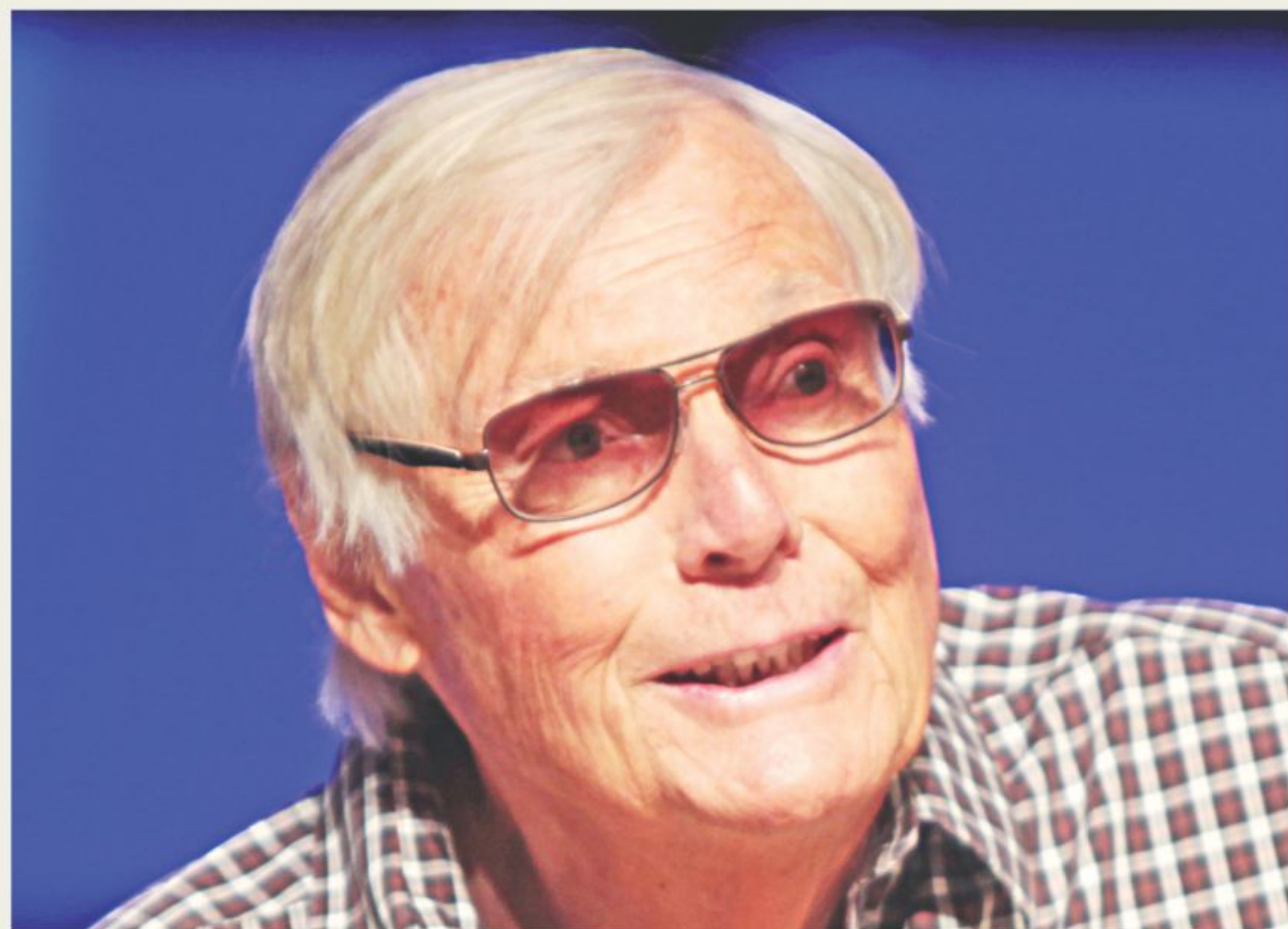


# KATY PERRY admits to being a victim of suicidal thoughts
