

Kaptai lake needs dredging

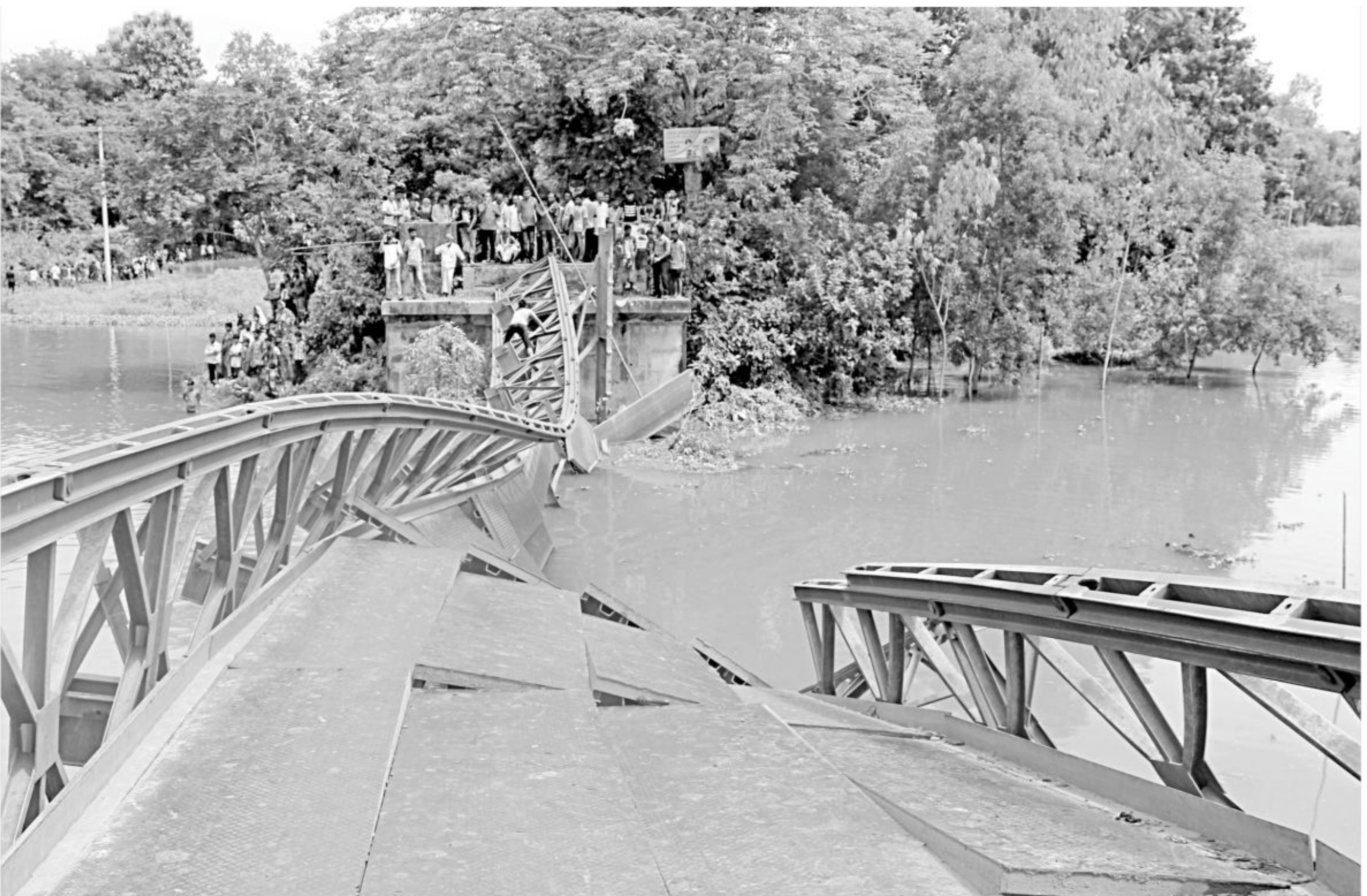

Speakers at a press conference in the hill town yesterday stressed the need for dredging the Kaptai lake to recover its navigability and boost fish production there. The press conference was held at Rangamati BFDC hall on the eve of National Fisheries Weeks to be observed during July 19-24 jointly by the Directorate of Fisheries, Bangladesh fisheries development corporation (BFDC) and Bangladesh Fisheries Research Institute (BFRI). "Following initiatives including ban on catching fish of Kaptai Lake during the breeding period, fish production in the lake sees gradual increase," Mohammad Asaduzzaman, manager of BFDC, said at the programme. The lake must be dredged every year and kept clean from garbage and water hyacinth, he added.

Another Tangail bridge collapses

A Bailey bridge on a canal in Dulla area of Delduar upazila collapsed under the weight of a fertiliser-laden truck yesterday. As a result, vehicular movement on Tangail-Delduar Road has remained suspended since then, causing immense sufferings to the passengers. Injured driver and helper of the truck, which fell into the canal, were rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital, said Mohammad Mosharaf Hossain, officer-in-charge of Delduar Police Station. The injured are trucker Omar Ahmed, 40, and his helper Abu Bakkar, 35. Fire Service and Civil Defense personnel were trying to recover the truck from the canal, local sources said. Meanwhile, vehicular movement on Delduar-Lawhati Road in Tangail still remained suspended from Friday following collapse of a bridge on the Elongjani river. A part of the bridge, including around 10 metres of the west approach road of the bridge at Charpara Elachipur Bazar in Fazilhati union of Delduar, was damaged after a passenger bus of Hanif Paribahan with over 50 passengers got on it on Friday afternoon. As a result, road communication from Tangail Sadar and South Tangail to Manikganj remained suspended due to collapse of the two bridges, causing untold sufferings to the passengers. Work was going on to make vehicular movement normal on the roads, upazila administration sources said.

3 to die for killing boatman

A court here yesterday sentenced three youths, aged about 25 to 30 years, to death for killing a boatman in 2015. The deceased was Abdur Razzak of Bahadurpur village in Harirampur upazila of the district. The convicts are Monirul Islam of Pirer Char village in Faridpur's Bhanga upazila, Rasel Mollah and Kartik Hawlader of Najirganj village in Pabna's Sujanagar upazila.

District and Sessions Judge Md Mizanur Rahman Khan also fined them Tk 20,000 each. According to the prosecution, five youths hired Razzak's boat for Tk1, 600 from Jhitka Hat of Harirampur upazila of Manikganj to go to Daulatdia Ghat in Rajbari on October 5 in 2015. The convicts strangled Razzak and took away his boat and dumped the body in the Padma river. On October 9, Harirampur police arrested the convicted youths.

Man cuts off wife's hair for dowry

Police arrested a man on Sunday night for allegedly cutting his wife's hair after torturing her as her parents refused to give him dowry. The arrestee is Hasanuzzaman Monu, 28, of Haridebpur village in Rangpur Sadar upazila. The victim is Roksana Begum, 25, daughter of Rafiqul Islam of Kashaipara village. Rafiqul told reporters that his daughter was married to Monu in 2015. He said he paid Tk 1akh as dowry as per the demand of his son-in-law's relatives. A year later, Monu again demanded Tk 50,000 as dowry. As Rafiqul refused, Monu started torturing Roksana. Later, the father paid the demanded money to save his daughter. On Friday night, Monu again tortured his wife for dowry and cut off her hair. Locals rescued the housewife and rushed her to Rangpur Medical College Hospital. Rafiqul filed a case with Rangpur Sadar Police Station on Sunday night. Officer-in-Charge of the police station ABM Zahidul Islam yesterday produced Monu before a court that sent him to jail.

No headmaster in 34 Rangpur schools

The academic activities in the government primary schools are being hampered

The academic activities at 34 government primary schools in Rangpur are being seriously hampered in absence of headmasters for over two years. There are around 9,000 students at the schools, according to Mithapukur upazila education office. The institutions include Khoraghas Uttarpara Government Primary School, Bokultola Government Primary School, Madarpur Government Primary School, Sangrampur Government Primary School, Buzruk Jhalai Government Primary School, Srirampur Government Primary School, Jalarganj Government Primary School, Buzruk Tazpur Government Primary School, Hasia Government

Primary School and Faridpur Government Primary School. There are 272 government primary schools in 17 unions of the upazila. Upzaila Education Officer Saila Zesmin Syed said her office is trying to fill up the vacant headmaster posts of these primary schools within this year. She refuted the allegation of hampering of academic activities at the schools due to absence of headmasters. However, a teacher of a primary school said smooth education of his school is badly disrupted in absence of the headmaster. An acting headmaster needs to perform all the administrative works alongside teaching the students, which is not possible.

Owner burnt to death in his tea stall

A man was burnt to death inside his tea stall in Mathbaria upazila of the district early yesterday. The deceased was Alam Hawlader, 55, son of late Atahar Ali Hawlader of Bashbuniya village. Locals said that after closing his stall, Alam went to sleep inside his tea stall at Musullibari bus stop in the upazila on Monday night. At midnight, his shop caught fire. On information, locals rushed to the spot and doused the fire. Alam could not come out and was burnt to death. The cause of the fire could not be ascertained, said Mostofa Kamal, officer of Mathbaria fire station. However, local people suspect that the fire originated from a burning cigarette.

Brahmanbaria transport strike called off
