Elderly with disabilities to get home delivery of cash

Govt officers tell roundtable on old age allowance

The elderly people who became physically disabled will get their allocated allowances delivered at home through a new mechanism the government is planning to develop, officials said yesterday.

There is also another plan to launch a social life insurance scheme to help the elderly people, they told a roundtable organised by Bangla daily Prothom Alo, and National Forum for Social Protection with support from Manusher Jonno Foundation (MJF) and UK Aid. The programme was held at the newspaper's office in the capital.

Speaking on the occasion, Director General of Department of Social Welfare Nurul Kabir said

the government had almost completed building a database of the elderly people who were getting old age allowances.

The old people will not have to face hassles because government representatives will deliver the allowances at their home through a cash machine, which would contain the database, he said.

Lawmaker Habibe Millat, a member of the parliamentary standing committee on the social welfare ministry, said the government was currently running 145 social safety-net programmes, and around 31 lakh elderly people got the old age allowance.

Eligible persons often miss the allowance because most of the elderly people in the country do not know their actual age, he said.

Commending the allowance-distribution programme, MJF Executive Director Shaheen Anam said if the authorities fixed its drawbacks, the elderly people would be benefited more.

Prof MM Akash of Dhaka University suggested that the elderly could make a list of themselves on their own and submit it to the authorities concerned. This technique can make the process transparent, he said.

Prothom Alo Associate Editor Abdul Quayum, Wave Foundation Chief Executive Director Mohsin Ali, RIC Executive Director Abul Hasib Khan, National Development Programme Executive Director Mohammad Alauddin, and Coast Trust Executive Director Rezaul Karim Chowdhury, also spoke, among others.

Asked about the delay, she replied that they prepared the results soon after getting final exam marks from the teachers. She, however, said head of the exam committee, Lecturer Mollika Roy, could say the reason behind the delay.

Mollika Roy, and another member, Assistant Professor Arifa Rahman, were not available to comment.

Contacted, head of the psychology department, Prof Nasreen Wadud, declined to comment on the matter.

Meanwhile, seeking anonymity, one of the 15 victim students expressed disappointment. "Our department is faced with session jams because of delays in publication of results," the student said. "Out teachers should be more careful about our future."

Apart from this case, there were past incidents of delay in publication of results and start of the classes at the department.

The honours final exams of session 2011-12 concluded in March 2016 and the results were published five months later in September 2016. But the master's classes did not begin until three months later, in January this year.

The students said they were almost one year behind their batch mates in other departments where the master's classes of the same session started in January 2016.

"We are falling behind in the competitive job market," a master's student told The Daily Star, while venting his frustration.

The foundation's Executive Director Advocate Mahfuzur Rahman filed the petition on behalf of the organisation requesting the HC to order the authorities to shut the boilers of factories immediately after those expire.

He said in the petition that there is a provision in the Boiler Act, 1923 for fining Tk 20,000 for keeping the expired boiler in the factory.

But there is no provision in the law regarding the death and injury of people in boiler explosion, he added.

The HC may hold hearing on the petition today.

Of them, Shafat, Nayem, Sakif and Billal gave confessional statements before magistrates on different dates.

Shafat, and Nayem were charged with raping the two university students. The three others faced charges of assisting them in various ways during and after the incident at a hotel in the capital on the night of March 28.

Shafat is the son of Dildar Hossain Selim, one of the owners of Apan Jewellers.

On May 6, one university girl filed the case with Banani Police Station accusing Shafat, Sakif and three others.

Fifteen more Biranganas (war heroines) have been recognised as freedom fighters for their contribution in the country's Liberation War in 1971.

The Ministry of Liberation War Affairs issued a gazette notification in this regard yesterday. With this, a total of 185 Biranganas received the freedom fighter status.

The liberation war affairs ministry, for the first time, recognised 41 Biranganas as freedom fighters on October 12, 2015.

Once recognised, the Biranganas will receive the same benefits as the freedom fighters do -- a monthly allowance, two annual bonus, special quotas in the government jobs and benefits for their children and grandchildren.

Actress Papia Selim dies
