The primary element of his art works are the forms traditionally found in rickshaws — folk motifs and even urban satires depicting 'Dhallywood' actors and actresses. The primary attraction of his pieces is the explosive use of colours, which of course is a hallmark of rickshaw paintings.

"A lot of people have moved towards digitally printed artworks, I am here to practice and continue hand painted craft," says Biskut.

His Facebook page features cell phone covers decorated with imagery one was accustomed to seeing on rickshaws even a decade ago. If you want something customised, the options are wide open as Biskut and his team can pretty much turn everything into art.

"Our team comprises four people and it is the collaborative efforts, our talents, knowledge and ideas that make the products and services of Biskut Factory possible," he says.

Initially, the team started by working on

phone covers, sunglasses and shoes and diversified into a miscellaneous variety of paintable objects as people started ordering for different things.

The artists at the Factory can pretty much jazz up any everyday object and turn them into objet d'art!

Brighten up your house with teapots, miscellaneous boxes and trunks; revamp your favourite guitar or ukulele; or 'simply' pimp your ride with designed scooters and helmets!

Biskut states that he practices the art not only to sell his work but to inspire all DIY enthusiasts. His motto is that people in Dhaka and everywhere should take an approach in life like never before, even with



daily schedules and everyday things.
