

Aga Khan commences 60th yr as Imam of Ismaili Shia community

The Aga Khan has commenced his diamond jubilee year, or 60th year as the 49th hereditary Imam (spiritual leader) of the world's Ismaili Shia Muslims.

This worldwide celebration brings together the global Ismaili community, partners of the Aga Khan Development Network, and government and faith community leaders in over 25 countries, said a press release received here yesterday.

On July 11, 1957, at the age of 20, the Aga Khan succeeded his grandfather, Sir Sultan Mahomed Shah Aga Khan as the Imam of the Ismaili Shia Muslims.

Today, the Aga Khan leads a global community of 15 million Ismaili Shia Muslims living in South Asia, Central Asia, Africa, the Middle East, Europe, North America and the Far East.

FOUR NAOGAON MEN ICT wants probe report, if any, September 17

The International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday directed the prosecution to submit investigation report, if any, on September 17 in a case filed against four Naoagan men for allegedly committing crimes during the Liberation War in 1971.

Yesterday was fixed for submitting the report but Prosecutor Abul Kalam sought three months time.

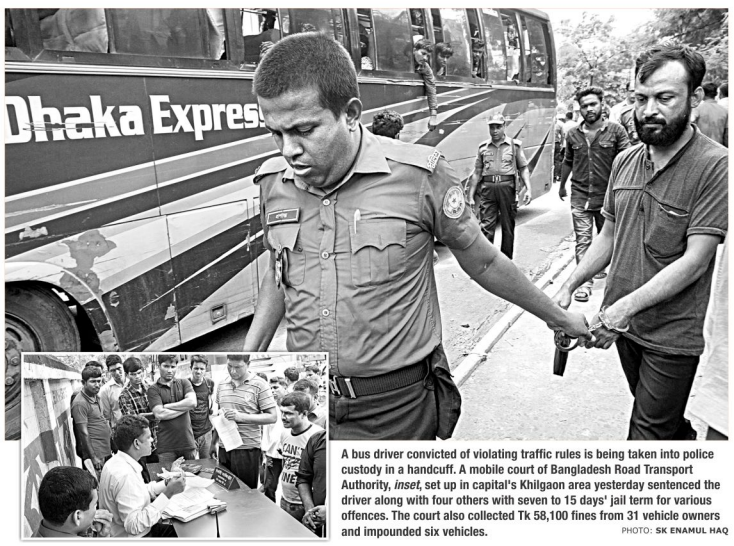
Of the four, Rezau Karim Muntaz, Ishaq Ali and Shahid Mandal are now in jail while another Nazrul Islam is yet to be arrested.

Rezau Karim is now living in Joypurhat and is a former ameer of Jamaat-e-Islam of Joypurhat district, according to the prosecution. Rezau, Ishaq and Shahid were shown arrested in the case on February 15.

Meanwhile, the tribunal deferred the date to September 17 to decide whether it would allow charges into cognising brought against four Netrokama men for allegedly committing crimes in 1971.

In another development, the tribunal deferred date to August 29 for hearing charges in a case filed against eight men from Jamalpur and Mymensingh over war-time crimes.

The date was deferred for the same reason, Prosecutor Abul Kalam said.



A bus driver convicted of violating traffic rules is being taken into police custody in a handcuff. A mobile court of Bangladesh Road Transport Authority, inset, set up in capital's Khilgaon area yesterday sentenced the driver along with four others with seven to 15 days' jail term for various offences. The court also collected Tk 56,100 fines from 31 vehicle owners and impounded six vehicles.

12 cops face extortion case

The wife of a former journalist yesterday filed a case against 12 policemen, including an assistant commissioner, and two others on charge of demanding an extortion of Tk 6 lakh for her husband's release.

The accused are Senior Assistant Commissioner Iftekharul Islam of Demra zone, Officer-in-Charge of Latabari Police Station Anisur Rahman, its OC (Investigation) Tofail Ahmed, Sub-inspectors Zakir Hossain, Omar Faruque, Shahin Parvez, Laxmikant Roy, Md Shahidullah, KM Enayet Hossain and Kabir Hossain Ukil, ASI Atoar Rahman, constable Saiful and police informants Khokon and Md sunon.

Shahana Akhter, wife of Md Forman Ullah Khan of Dhakkin Kadza in Latabari, filed the case with the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court of Dhaka.

After the hearing, Metropolitan Magistrate Khurshid Alam fixed July 19 to decide whether to take cognisance of the extortion charges.

In her complaint, Shahana said Latabari police arrested her husband at about 11:00am on June 21 as her husband submitted three applications to the home ministry seeking steps to stop narcotics

business in his area, being run with the help of police.

Later Shahana went to Latabari Police Station at about 4:30pm and found policemen beating her husband indiscriminately. After that, she met AC Iftekharul for her husband's release. But he used abusive words and demanded Tk 6 lakh in extortion for his release, reads the complaint.

At about 9:00pm, Shahana returned to her residence to collect money and gave Tk 2 lakh to one of the accused SI Kabir Hossain Ukil. But police did not release her husband, and the following day, sent him to the court showing him arrested in three cases for possessing narcotics.

Forman used to work at national dailies and weeklies as a reporter, Shahana said in the complaint.

Contacted, AC Iftekharul told The Daily Star that Forman alias Nirob was a drug peddler and arrested in several criminal cases.

"Police arrested him twice for selling illegal drugs in last three months. He used to run his drug racket identifying him as a journalist of an online news portal. His wife filed the case with the court out of vengeance."

"I will file a defamation case as she told lies about me," he said.

POND AT RK MISSION

The over 100-year-old pond inside the Ramakrishna Mission in Gopibaghat is still there. But the authorities are struggling to keep it clean. There are buildings surrounding the 28-decimal reservoir and residents of those buildings continue to throw garbage in it.

"We started the mission back in 1899, and the pond was also dug up around that time," said Shebanand Hindu Moharaj, assistant secretary of the mission.

He said the pond is used by people of the Hindu community for performing rituals. "We try to keep the reservoir clean as it is being used regularly."

While visiting the pond, this correspondent met Jharna Karmakar, a resident of Gopibaghat, and her family members. Jharna came to the mission to perform a marriage ritual, "jal bath" for one of her relatives.

"The pond is important to us. We use its water for performing our rituals," she said.
