# Rain triggers flash flood in Habiganj

## People of 45 villages marooned

Residents of around 45 villages in Habiganj Sadar upazila have become marooned due to flash flood triggered by heavy rain in the last two days.

The district administration has asked the people living near the Khowai river to take shelter further away from the river.

Water level of the Khowai river has been rising alarmingly from yesterday morning following the rain. The river is flowing about 270 cm above the danger level, increasing the possibility of flood.

Executive Engineer of Water Development Board (WDB), Habiganj Md Tawhidul Islam said the danger level for the Khowai river is 9.5m, while the river was flowing at 12.2m yesterday. Kamrapur, Masulia and Tetoia bridges are now under risk.

Low lying areas in Khowai river basin were submerged during the period, and Aus paddy on thousands of hectares of land was also damaged due to the inundation, he added.

Locals said heavy downpour for the last two days and water rolling down the hills caused breaches in different points of the Khowai River Protection Embankment.

Alim Uddin, 58, of Kamrapur village in the upazila said the flood was triggered by

heavy rain in the last two days. Water from the Khowai started entering their homes from Monday morning, he added.

Moinul Mia, 65, who lives near the Khowai river basin, said more than five houses in the area were flooded on Sunday. The hapless victims took shelter on the road, he said.

Deputy Commissioner of Habiganj Sabina Alam said they have informed the higher authorities about the flood.

Bangladesh Parishesh Andolon, Habiganj unit General Secretary Toffaza Sohel said if the embankment had been repaired earlier the villagers would not have faced these problems.

Mayor of Habiganj Municipal GK Gous said five points of the embankment along the Khowai river have collapsed and 15 points have become vulnerable. One lakh people have been marooned and thousands of families along the river are living in fear of losing their croplands and homesteads, he added.

Habiganj Sadar Upazila Chairman Syed Ahmedul Haq said they have informed the higher authorities about the 45 affected villages.

Engineer Tawhidul said they have written to the higher authorities for allocation to repair the embankment.

### MURDER OF WOMAN Husband absconding

The man who allegedly hacked his wife to death in Bhaluka upazila of the district on Monday has not been arrested yet.

The victim was Jesmin Akhter, 45, wife of Abul Kashem of Koiadi village.

Officer-in-Charge of Bhaluka Police Station Md Mamun-ur-Rashid said the couple often used to lock in altercation over family matters.

There had been a serious altercation on Sunday night between Jesmin, mother of three children, and Kashem, a farmer who stays at his in-laws' house, the OC said.

Later, Kashem allegedly hacked Jesmin indiscriminately with an axe when she was sleeping, killing her on the spot, the OC said. Kashem has been absconding since then.

Police sent the body to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

A case was filed, but Kashem had not been arrested as of filing of this report.

### ROW OVER SCHOOL COMMITTEE Two teachers assaulted

#### Speakers at rally demand punishment to culprits

Headmasters of two government primary schools were assaulted over formation of schools' managing committees in Ghatail upazila on Monday and the day before.

The victims are Akbar Hossain, headmaster of Baroipara Government Primary School, and Mahbubur Rahman, headmaster of Noornagar Government Primary School.

Speakers at a protest rally demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the assaulters of the headmasters.

Under the banner of Ghatail upazila unit of Bangladesh Primary School Teachers' Association, hundreds of primary schoolteachers in the upazila joined the programme yesterday.

Among others, Akhtaruzzaman Khan and Sujat Ali Khan, president and general secretary of upazila unit of the association, headmasters Baset Karim and Humayun Kabir and Ghatail municipality Mayor Shahiduzzaman Khan spoke.

Mentionable, headmasters Akbar and Mahbubur were beaten by local criminals over formation of the schools' managing committees. They are now undergoing treatment at Ghatail Upazila Health

Complex. The victims filed two cases with Ghatail Police Station in this connection on Monday.

According to case statements, president candidate Azaharul Islam Raza of Bhabondutta village lodged a complaint with the upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) of irregularities over formation of the managing committee of Baroipara Government Primary School.

Following the complaint, assistant education officer in Ghatail JM Fuad went to the school on Monday morning to look into the matter.

However, Raza and his men beat headmaster Akbar Hossain during the inquiry and also ordered the education officer to submit the inquiry report in his (Raza) favour.

Meanwhile, an 11-member managing committee of Noornagar Government Primary School was formed on Sunday. Failing to get selected as president, candidate Babar Ali of the area and his men beat up headmaster Mahbubur Rahman.

GM Fuad, assistant education officer in Ghatail, said they are investigating the incidents of assault on the two headmasters.

### 2 cattle traders held by BSF

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) detained two Bangladeshi nationals from bordering Porsha upazila of Naogaon early Monday.

The detainees are Moinul Islam, 30, son of late Ketab Ali, and Monirul Islam, 35, son of Abdul Mannan of Duarpal village in the upazila.

Both are cattle traders, said BGB members quoting family members.

Abdur Razzak, camp commander of Hapania outpost, told this correspondent yesterday over phone that the BSF troops detained the two Bangladeshis when a group of smugglers were returning to the country through Hapania border on early Monday.

After filing a case BSF members handed over the two detainees to Indian police, he said.

Lt Col Ali Reza, commanding officer of BGB 14 Battalion, said although they sent a request letter to the their Indian counterpart to return the two Bangladeshis, BSF ignored the message and handed them over to police.

# One killed, 10 shot by robbers

One person was killed and ten others were injured when a gang of robbers fired on villagers indiscriminately in Kholabari cluster village under Fulchhari upazila yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Azher Ali, 45 of the village. The injured are Abdul Aziz, 50, Halima Begum, 18, Abdur Rahim, 32, Rashidul, 38, Shafiqul Islam, 35, Eqab Ali, 22, Azam, 30, Zilhaq, 25, Hashem Ali, 38, and Vikhu Mia, 40.

The gang also abducted Lal Mia and Sukur Ali from the village. Quoting locals, police said the robbers led by Abdus Sattar opened fire on the villagers as a sequel to a past feud with one Lal Mia, an inhabitant of the village.

Due to indiscriminate gunfire, eleven people received bullet injuries. They were taken to Gaibandha Sadar Hospital from where they were shifted to Rangpur Medical College Hospital in critical condition. Later, Azher Ali succumbed to his injuries.

Their injuries were critical, so they were referred to Rangpur Medical College Hospital for better treatment, said Dr Efat Ara Sharmin, on-duty physician of Gaibandha hospital.

Confirming the death of one person in the incident, Officer-in-Charge of Fulchhari Police Station AM Ashrafuzzaman said additional police have been deployed in the village to avoid further attack and raids are on to arrest the robbers and rescue the missing people.

# Kid found dead

An eight-year-old girl was found dead in a pond in the district yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Hena Akter, 8, daughter of Md Hasan Ali of Outpara village in Betilla-Mitora union under Sadar upazila. She was a Class I student at the local Rawan Bin Ramzan Cadet School.

According to family and local sources, Hena went out from the house on Monday afternoon for playing, but did not return home. Locals saw Hena's body floating in a pond near the house at around 8:30am and informed her family members.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to Manikganj Sadar Hospital for autopsy, said Officer-in-Charge of Manikganj Sadar Police Station Habibullah Sarkar.

Hena's uncle Chunnun Mia, 30, was detained for interrogation in connection with the incident. However, several villagers said Chunnun Mia is mentally unbalanced.
