(VIP, first and second class cabins) will start from June 15 and launches for Patuakhali and Galachipa routes will leave Dhaka from Waiz Ghat, he said.

However, a leader of Bangladesh Inland Waterways (passenger carriers) Association claimed that passengers have already started buying advance tickets for launch cabins and selling of advance tickets is "almost done".

"Fixing the date for selling tickets is just for show," he alleged.

Zainal, however, refuted the allegation. "Several launch owners told the meeting that they have enough tickets," he added.

Usually 70 to 75 launches ply the 41 routes from Sadarghat, he said. "Around 200 launches will operate during the Eid vacation."

Every year, tens of thousands of people leave the capital to celebrate Eid with near and dear ones at their village homes. But their journey home often turns bitter largely due to traffic jam, overcharging of tickets and delays in bus and train schedule.

However, Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader and the authorities concerned said that they had taken steps to ensure safe and hassle-free journey on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr.

## BAEC bill placed at JS

A bill titled "Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission Bill, 2017" was placed in parliament yesterday to update the version of the "Bangladesh Atomic Commission Order, 1973" in Bangla.

Science and Technology Minister Architect Yafesh Osman placed the bill in the House, which was sent to the respective Parliamentary Standing Committee for further scrutiny.

The committee was asked to submit its report within a month.

According to the new law the commission will be constituted with maximum four members, including a chairman with a science and technology background.

The head office of the commission will be situated in the capital while any branch can be set up in any place of the country with a prior government permission.

The commission will work for a peaceful use of atomic power in the areas of food, agriculture, health, medicare, environment and industries.

It will also work for development of electronic machinery, design, technologies and useful appliance, and conduct educational programmes, and service, implement nuclear projects and carry out research and development.

Gas-rich Qatar is home to nearly 4 lakh Bangladeshis. It has been recruiting workers from Bangladesh without any interruption in the last several years for its construction projects for the World Cup.  
Bangladesh, which follows the "friendship with all, malice towards none" foreign policy, is facing a serious dilemma over the conflicting situation and is expecting early solution to the diplomatic rift as both Saudi Arabia and Qatar are important to Bangladesh.  
Bangladesh maintains strong relations with both Saudi Arabia and Qatar, as both countries are major destinations for Bangladeshi workers.  
Bangladesh is also the founder member of Saudi-led Islamic Military Alliance aimed to fight against terrorism and violent extremism. Bangladesh also supported Saudi-led strikes in Yemen against rebel Houthis fighters.  
The Gulf recruits over 70 percent of Bangladesh's nearly 90 lakh migrant workers. Sixty percent of the \$15 billion remittance Bangladesh receives a year come from the Gulf region.

centre would be set up at a cost of Tk 60 crore to develop design of the leather goods and footwear.  
Leather-goods and Footwear Manufacturers and Exporters Association of Bangladesh, a trade body representing the sector, will receive the fund from the government to set up and operate the design centre.  
The exporters will continue receiving the cash incentives up to 2021 as instrumental to promote the export.  
The news agency has obtained a copy of the draft policy, which was prepared through a process of inter-ministerial workshops and consultation meetings.  
At present, the country annually exports about \$1.16 billion of leather goods and footwear products. As per the proposed policy, the export is targeted to reach 5 billion when the country's total export will stand at 60 billion.
