

Turkey condoles deaths in hills

The Turkish government has expressed condolence over the deaths of Bangladeshi citizens caused by landslides in hill districts, said a press release of the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs. "We learned with sorrow that mud slides that took place in Bangladesh claimed the lives of at least 130 people. We extend our sincere condolences to the relatives of those who lost their lives, to the people and government of Bangladesh and wish speedy recovery to the injured," said the press release.

ISPR also said eight medical teams of the army were working in 16 areas of the hill districts, and food and drinking water were being provided in seven shelters.

Steps taken to make Biman profitable

Rashed Khan Menon tells JS

The government has taken various measures, including phasing out old aircraft and inducting new generation of aircraft, to make Biman Bangladesh Airlines a more profitable airline, Civil Aviation Minister Rashed Khan Menon told parliament yesterday.

"The Biman's fleet has been modernised by phasing out its old F-28/DC 10-30 aircraft and inducting four new generation 777-300 aircraft and two 737-800 aircraft of Boeing Company in the fleet. As a result, the national flag carrier's maintenance, fuel and repair cost has been declined to a great extent," he said in reply to lawmakers' queries.

Efforts have been made to boost up Biman's revenue income by implementing "revenue management" and "revenue integrity system", while steps have been taken to reduce Global Distribution System (GDS) cost in the process for increasing online sales, the minister told the parliament.

Meanwhile, Liberation War Affairs Minister AKM Mozammel Huq yesterday said the government will construct 8,000 flats across the country for insolvent freedom fighters.

"The Liberation War Affairs Ministry has undertaken a project for constructing 8,000 flats for insolvent freedom fighters across the country, while multistoried building would be built in every district and upazila....," he said in reply to lawmakers' queries.

Boost trans-boundary ties to address water issues

Experts tell discussion about South Asia

UNB, Dhaka

Experts at a discussion here yesterday said strengthening cooperation among the South Asian countries is a must to resolve trans-boundary water problem.

Today, more than ever, cooperation is needed to meet the water-related needs of South Asia's growing population in the river basins for food production, energy, industrial and domestic uses and sustain its ecology, they said, adding, that's why cooperation among the neighbouring countries can be nurtured through dialogue and people-to-people contact.

Oxfam in Bangladesh arranged the discussion at Cirdap auditorium in the capital. During the meeting Oxfam launched a five-year project -- Trans-boundary Rivers of South Asia (TROSA) project -- to promote improved policies and practices that protect the rights of communities along the trans-boundary Ganges-Brahmaputra-Meghna (GBM) river basins.

Speaking at the discussion, State Minister for Water Resources Muhammad Nazrul Islam said as a lower riparian, Bangladesh will continue its efforts until it achieves an equitable share of benefits for all in the entire basin.

"It is essential for wellbeing of ecosys-

tems and millions of people in Bangladesh as well as the basin. We call upon our neighbours in the upstream to respect the rights of the lower riparian countries so we can prosper together," he said.

The minister hoped that TROSA project will be able to replicate the successful model of the Mekong basin to enhance regional cooperation in the GBM basins.

IUCN country representative Ishitaq Uddin Ahmad said trans-boundary water governance is linked to geopolitics, economies and livelihoods, cultures and heritage.

"To make it just and win-win, the upper and lower riparian countries need to follow certain principles, like causing no harm to anyone, preserving ecosystem integrity and rights of the communities," he added.

Member of the National Commission for the Protection of the River Sharmeen Murshid stressed developing a 'People's River Master Plan' and called upon different actors to come together to set a minimum common position to share the rivers in this region.

Among others, the event was attended by advisor of South Asian Network for Development and Environmental Economics (SANDEE) Prof Dr AK Enamul Haque, Paribesh Bachao Andolon (Poba)

motivated through the "provocation" by the most powerful person of the state, he said, without referring to anyone.

"Those who can travel abroad leaving the helpless disaster-affected people can do anything bad. People have seen a new and desperate form of terrorism of the government because of the way the ruling party men attacked BNP secretary general's motorcade on his way to Rangamati with relief materials," he said.

Rizvi said police arrested their party men on Sunday as they took out processions protesting the attack on their leaders.

The motorcade of Fakhru was attacked in Chittagong on Sunday allegedly by Awami League men when he was going to visit the landslide victims in Rangamati. At least seven BNP leaders, including Fakhru, were hurt and five vehicles vandalised.

Court accepts charges, hearing

students. The three others faced charges of helping them in various ways during and after the alleged incident at a hotel in the capital on March 28 night.

The three are Shafat's driver Billal Hossain, bodyguard Rahmat Ali and Shadman Sakif, a friend of the two victims. Shafat is the son of Dildar Hossain Selim, one of the owners of Apan Jewellers.

During the one-month investigation, the investigation officer recorded statements of 47 witnesses, including hotel staffs.

Invited to Shafat's birthday party, the two girls went to the Banani hotel around 9:00pm on March 28.

They victims wanted to return home as they felt "uncomfortable" in that atmosphere, but the accused asked them to wait until the birthday cake was cut.

When the victims' male friend and the girl who went to the party with him wanted to leave the hotel after the cake was cut, Shafat and Nayem forcibly took the key of the male friend's car and physically assaulted him and kept him confined to a room with the girl, according to the charge sheet.

After midnight, Shafat raped the plaintiff while Nayem raped her friend in separate rooms, the charge sheet said.

The victims got acquainted with Shafat and Nayem at Picasso restaurant in the capital through their friend Sakif, some 10 to 15 days before the incident.

Since their first meeting, Shafat often chatted with the plaintiff on the phone. Just a few days before the incident, he repeatedly asked her to attend his birthday party with her friends, according to the charge sheet.

Of the arrestees, Abdus Salam, 75, Suruj Ali Fakir, 62, Joyen Uddin Faruki alias Joyal Abedin, 60, Abdur Rahim alias Abdur Rahim Master, 67, Jalal Uddin, 59, and Rustam Ali, 70, are now in jail. Shamsur Haque, 66, Fazlul Haque, and Shamsul

Haque, 70, are on the run, Kalam said. The tribunal's investigation agency on March 29 completed the probe and said to have found evidence against the nine men. Abdus Salam was allegedly involved with Al-Badr force, while the rest were alleged Razakar men, the agency said.
