tanveer Hossain, a salesperson at the stall, said they have 50 to 70 different species of orchids in their nursery but brought only 20 to 25 of those in the fair. The price ranged from Tk 500 to 1,500 for each plant.
The month-long fair is open for all from 9:00am to 8:00pm each day.

government's decision to enforce a further increase in the gas price within a span of three months after the Consumers Association of Bangladesh (CAB) filed a petition questioning the legality of the move.
The HC also issued a rule asking the authorities concerned to explain why the decision to hike the gas price should not be declared illegal.
Households using double burners have been paying Tk 800 per month from March 1 while Tk 750 for single burners after the energy regulator raised the gas price for all consumers by 22.7 percent.

India eases movement thru 2 ICPs, 24 airports

Bangladesh nationals with valid visas to India can enter and exit from Integrated Check Posts (ICPs) at Haridaspur and Gede and 24 international airports without any restriction.
Earlier, ports had to be specified in the visa but now the ports (air, Gede and Haridaspur) do not need to be specified.
Clarifying further, a diplomat of the High Commission of India (HCI) told The Daily Star that Bangladesh travelers need not have ports specified in the visa if they entered through Gede by train can exit through Haridashpur by road or from the 24 international airports. "You can enter and exit from Gede and Haridaspur without restrictions," the diplomat added.
This move is being considered another major step towards easing of entry and exit restrictions for Bangladesh travelers to India, officials said.
The HCI in a press release yesterday said, as per revised guidelines, entry/exit restrictions were removed on visas issued to Bangladeshi nationals from 24 International Airports and ICPs at Haridaspur and Gede.
The international airports include Ahmedabad, Amousi (Lucknow), Varanasi, Bangalore, Calicut, Chennai, Cochin, Coimbatore, Dabolim (Goa), Delhi, Gaya, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Kolkata, Mangalore, Mumbai, Nagpur, Pune, Amritsar, Trichy, Trivandrum, Bagdogra, and Chandigarh.
