

# Film actor Tonu held over raping woman

Film actor and model Tanvir Rahman Tonu has been arrested at his Rupnagar residence in Mirpur of Dhaka in a case filed over raping a woman.

The arrest was made on Friday afternoon after the woman, an executive of a private firm, had filed the rape case, said Rupnagar Police Station Inspector Mokammel Hoque, also investigation officer of the case.

The woman claimed that she was introduced through Facebook with Tonu who promised her with a better job in Malaysia.

She alleged that Tonu asked her to go to his house on May 6 around 10:00pm and raped her there in the presence of one of his friends.

She alleged that before raping her Tonu gave her drink mixed with sedatives. He let her go around 6:30am, the IO said.

Asked about Tonu's friend, the IO said they will take action, if he is found involved in it.

A Dhaka court yesterday sent Tonu to jail when police produced him before it with a five-day remand prayer.

Tonu appeared in a number of movies, including "Full and Final", "Gunda", and "Khas Zamin".

## 7,000 Ctg artisans busy making Eid outfits

With Eid-ul-Fitr approaching near, artisans at Khalifa Potti, a popular wholesale market for readymade outfits in Chittagong city, are busy trying to keep up with the demand of one of the biggest religious festivals of Muslims.

At the Khalifa Potti in Ghat Farhadbeg area, some workers are seen manufacturing various attire including shirts, tops, skirts, frocks, salwar suits and gowns of different designs and colours, while some are busy making artistic fancy works on dresses of women and children and on men's punjabi.

Kazi Md Kafil Uddin, owner of Bismillah Garments, said usually six workers work for some 14 hours per day. But now, eight workers are working for some 20 hours a day, he added.

About the sale this year, Kafil said he was satis-

fied with what he had sold so far.

Another trader, Belal Hossain, produces female clothes, and shirts for kids with the help of three artisans at his factory. The wholesale price of the readymade outfits is between Tk 80 and Tk 2,000, he added.

"Targeting Eid, we have started our production three to four months before," he added.

"Earlier, our daily sale was between Tk 1 and 4 lakh. But, there has been a decline in the sale since last two years," he added.

"On an average, we have sold goods for about Tk 40,000 to Tk 50,000 per day till now," he said, adding, "Our sale will continue till 29th Ramadan."

Kazi Mohin, a worker at Belal's factory cum shop, said they were working for extra six hours daily.

Mohammad Reaz, a craftsman at Ahmmad Fashion, said, "We can produce two to three

dozens of clothes per day. But, it takes more time when the designs are complex."

About their sale, Mohammad Sohag, a staff of Ahmmad Fashion, said it was not satisfactory yet, but he hoped that their sale would increase within a few days. Some 2,000 artisans are now working in about 500 factories and shops in the area. With them, the total number of artisans is 7,000, said Md Shamsul Alam, general secretary of Khalifa Potti Bonik Kalyan Samity.

Between Shab-e-Barat and 20th Ramadan, some shops manage to do business of about Tk 30 lakh to Tk 40 lakh while some shops experience sale up to Tk 2 crore. Many fashion house and boutique shop owners buy clothes from the potti as they are made with high quality fabric, trendy designs and attractive handiwork, he added.

## Recommendations to save hills

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a fund shortage, according to district administration sources.

Zafar Alam, the then member secretary of the HMC formed after the landslide in 2007, said the HMC's technical committee had proposed the recommendations regarding hill management to avert landslide. But none were implemented, he said.

Pointing fingers at organisations like BR, CWasa and PWD, Additional Deputy Commissioner (ADC- revenue) Abdul Jalil said the owners of most of the hills have no plan whatsoever to save those.

"We conduct eviction drives every year. But these organisations don't take any steps to save their hills," said Jalil, also the incumbent member secretary of HMC.

About the Tk 73 lakh fund, he said it was not possible to rehabilitate thousands of people with such a small amount. "Without a proper initiative by the government it is not possible to rehabilitate the hill dwellers."

Contacted, Jahangir Alam, former vice-chancellor of Chittagong University of Engineering and Technology, said "Local authorities did not take effective measures to execute most of the recommendations. Their carelessness and a lack of interest are the reasons behind not implementing the suggestions."

The government and private organisations have to come forward to save their respective hills. They should also consult the experts for technical support, he added.

The administration should take short-, mid- and long-term projects so that the recommendations can be executed, said Prof Jahangir, a former member of HMC's technical committee.

In the recent landslides, worst since 2007, at least 150 people, including army men, women and children, were killed in Chittagong, Rangamati, Bandarban and Cox's Bazar after a depression in the Bay caused the torrential rain.

### RICE PRICE HIKE

## Fakhrul demands food minister's resignation

UNB, Dhaka

BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir yesterday demanded resignation of Food Minister Quamrul Islam for his failure to check the rice price hike and "corruption".

"The unusual rice price hike is an ominous sign. We think the food minister should quit taking the responsibility for it," he said.

The BNP leader was speaking at a discussion arranged by Jatiyatabadi Jubo Dal at the Institution of Engineers Bangladesh.

Slamming the food minister for his comment that pro-BNP businessmen are pushing up the rice prices, Fakhrul said Quamrul is trying to shift the blame on BNP only to hush up his "incompetence and corruption".

He voiced concern that the government's food stock has come down to only 1.91 lakh metric tonnes.

Fakhrul alleged that the unprecedented corruption is taking place in Padma bridge project. "A proposal was placed again to increase the bridge construction cost by 23 percent. They're raising the cost every year for widespread corruption."

The BNP leader alleged that the government is giving the ruling party men the scope to plunder public money by hanging onto power using the state machinery and different forces.

Speaking at another discussion at the Jatiya Press Club, BNP standing committee member Khandaker Mosharraf Hossain also criticised the government for its failure to arrest the soaring prices of rice.

He said the common and poor people are going through immense sufferings for the raise in rice prices during this holy month of Ramadan.

The BNP leader also came down hard on the Prime Minister for staying in Sweden when many people were killed and injured in landslides in four districts. "They (government) are least bothered about public sufferings as they're not elected with people's votes."
