

### Notice served on govt seeking judicial probe into Longadu attacks

A legal notice was sent yesterday to the government for forming a judicial enquiry committee in three days to ascertain whether there was any negligence of the local administration in protecting the people in Longadu upazila of Rangamati during the June 2 arson attacks.  
A retired judge of the High Court will head the committee, Nicolas Chakma, a Supreme Court lawyer and a resident of Khagrachhari, demanded in the legal notice.  
In the notice, Nicolas also asked the government to find out the extent of damage caused by the arson attacks carried out by Bangalee settlers in three villages of Longadu.  
The committee will have to ascertain what action has been taken by the government to rehabilitate the affected people, the legal notice said.  
Nicolas further said he would file a writ petition with the High Court against the respondents, if they do not form the judicial enquiry committee in three days.  
The home secretary, social welfare secretary, women and children affairs secretary, Chittagong hill tracts affairs secretary, inspector general of police, deputy inspector of general (Chittagong range), deputy commissioner and superintendent of police in Rangamati, upazila nirbahi officer of Longadu and officer-in-charge of Longadu Police Station have been made the respondents.  
More than 350 houses along with crops and furniture were damaged and money and ornaments were looted during the attack, the SC lawyer claimed.  
"I think it has happened due to the negligence of the local administration of the government. If the administration were active, there might not be any incidents like this," he said in the notice.

# 'Wilful negligence' behind accidental deaths: Dr Kamal

Eminent jurist Dr Kamal Hossain yesterday said killing of people in road and river accidents is taking an "institutional form" in the country.  
"These cannot be described as accidents. Another term should be introduced for the concept... these are acts of almost wilful negligence," he said.  
The jurist, also an architect of the country's constitution, made the remarks at a views exchange meeting organised by Bangladesh Legal Aid and Services Trust (BLAST) at The Daily Star Centre.  
People are dying in road accidents and launch capsizes each year due to intentional acts of negligence, he alleged, adding that the authorities concerned should find out the reasons behind such recurring incidents.  
Professionals from different sectors including judges, lawyers and rights activists attended the programme to discuss legal obligations to compensate victims of launch capsizes.  
BLAST on June 5 won a landmark case in the High Court which upheld a lower court verdict ordering BIWTA (Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority) and a launch owners' association to pay Tk 17.11 crore in compensation to the families of victims who died during the capsizing of launch MV Nasrin-1 in 2003.  
MV Nasrin-1 capsized on July 8, 2003 at the confluence of the Padma, Meghna and Dakatia in Chandpur, leaving 110 people dead, about 200 missing, and many others injured, according to a government investigation report.  
Speakers at yesterday's meeting said a moral victory has been ensured through the HC judgement.  
It will help victims of other incidents get justice, they said, adding that the authorities concerned need to act promptly in disbursing compensation money to the families of victims.  
They advised that the method of swift disbursement of compensation to the families of deceased expatriate workers should be followed in this regard. The authorities can also follow the model of prompt procedure adopted in India to compensate accident victims there.  
Former Appellate Division judge Justice Md Nizamul Huq said advocacy programmes and accident awareness campaigns need to be continued.  
Supreme Court lawyer Advocate Subrata Chowdhury demanded that the government

# Before going broke...

While police suspect the death of a woman and her three children in Turag was triggered by financial hardship, locals say the family used to live an affluent life once and went broke after losing Tk 50 lakh in an MLM business.  
Most of the neighbours, however, came to know about the plight of Mostafa Kamal only after his wife, Rehena Parvin, 35, reportedly hanged herself after strangling her daughters Nusrat, 13, and Arisha, 9, and nine-month-old son Saad, at their house on Friday.  
Police say she might have committed suicide out of frustrations arising from financial hardship, but they are also looking into land and business issues.  
Neighbours said a decade ago, Kamal used to donate, but they heard he had been relying on borrowings from relatives for quite a while.  
"Whenever there was any cultural or sporting event, we would collect donations for him because he was a solvent businessman at that time," said Babul Hossain, a neighbour.

Echoing him, another neighbour, Mohammad Kamal, said Mostafa was also known as a good person. "So we used to invite him as chief guest."  
Although Kamal is a business partner of Mostafa at their recent enterprise, Youth Welfare and Small Traders Association, he was never aware of his financial plight.  
Mostafa worked at the association as an accountant.  
"We, seven partners, launched the association investing Tk 20,000 each around seven months back and decided to pay him after making profits," Kamal said.  
When asked why he does not search for a job again, Mostafa told Kamal that he was having problems in the eye and was not able to perform like earlier.  
In 2006, Mostafa quit a job at a buying house in Chittagong and got involved in multi-level marketing (MLM) and land businesses.  
His hard days started when he lost Tk

50 lakh in the MLM business in 2012, Mostafa told reporters at Dhaka Medical College Hospital on Friday.  
After that his only income source was a portion of house rents and financial assistances from relatives, said Samsul Alam, his brother-in-law.  
The 48-year-old built 16 tin-roof rooms on his father's 4-katha land in the capital's Turag. His family started living in three rooms and three others were used by one of his sisters, Kohinoor. The rest were rented out.  
Rehena's relatives said two years ago, Mostafa used to collect Tk 25,000 as rents and could hardly spend Tk 5,000 to meet his family expenses as he had to pay the utility bills and give the rest to his sisters.  
But things worsened when his sisters took control of the house to collect rents and started pressing him to vacate the rooms for failing to repay them loans, they said.  
To support her family, Rehena regularly collected money from her b r o t h e r s

### Afsan Chy gets anticipatory bail in case filed under section 57

The High Court yesterday granted anticipatory bail to BRAC University teacher Afsan Chowdhury for four weeks in a case filed under Section 57 of the Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Act, 2006.  
The court also asked Afsan Chowdhury, also a journalist, to surrender before the lower court concerned after four weeks in connection with the case.  
The bench of Justice Zinat Ara and Justice SM Mozibur Rahman gave the order following a petition filed by Prof Afsan seeking anticipatory bail in the case.  
He appeared before the HC bench yesterday for bail in the case.  
Deputy Attorney General Moniruzzaman Rubel told The Daily Star that Lt Gen (retd) Masud Uddin Chowdhury filed the case against Prof Afsan with Gulshan Police Station on charge of posting "false and derogatory" comment on facebook on May 7.  
According to Section 57, if any person deliberately publishes or transmits false, obscene and derogatory information on any website or in any other electronic form, he or she will be sentenced to seven to 14 years' imprisonment and fined up to Tk 1 crore.  
The government will not move any appeal before the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court against the HC order of bail to Prof Afsan, as he will have to surrender to the trial court after four weeks, Moniruzzaman added.  
Advocate M Asaduzzaman appeared for Afsan Chowdhury.
