ICT-1 to get new chairman soon

Law Minister Anisul Huq said yesterday said the chairman of International Crimes Tribunal-1 (ICT-1) will be appointed very soon.

He, however, did not say who will be appointed as the chairman, and when the appointment will be made.

Relying to a question on whether he has consulted with Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha about the appointment, Anisul Huq said, "I will not say anything about this at this moment."

The post of ICT chairman fell vacant after its chairman Justice Anwarul Haque passed away on Thursday.

normal pro-people activities, not creating any distance from mass people," she said.

She said the SSF personnel should consider the public relations of the VIPs with utmost importance.

The prime minister said the SSF members should consider with importance about the attainment of strength of character, higher discipline, honesty, responsibility and human qualities alongside improving professional skills.

girl went to their respective rooms but Ateef and Winson started drinking liquor in Winson's room where the party was held, the OC quoted Niraj as saying.

When Niraj came out of his room to lock the main door of the flat around 12:00am, he found Winson's room locked from inside.

As none was responding from inside despite repeated knocks on the door, Niraj entered inside using a spare key and found Winson hanging from the ceiling and blood stained body of Ateef on the floor, said the OC quoting Niraj.

Niraj and the girl, with the help of fellows, rushed the duo to the USTC hospital immediately but the USTC medical authority suggested them to go to Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) as it was a police case, said Alamgir.

Winson was admitted to CMCH but Ateef was declared brought dead around 1:00pm. Later, Winson was transferred to nearby Max Hospital as his condition

started deteriorating, said the OC.

OC Alamgir said they found 15 wound marks of a sharp weapon on Ateef's body. After an autopsy, the body was handed over to the USTC authorities.

Police primarily suspected that following an altercation between the two in a drunken state, Winson might have stabbed Ateef to death and later tried to kill himself.

"Niraj and the girl are being quizzed", said Alamgir, adding, others who attended the party will be interrogated later.

Deputy Commissioner (ADC-west zone) of Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) Farookul Haque said Winson will be interrogated after his condition improves.

"The incident was conveyed to Indian Assistant High Commission in Chittagong and the commission will take steps to contact the victim's family," said the DC.

Filing of a case was underway with Akhber Shah Police Station in this connection, said OC Alamgir.

University student fighting for life after brick fall

A private university student is fighting for life in a Dhaka hospital after a brick fell on his head from the roof of a three-storey building in Mohammadpur area on Friday afternoon.

Akhidul Islam, 22, a fine arts student of the University of Development Alternative, is under life support following a head surgery at Square Hospital on that day, hospital sources said.

The victim's family filed a written complaint with Mohammadpur Police Station, said Officer-in-Charge Jamaluddin Meer.

They picked up the building owner Mosharraf Hossain and his son for their negligence in maintaining the building, he said.

The incident happened on Road No-7 of Mohammad Housing while Akhidul was returning home on Road No-8 of the housing from a Dhamondi coaching centre, said his family.

The OC said Mosharraf told them that there was a family programme on the roof during the incident.

Due to the gathering, a brick fell down from an old wall that demarcated the roof, he quoted the building residents as saying.

Akhidul used to live with his brother-in-law Mostafiz Karigar who said Akhidul is the third among four siblings.

Anisur Rahman, KCC conservancy officer, said, "There are four excavators used for removing waste from around 2,187 drains. Also, we have 550 employees to clean and maintain the drains."

But during high tides, drain water cannot flow into the river properly that eventually creates waterlogging, he said.

Wishing anonymity, an engineer of KCC, said, "During high tide in the rivers (Bhairab and Rupsha) drain water cannot flow into those as the rivers' water level goes over the sluice gate. As a result, tidal water also enters the
