

## Withdrawal of case against two newsmen demanded

Journalists formed a human chain in front of Dumki Press Club in the upazila headquarters under the district about 11:00am yesterday demanding withdrawal of a case against two local journalists.

On May 16, the case was filed against Nipun Chandra Das, Dashmina upazila correspondent of the Asian Age, and Sanjoy Banerjee, upazila correspondent of the Dainik Janata, after they presented news over torture on a Hindu woman by a local gang who attempted to grab her land.

Sikder Golam Mostafa, secretary of Dashmina upazila unit of Awami League, filed the case with Dashmina Upazila Judicial Magistrate's Court under Section 57 of Information Communication Technology Act.

"After getting order from the court we started investigation into the case and later submitted a prayer to the court for more time for proper investigation. The court on Tuesday asked me to take lawful step after treating the case as an FIR," said Md Monirul Islam, OC of Dashmina Police Station. Nipun Chandra Das, also former secretary for Dashmina Press Club, said, "We have become victim as we presented news over a local gang's torture on Kanonbala, a Hindu widow of Purbo lipur village under the upazila, in an attempt to grab her land on May 8."

The gang led by a local influential man physically tortured Kanonbala after tying her hands and legs with rope. Informed, police rushed to the spot and rescued the victim. Her relatives took her to Patuakhali General Hospital.

On May 11, the victim's son Asim Saha filed a case accusing 14 people with Dashmina Upazila Magistrate's Court and main accused Abul Hossain is now in jail in that case.

Md Jasim Uddin, president of Dashmina Press Club, Mojibur Rahman, its secretary, addressed, among others, during the half an hour-long human chain programme yesterday.

## AGING COX'S BAZAR BRIDGE

# A disaster waiting to happen

An aging bridge on one of the busiest and most important national roads, the 151-kilometre highway from Chittagong to Cox's Bazar, is increasingly a serious threat to road users.

The fitness of the Matamuhuri Bridge, constructed in 1964 to span the river of the same name in Cox's Bazar's Chakoria upazila has been of concern for the past four years, when the large moulded section of the bridge first began to subside. The Roads and Highways Department (RHD) repaired the bridge using sandbags in order to keep the vital transport corridor functional and open for vehicular movement.

But two weeks ago the middle portion of the bridge sagged further. Iron platforms were then set up on the sagged portion as a quick fix; but the platform is now higher than the original level of the bridge, which caused a tourist coach to skid off the bridge, breaking the railing and plunging

into the river below. Twenty people were killed in the accident.

After the accident, the RHD repaired the broken railing and the bridge's sagging portion once more and reopened the bridge to traffic. Sandbags have been added to strengthen the girders, with brick walls built around the sandbags to hold them in place. But recent bad weather has again worsened the bridge's condition.

"Heavy rain over the last several days has caused the middle portion of the bridge to start sagging again," says Chakoria's assistant engineer of the roads division Abu Ehsan Mohammad Azizul Mostafa. "The road is kept under round-the-clock surveillance at the moment, and signs have been put up on both approaches warning vehicles carrying more than ten tonnes of cargo not to use the bridge."

"Accidents often occur on this bridge," says Chakoria upazila's former chairman Rezaul Karim, "It has been in a risky state for the past four

years. Many development projects are being implemented in Cox's Bazar; as a part of that development a new bridge over the Matamuhuri river is urgently required.

Cox's Bazar RHD Executive Engineer Rana Priyo Barua believes the Matamuhuri Bridge is a risk to users. "Maximum effort has been made to keep the road open," he says. "These types of bridges usually become risky some fifty years after their construction and the Matamuhuri Bridge was built fifty-seven years ago."

"Preparation work for a replacement four-lane bridge over the Matamuhuri river has begun," he continues, "with finance from the Japan International Cooperation Agency. The consultancy firm has visited the proposed site and a bridge design is being worked on. Construction may begin after two years." In the interim, however, the risk to road users posed by the bridge looks set to remain.

## 2 cops beaten by mob

A mob beat up four people, including two policemen, suspecting them of being robbers at Nakalia Ghat in Bera upazila of the district early yesterday.

The victims -- Sub-inspector Lal Miah, constable Chunnun and boatmen Khorshed and Noreh are undergoing treatment at Bera Upazila Health Complex.

"Lal Miah and Chunnun conducted a drive in the char areas of Shahzadpur and Bera on a boat on Tuesday night. When they went to the bazar near Nakalia Ghat around 3:00am for taking sehri, locals attacked and beat them, suspecting they were robbers," said Md Abdul Mottalib, OC of Bera Police Station.

"The policemen were not spared even after giving their identity. Later Bera police rescued the four victims," he said.

## MURDER OF SCHOOLBOY

# 2 siblings to die

A court here yesterday sentenced two brothers to death for killing a schoolboy in 2013.

The convicts are Nafis Hasan Nahid, 23, and Nazmul Hasan Nayeem, 25, sons of Shafikul Alam Hawlader of Adarshapara area in the town. Of them, Nayeem was tried in absentia.

District and Sessions Judge Md Golam Kibria also sentenced the duo to seven years' imprisonment and fined them Tk 50,000 each.

The court acquitted Shafikul, father of the two siblings, in the murder case as the charge brought against him could not be proved.

According to the prosecution, Sadman Shakib Prince, 14, son of Jakir Hossain Sarder alias Liton of the town, went missing on August 29 in 2013. Locals found his body floating on a pond in the area on September 1. Prince was a student of Pirojpur Government Technical School and College.

Later, the victim's father filed a case with Sadar Police Station, accusing eight people.

After investigation, Moniruzzaman Munir, sub-inspector of the police station, submitted a charge sheet before the court accusing Nahid, Nayeem and their father Shafikul.

Nahid and Nayeem killed Prince following an altercation over playing cricket, said the SI, also investigation officer of the case.

## Indigenous women clash with cops

Demand for arrest of Kalpana Chakma's abductors

At least seven women activists of Hill Women's Federation (HWF) were arrested yesterday after they clashed with police and members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB).

The incident took place when the HWF activists tried to bring out a procession in Swanirbhar area in the district town around 11:30am demanding arrest and punishment of Kalpana Chakma's abductors.

Three BGB men and six policemen sustained minor injuries as HWF activists clashed with the law

enforcers when the latter tried to prevent the HWF activists while they were about to bring out the procession.

Following a case filed by BGB Nayek Subedar Abdul Haq with Khagrachhari Police Station, police detained eight people including seven HWF activists, said Sub-inspector Mohammad Hayatulla of the police station.

Protesting the arrest, activists of HWF vandalised a number of vehicles in different areas of the town.

## 18 people infected with anthrax in Sirajganj

Eighteen people have been infected with anthrax at Kaliakore village in Ullapara upazila of Sirajganj in the last 24 hours, according to upazila health complex officials.

All the patients are being given treatment at the hospital while a medical team has been kept alert in the village to identify more patients, said Dr Jafrul Hasan, Ullapara upazila health and family planning officer.

Md Abdur Rahman of the village slaughtered a diseased cow on May 29 and distributed meat among the people, he said.

People who came in touch with the

meat fell sick and all of them are infected with anthrax, said the doctor.

Earlier, 25 people were infected with 'anthrax' at Jantihar village of Faridpur upazila in Pabna five days ago. Of them, one died on June 2.

The deceased was Md Alauddin, 12, son of Golam Mostafa of Jantihar village. He took part when a diseased cow was slaughtered in the village last week, said family members.

Anthrax outbreaks at Jantihar village in the upazila started after slaughtering of two diseased cows on May 27, said locals.

People engaged with the meat processing were infected with anthrax, said Livestock Officer Md Kamruzzaman.

## Widow raped by neighbour

A widow was raped allegedly by a neighbour at Dharmonagar village in Akhaura upazila on Monday night.

The 24-year-old victim, who lives with her child at her village home, is now undergoing treatment at Brahmanbaria Sadar Hospital.

Officer-in-Charge of Akhaura Police Station Mosharraf Hossain Tarafder said Bashir Mia, 35, son of late Abdul Wahab, raped the woman while she was returning to her room from toilet.

Police arrested Bashir early Tuesday and produced him before a court that sent him to jail.
