"As an engineering initiative of 3Es, the government has identified 227 black spots through a survey of the country's road and highway network," he said.

Quader said his ministry already took steps to fix over 100 black spots, and a Tk 165 crore project was now being implemented to repair the rest within the outgoing fiscal.

Quoting a police report, the minister said the number of road accidents dropped from 4,472 in 2008 to 2,566 in 2016.

While replying to another query, Quader said 888 people were killed in road accidents across the country in the first four months of 2017.

We have lodged a strong protest with the charge d'affaires of the United States Embassy in Dhaka," the ministry said Tuesday.

According to the indictment, Shahedul brought another Bangladeshi, Mohammed Amin, to New York between 2012 and 2013 to work as a household help for his family.

The defendant allegedly took his passport and required the man to work 18 hours a day, never paid him and assaulted him on several occasions, the statement said.
